SIZE

(2XS-XS) S-M (L) XL-3XL

MEASUREMENTS

Bust: (89) 115 (115) 141 cm

Length: approx (52) 52 (58) 58 cm

Sleeve length: 52 cm, or suitable

All measurements are for the finished garment = personal body measurements + movement allowance. The measurements are all according to given tension.

THE GARMENT

Crochet squares to sew tog for the cardigan. Knit up sts for ribbing on sleeves, back/front, front bands and neckband. Cardigan is worked with both crocheting and knitting and with double yarn = 1 strand Tynn Peer Gynt + 1 strand Tynn Silk Mohair.

YARN

TYNN PEER GYNT (100 % Norwegian wool, 50 g = 205 m)

TYNN SILK MOHAIR (57 % mohair, 28 % silk, 15 % wool, 25 g = 212 m)

ALTERNATIVE YARN FOR TYNN PEER GYNT

MINI ALPAKKA, ALPAKKA SILKE, MANDARIN PETIT, BABYULL LANETT, TYNN LINE, SISU, TYNN MERINOULL

NOTE: If alternative yarn is chosen be sure to check the yardage on label. The image of garment might change by using alternative yarn.

ALPAKKA FØLGETRÅD

YARN REQUIRED

TYNN PEER GYNT

Bubblegum pink #4315: (9) 11 (12) 13 balls

TYNN SILK MOHAIR

Bubblegum pink 4315: (9) 11 (12) 13 balls

NOTIONS

Separating zipper in suitable length

SUGGESTED CROCHET HOOK/ KNITTING NEEDLE

Crochet hook 4.5 mm

Circular and double pointed ndls 3.5 mm for ribbing

Circular 3 mm for neckband and front bands

Size of hook is only suggestion. If your crocheting shows tighter tension, use thicker hook, for looser tension use thinner hook..

TENSION

1 square meas approx 6½ x 6½ cm worked with double yarn and 4.5 mm hook

MAGIC CIRCLE

Twirl yarn once around index finger and middle finger to create a loop, insert hook through loop and work ch1.

2 DC TOG

Work 1 dc, but stop with 2 loops on hook, work 1 more dc, but stop when 3 loops on hook, work 1 yo and pull through all loops on hook.

SQUARE

Rnd 1: With double yarn and 4.5 mm crochet hook work a magic circle. Work ch3 (= 1 dc), 1 dc, ch2 in the magic circle. Cont with *2 dc tog, ch2*, rep from *-* a total of 7 times, join with 1 sl st = 8 petals.

Rnd 2: Work 1 sl st in first ch-loop. Work ch2, 1 dc, ch3, fasten with 1 sl st in same ch-loop. *Work 1 sl st, ch3, 2 dc tog, ch3, fasten with 1 sl st in next ch-loop*, rep from *-* in each of the next ch-loops, end with 1 sl st in first ch-loop, ch3, join with 1 sc at top of first dc = 8 petals.

Rnd 3: Work ch3, work (3 dc, ch2, 3 dc) at top of next petal, ch3, *1 sc at top of next petal, ch3, (3 dc, ch2, 3 dc) at top of next petal, ch3*, rep from *-* twice more, join with 1 sl st in sc on previous rnd.

Cut yarn and fasten well.

HALF SQUARE

Row 1: With double yarn and 4.5 mm hook work a magic circle. Work ch5 (= 1 dc and ch2) in the magic

circle. Cont with *2 dc tog, ch2*, rep from *-* a total of 4 times, end with 1 dc in magic circle = 1 half petal + 4 complete petals + 1 half petal.

Row 2: Turn, and work ch3. Work 2 dc tog, ch3 in first ch-loop and fasten with 1 sl st. *Work 1 sl st, ch3, 2 dc tog, ch3, fasten with 1 sl st in next ch-loop*, rep from *-* in each of the next 3 ch-loops, but end with 1 dc instead of ch3 in last ch-loop = 5 petals.

Row 3: Turn, and work ch3. Work 3 dc at top of first petal, ch3, 1 sc at top of next petal, ch3, work (3 dc, ch2, 3 dc) at top of next petal, ch3, 1 sc at top of next petal, ch3, end with 4 dc at top of last petal.

Cut yarn and fasten well

BACK

Work (49) 63 (72) 88 full squares.

Note: Sew squares tog with mattress sts through back of loop, for front of loop to appear as a straight and even seam.

FRONTS

Work (19) 26 (30) 38 full squares, and 1 half square for each front.

SIZE (2XS-XS)

Sew squares tog 7 x 7 for back, then 2 squares on outer part of each shoulder, then 2 squares + 1 half square by each shoulder, and 3 x 5 squares (see sketch).

SIZE S-M

Sew squares tog 9 x 7 for back, then 3 squares on outer part of each shoulder, then 3 squares + 1 half square by each shoulder, then 4 x 5 squares (see sketch).

SIZE (L)

Sew squares tog 9 x 8 for back, then 3 squares on outer part of each shoulder, then 3 squares + 1 half square by each shoulder, and 4 x 6 squares (see sketch).

