Enjoy your crocheting!



Materials:

- Yarn - KOKONKI (50% cotton/50% acrylic) – about 1000 m, 3 threads ≈ 200 g
- Crochet hook 3,5 mm

Measurements:

- width about 180/80 cm before blocking and 190/90 cm after blocking

How to read the chart:

The file contains the chart (p. 6-7), a written description (p. 8-9) and table with stitch count in repetitions (p. 5).

Start with chain 4 and join a ring with slip stitch (or make a magic ring). The first row is crocheted around the ring.

Turn your work after every row.

Count 3 chain stitches at the beginning of the row as 1 dc.

The part of the row that we repeat is marked in red.


The gray numbers (on the chart) are the dc number between the other stitches. Do not count 3 double crochets at the beginning and end of the row.

After completing rows 1 - 17, continue with repetition rows 6 - 17, until the shawl is large enough and go to border. Border can be made after row 10 or 16.

All the stitches made into the chain can be done by inserting the crochet hook into the chain space (under the chain). The exception is row 13. At the beginning of this row you can use the stitch marker and put it in the third chain stitch.




R. 1 - 9 you can see whole rows. From the 10th row the chart is shortened - there is a half of shawl on the chart. and we read it as shown by arrows 1 - 3. in the example below. We start from right to left (1.), we made the middle of the shawl (2.), after reaching the middle we make mirror image, reading the chart



Used stitches (US terms):

*picot stitches can be done in several ways. If you want it to always be in the center of the "fan", you can do it as in the picture below:


- dc made into the space between 2 dcs from the previous row. (dc).




Table with stitch count:

- Table shows the number of stitches on one half of the row. The entire middle of the shawl is marked in dark red (on chart). **DO NOT count that stitches.**
- Count 3 chain stitches at the beginning of the row as 1 dc.





The Chart:



Border: - we only change the double crochets in the 10th or 16th row to single crochets with picots on the top of the fans. If the yarn is not enough for the entire repeat, you can replace the double crochets in the rows before the fans with single crochets or half double crochets.



Written pattern:

Repeat parts between () (Parts in red should be repeated until you reach the middle/end of the row).

In brackets [] there are stitches made in one stitch / one ch-sp.

Last stitch = the third chain stitch from the beginning of the previous row.

R.1: 3 ch, 4 dc.

R.2: 4 ch and 1 dc into first st, into next dc: [1 ch, 1 dc, 1 ch],
into 1 dc in the middle of the shawl: [1 dc, 1 ch, 1 dc, 1 ch, 1 dc],
into next dc: [1 ch, 1 dc, 1 ch], into the last st: [1 dc, 1 ch, 1 dc].

R.3: 4 ch and 1 dc into first st, 2 ch, skip: [1 ch, 1 dc, 1 ch], (1 dc, 2 ch, skip 1 ch)* 2,
into 1 dc in the middle of the shawl: [1 dc, 2 ch, 1 dc],
(2 ch, skip 1 ch, 1 dc)* 2, 2 ch, skip: [1 ch, 1 dc, 1 ch], into the last st: [1 dc, 1 ch, 1 dc].

R.4: 3 ch and 2 dc into first st, 1 dc into every ch and dc,
into ch-2-sp in the middle of the shawl:[5 dc],
1 dc into every dc and ch, into the last st: [3 dc].

R.5: 3 ch and 2 dc into first st, 1 dc into each of the next 5 dc, 3 ch, skip 3 dc, 1 dc into each of the next 7 dc,
into 1 dc in the middle of the shawl: [1 dc, 4 ch, 1 dc],
1 dc into each of the next 7 dc, 3 ch, skip 3 dc, 1 dc into each of the next 5 dc, into the last st: [3 dc].

R.6: 3 ch and 2 dc into first st, (1 dc into every dc and ch)*,
into ch-4-sp in the middle of the shawl:[7 dc],
(1 dc into every dc and ch)*, into the last st: [3 dc].

