



KNITTING PATTERN

Chicky

Children's sweater

Design: Knit Gang | Hobbii Design



MATERIALS

2 (3) 3 skeins of Divina color Light Petrol (27)
1 skein of Divina color Primrose (32)
1 skein of Divina color Curry (31)

Scraps of yarn for embroidering chicken eyes,
beaks and legs, or:

1 skein of Divina color Powder (10)
1 skein of Divina color Taupe (08)
1 skein of Divina color Sangria (15)

Knitting needles 4 mm (US 7)
Knitting needles 5 mm (US 8)
Circular needles 4 mm (US 7)
Tapestry needle

YARN QUALITY

 **Divina**, Hobbii

65% alpaca, 25% polyamide, 10% wool
50 g (1.75 oz) = 150 m (164 yds)

GAUGE

10 cm x 10 cm (4" x 4") = 20 sts x 28 rows

ABBREVIATIONS

st/sts = stitch/es

k = knit

p = Purl

inc = increase

CO = cast on

BO = bind off

sc = single crochet

SIZE

98/3 yrs (104/4 yrs) 110/5 yrs

MEASUREMENTS

Width: 31,5 (37,5) 39,5 cm / 12.4" (14.7") 15.5"

Length: 34 (36) 38 cm / 13.3" (14.1") 14.9"

Sleeve length: 30 (32) 34 / 11,8" (12,5") 13,3"

PATTERN INFORMATION

Super soft and adorable little sweater for kids,
very comfortable and easy to make. The
chicken motifs give it a cute look.

INFO AND TIPS

Stitches used in the pattern:

- rib stitch- k2, p2,
- rib stitch- k1, p1,
- stockinette stitch- purl in odd rows, knit in even rows;

BODY

Back piece

With 4 mm (US 7) knitting needles and color Light Petrol CO 57 (66) 72 sts.

Work 7 rows in rib stitch k2, p2.

In the 8th row start to increase:

3 yrs size- inc 1 st every 9 sts = 63 sts;

4 yrs size- inc 1 st every 8 sts = 75 sts;

5 yrs size- inc 1 st every 10 sts = 79 sts.

Change to 5 mm (US 8) needles and work 10 rows in stockinette stitch. In the 11th row start the chicken motifs according to the diagram. Remember that you can swap the chicken colors as you want.

Continue knitting in stockinette stitch to the neckline, i.e., to the 80th (86th) 92nd row.

On the next row, i.e. 81st (87th) 93rd, pass the middle 13 sts on the circular needles, and then, pass successively in every 2 rows on each side of the neckline: 3 sts, 2 sts and 1 st.

In the 89th (95th) 101st row BO the remaining arms sts (18 (25) 27).

Front piece

Work as back piece. Start the neckline in the 75th (81st) 87th row.

Work the chicken motifs as on the back, swapping the chicken colors as desired.

Make sure that the number of stitches left for the arms and the number of rows finishing the front piece is the same as at the back.

SLEEVES

With 4 mm (US 7) knitting needles CO 38 (44) 44 sts.

Work 7 rows in rib stitch k2, p2.

In the 8th row inc 1 st every 6 sts = 44 (51) 51 sts.

Change to 5 mm (US 8) needles and start to work in stockinette stitch.

Every 8 rows, inc 1 st on both sides of the sleeve.

In the 15th row counting from the beginning of the stockinette stitch, insert the chicken motifs according to the diagram, remember, that you can use the colors alternately.

Continue to the 80th (85th) 90th row.

BO all the sts.

FINISHING

Sew parts of the sweater together with mattress stitch.

Work 6 rows of the sts on circular needles in rib stitch k1, p1. BO.

Embroider the eyes, beaks and legs of the chicken with some leftover yarn.