SIZE XL-3XL

Sew squares tog 11 x 8 for back, then 4 squares on outer part of each shoulder, then 4 squares + 1 half square by each shoulder, and 5 x 6 squared (see sketch).

SLEEVES

Work (84) 98 (98) 112 full squares, (42) 49 (49) 56 squares for each sleeve.

Tips: For shorter or longer sleeves, work 1 row less, or 1 row more squares, or work ribbing longer.

Sew squares tog (6x7) 7x7 (7 x 7) 8 x 7, (see sketch).


Edge st: Work k every row

FINISHING



Join and sew sleeves to garment according to sketch.

Sew sleeve seams at underarm, and sew back and front tog at sides.

FULL SQUARE



HALF SQUARE



RIBBING SLEEVES

With double yarn and 4.5 mm crochet hook work 1 row sc, with 15 sc on each square as follows:

Work 1 sc on corner of square, cont with 1 sc in each dc, 3 sc in ch-loop, 1 sc in sc, 3 sc in ch-loop, 1 sc in each dc, 1 sc in corner of square, rep from *-* on each square = (90) 105 (105) 120 sc.

Do not cut yarn, but transfer st to 3.5 mm double pointed ndl, and knit up 1 st in every sc in the rnd.

Join and work 6 cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds, at the same time dec (10) 17 (17) 24 sts evenly spaced on first rnd = (80) 88 (88) 96 sts.

Work Italian cast-off.

Work ribbing in same manner on other sleeve.

RIBBING FOR BACK AND FRONT

From RS, with double yarn and 4.5 mm crochet hook work 1 row sc, with 15 sc on each square as follows:

Work 1 sc on corner of square, cont with 1 sc in each dc, 3 sc in ch-loop, 1 sc in sc, 3 sc in ch-loop, 1 sc in each dc, 1 sc on corner of square, rep from *-* on each square = (195) 255 (255) 315 sc.

Cut yarn, beg again from RS, and with 3.5 mm circular ndl knit up 1 st in every sc to end of row.

Work 6 cm ribbing back and forth as follows:

(Row 1 = WS): 1 edge st, p1, *k1, p1*, rep from *-* at the same time dec (14) 30 (30) 44 sts evenly spaced on first row = (181) 225 (225) 271 sts.

Work Italian cast-off.

EDGING ON CARDIGAN

Crochet edging on cardigan, for knit up sts for neck- and front bands later.

Beg from RS, at lower edge of right front. With double yarn and 4.5 mm hook, work as follows on edge of hem: Work 1 sc in every st, but miss every 4th st = a total of 13 sc.

Work as follows on each full square:

Work 1 sc on corner of square, cont with 1 sc in each dc, 3 sc in ch-loop, 1 sc in sc, 3 sc in ch-loop, 1 sc in each dc, 1 sc on corner of square = 15 sc.

Work as follows on half square:

Work 3 sc around first dc, 2 sc around next dc, 3 sc around next dc, miss middle of square and work 3 sc around next dc, 2 sc around next dc, 3 sc around last dc = 16 sc.

Work next square and corner by neck as follows:

1 sc on corner of square, 1 sc in each dc, 3 sc in ch-loop, 1 sc in sc, 3 sc in ch-loop, work corner at back as follows: 1 sc in next dc, 1 hdc in next dc, 1 dc in next dc, 2 dc tog (work tog 1 dc from corner of each square), work 1 dc in next dc, 1 hdc in next dc, 1 sc in next dc.

Cont at neck edge as follows:

3 sc in ch-loop, 1 sc in sc, 3 sc in ch-loop, 1 sc in each dc, 1 sc at corner of square = 30 sc.

Work the full square at middle back.

Work equivalent on other side = (261) 261 (287) 287 sc.

NECKBAND

With double yarn and 3 mm circular ndl knit up 1 st in every sc on neck edge.

From WS, work 1 p row, at the same time adjust number of sts to 101.

Work ribbing back and forth in this manner:

Row 1 (= RS): Work 1 edge st, k1, *p1, k1*, rep from *-*, end with 1 edge st.

Row 2 (= WS): Work 1 edge st, p1, *k1, p1*, rep from *-*, end with 1 edge st.

Rep row 1 - 2 until neckband meas 14 cm.

Cast off loosely rib-wise.

Fold neckband double to WS and sew loosely with hidden sts.

LEFT FRONT BAND

With double yarn and 4.5 mm hook work sc on neck edge, through both layers, as follows:

Beg by folding row at upper edge and work 16 sc.

With double yarn and 3 mm circular ndl work double edging on front.

Beg by folded edge and knit up 1 st in every st-loop (= 2 sts in each sc) on front edge = (188) 188 (214) 214 sts. Work double edging in this manner:

Row 1 (= WS): *Sl 1 st with yarn in front of work, k1*,

rep from *-* to end of row.

Row 2 (= RS): *Sl 1 with yarn in front of work, k1*, rep from *-* to end of row.

Row 3 (= WS): Work as row 1.

Row 4 (= RS): Work as row 2.

From WS work Italian cast-off.

RIGHT FRONT

Work sc on neckband as for left side, but beg at lower edge of ribbing.

Work double front band as for left front, but beg at lower edge of front.

Sew on zipper.