R.7: 3 ch and 3 dc into first st, 2 ch, skip 2 dc, 1 sc, 5 ch, skip 3 dc, 1 sc, (2 ch, skip 3 dc, into next dc: [5 dc],
2 ch, skip 3 dc, 1 sc, 5 ch, skip 3 dc, 1 sc)* , 2 ch, skip 3 dc, into next dc: [3 dc],
into 1 dc in the middle of the shawl: [4 dc],
into next dc: [3 dc], 2 ch, skip 3 dc, (1 sc, 5 ch, skip 3 dc, 1 sc, 2 ch, skip 3 dc, into next dc: [5 dc], 2 ch,
skip 3 dc)* , 1 sc, 5 ch, skip 3 dc, 1 sc, 2 ch, skip 2 dc, into the last st: [4 dc].

R.8: 4 ch and 1 dc into first st, (into next dc: [1 ch, 1 dc])* 3, 2 ch, skip 2 ch and 1 sc, 1 sc into ch-5-sp, 2 ch,
skip 1 sc and 2 ch, ((into next dc: [1 dc, 1 ch])*4, 1 dc, 2 ch, skip 2 ch and 1 sc, 1 sc into ch-5-sp, 2 ch, skip 1 sc
and 2 ch)*, (into next dc: [1 dc, 1 ch])* 4,
into 2 dc in the middle of the shawl: 1 dc into first dc, 1 ch (insert a stitch marker), 1 dc into second dc,
(into next dc: [1 ch, 1 dc])* 4, (2 ch, skip 2 ch and 1 sc, 1 sc into ch-5-sp, 2 ch, skip 1 sc and 2 ch,
(into next dc: [1 dc, 1 ch])*4, 1 dc)*, 2 ch, skip 2 ch and 1 sc, 1 sc into ch-5-sp, 2 ch, skip 1 sc and 2 ch,
(into next dc: [1 dc, 1 ch])*3, into the last st: [1 dc, 1 ch, 1 dc].

R.9: 5 ch from first st, skip 1 ch, (1 dc, 2 ch, skip 1 ch)* 3, 1 dc, skip: [2 ch, 1 sc and 2 ch],
((1 dc, 2 ch, skip 1 ch)* 4, 1 dc, skip: [2 ch, 1 sc and 2 ch])* , (1 dc, 2 ch, skip 1 ch)* 4, 1 dc,
above ch-1-sp in the middle: [2 ch] (insert a stitch marker),
(1 dc, 2 ch, skip 1 ch)* 4, 1 dc, (skip: [2 ch, 1 sc and 2 ch], (1 dc, 2 ch, skip 1 ch)* 4, 1 dc)* ,
skip: [2 ch, 1 sc and 2 ch], (1 dc, 2 ch, skip 1 ch)* 4, into the last st: 1 dc.

R.10: 3 ch and 2 dc into first st, (1 dc into each of the next 11 ch and dc, skip 1 dc,
1 dc (into space between dc), skip 1 dc)* , 1 dc into each of the next 12 ch and dc,
into ch-2-sp in the middle of the shawl: [5 dc],
1 dc into each of the next 12 dc and ch, (skip 1 dc, 1 dc (into space between dc), skip 1 dc, 1 dc into each
of the next 11 ch and dc)* , into the last st: [3 dc].

- R.11:** 3 ch and 2 dc into first st, (3 ch, skip 3 dc, 1 dc into each of the next 9 dc)*, 3 ch, skip 3 dc, 1 dc into each of the next 13 dc,
into 1 dc in the middle of the shawl: [1 dc, 4 ch, 1 dc],
1 dc into each of the next 13 dc, (3 ch, skip 3 dc, 1 dc into each of the next 9 dc)*, 3 ch, skip 3 dc, into the last st: [3 dc].
- R.12:** 3 ch and 2 dc into first st, (1 dc into every dc and ch)*,
into ch-4-sp in the middle of the shawl: [7 dc],
(1 dc into every dc and ch)*, into the last st: [3 dc].
- R.13:** 8 ch from first st, (insert a stitch marker into third ch), skip 1 dc, (1 sc, 2 ch, skip 3 dc, into next dc: [5 dc], 2 ch, skip 3 dc, 1 sc, 5 ch, skip 3 dc)*, 1 sc, 2 ch, skip 3 dc, into next dc: [5 dc], 2 ch, skip 3 dc, 1 sc, 2 ch, skip 2 dc,
into 1 dc in the middle of the shawl: [5 dc],
2 ch, skip 2 dc, (1 sc, 2 ch, skip 3 dc, into next dc: [5 dc], 2 ch, skip 3 dc, 1 sc, 5 ch, skip 3 dc)*, 1 sc, 2 ch, skip 3 dc, into next dc: [5 dc], 2 ch, skip 3 dc, 1 sc, 5 ch, skip 1 dc, into the last st: 1 dc.
- R.14:** 4 ch and 1 dc into first st, 2 ch, 1 sc into ch-5-sp, 2 ch, skip 1 sc and 2 ch, ((into next dc: [1 dc, 1 ch])*4, 1 dc, 2 ch, skip 2 ch and 1 sc, 1 sc into ch-5-sp, 2 ch, skip 1 sc and 2 ch)*, (into next dc: [1 dc, 1 ch])*4, 1 dc, 2 ch, skip: [2 ch, 1 sc and 2 ch], 1 sc, 2 ch, into next dc: [1 dc and 1 ch],
into 1 dc in the middle of the shawl: [1 dc, 1 ch, 1 dc],
into next dc: [1 ch and 1 dc], 2 ch, 1 sc, 2 ch, skip: [2 ch, 1 sc and 2 ch], ((into next dc: [1 dc, 1 ch])*4, 1 dc, 2 ch, skip 2 ch and 1 sc, 1 sc into ch-5-sp, 2 ch, skip 1 sc and 2 ch)*, (into next dc: [1 dc, 1 ch])*4, 1 dc, 2 ch, skip 2 ch and 1 sc, 1 sc into ch-5-sp, 2 ch, into the last st: [1 dc, 1 ch, 1 dc].
- R.15:** 4 ch and 1 dc into first st, 2 ch, skip 1 ch, 1 dc, skip: [2 ch, 1 sc and 2 ch], ((1 dc, 2 ch, skip 1 ch)* 4, 1 dc, skip: [2 ch, 1 sc and 2 ch])* , 1 dc, 2 ch, skip 1 ch, 1 dc, 2 ch,
into ch-1-sp in the middle of the shawl: [1 dc, 2 ch, 1 dc],
2 ch, 1 dc, 2 ch, skip 1 ch, 1 dc, (skip: [2 ch, 1 sc and 2 ch], (1 dc, 2 ch, skip 1 ch)* 4, 1 dc)*, skip: [2 ch, 1 sc and 2 ch], 1 dc, 2 ch, skip 1 ch, into the last st: [1 dc, 1 ch, 1 dc].
- R.16:** 3 ch and 2 dc into first st, 1 dc into each of the next 4 ch and dc, (skip 1 dc, 1 dc (into space between dc), skip 1 dc, 1 dc into each of the next 11 ch and dc)*, skip 1 dc, 1 dc (into space between dc), skip 1 dc, 1 dc into each of the next 6 ch and dc,
into ch-2-sp in the middle of the shawl: [5 dc],
1 dc into each of the next 6 dc and ch, (skip 1 dc, 1 dc (into space between dc), skip 1 dc, 1 dc into each of the next 11 ch and dc)*, skip 1 dc, 1 dc (into space between dc), skip 1 dc, 1 dc into each of the next 4 ch and dc, into the last st: [3 dc].
- R.17:** 3 ch and 2 dc into first st, 1 dc into each of the next 5 dc, (3 ch, skip 3 dc, 1 dc into each of the next 9 dc)*, 3 ch, skip 3 dc, 1 dc into each of the next 7 dc,
into 1 dc in the middle of the shawl: [1 dc, 4 ch, 1 dc],
1 dc into each of the next 7 dc, (3 ch, skip 3 dc, 1 dc into each of the next 9 dc)*, 3 ch, skip 3 dc, 1 dc into each of the next 5 dc, into the last st: [3 dc].
