




Pattern Notes

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This pattern uses UK terminology throughout.

Abbreviations:

Mc Magic Circle

Sl St Slip Stitch

Ch Chain Stitch

Dc Double crochet

St Stitch

Htr Half treble

Tr Treble

Dtr Double Treble

FL Front loop

BL Back loop

Cc Colour change

Dec Decrease

Inc Increase

WS Wrong side

RS Right side

Special stitches

Lp St Loop stitch

To form a loop stitch, wrap your yarn from front to back over the index finger of your yarn hand. Insert hook into the stitch and bring the yarn under the hook, keeping your finger in place. Now grab your strand of yarn from behind your index finger and draw the loop through the stitch, still keeping your finger in place. You should now have two loops on your hook and a loop of yarn wrapped around your index finger. Gently pull the yarn until you have your desired loop length, yarn over hook as normal and pull through both loops on hook. Your loop stitch is now formed and you can remove your finger.

Pc popcorn


popcorn stitch; work 6tr all in one st, remove live loop from hook, insert hook in top of first tr, place loop on hook and pull through

Bbl Bobble stitch

*yrh twice, insert hook into stitch and pull up a loop, (yrh, pull through two loops) twice; repeat from * in the same st until you have 6 loops on your hook, yrh, pull through all 6 loops at once

Picot

ch3, sl st in the 3rd ch from hook, sl st in the next 2 sts.



Materials

- 3.5mm hook throughout
- Yarn needle
- Scissors
- Fibre filling
- Butchers twine for hanging loops
- Glue gun and glue sticks
- A small bell for the gnomes hat
- 10x Safety eyes, 10mm
- Small amount of crafting wire for the tree topper
- Card for the tree topper (2x circles cut measuring 8cm by 8cm)
- Optional - A small wooden hook to attach to the yarn decoration (I cut a 3mm hook down)

Knitcraft, Cotton Blend DK in the following colours:

- 1x Red
- 1x Coral
- 1x Mustard
- 1x Yellow
- 1x Teal
- 1x Light Grey
- 1x Lilac
- 1x Hot Pink (small amount)
- 1x Bright Blue
- 1x White
- 1x Black (small amount)

Ricorumi DK 25g yarn in the following colours:

- 2x Beige
- 1x Chocolate

Tension

Work an even fairly tight tension throughout.

Finished size

Finished size of each decoration measures approximately 10cm each

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Jellyfish

Colour: Lilac

Mc

R1. 6dc in the mc (6dc)

R2. [inc] 6 times (12dc)

R3. [1dc, inc] 6 times (18dc)

R4. [2dc, inc] 6 times (24dc)

R5. [3dc, inc] 6 times (30dc)

R6. [4dc, inc] 6 times (36dc)

R7-11. 1dc in each st (36dc)

Insert safety eyes between R8 and R9, 8sts apart. With black yarn, embroider a simple mouth between the eyes.

R12. Working in the BLs, [4dc, dec] 6 times (30dc)

R13. [3dc, dec] 6 times (24dc)

Start to stuff with fibre filling.

R14. [2dc, dec] 6 times (18dc)

R15. [1dc, dec] 6 times (12dc)

R16. [dec] 6 times (6dc)

Fasten off and sew shut.

Join Lilac in the FLs of R11.

R17. [miss 2 sts, 6tr in the next st, miss 2 sts, sl st] 6 times.

Fasten off and sew in the ends.

Cheeks

Colour: Hot Pink

Mc

R1. 6dc in the mc (6dc)

Fasten off, leaving a long tail. Using the photo as a guide, sew to the face.

Tentacles (make 8)

Colour: Lilac


Ch 15

R1. 2dc in the 2nd ch from hook and 2dc in each of the next 13 ch.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail. Sew each tentacle to the underside of the jellyfish.

Attach 15cm of Butchers twine to the top of the jellyfish and tie in a knot to secure, this forms the hanging loop.

Mc

R1. 6dc in the mc (6dc)

R2. [inc] 6 times (12dc)

R3. [1dc, inc] 6 times (18dc)

R4. Working in the BLs, 1dc in each st to the end (18dc)

R5-7. 1dc in each st (18dc)

Fasten off Coral, cc to Light Grey.

R8. Working in the BLs, 1dc in each st to the end (18dc)

R9-10. 1dc in each st (18dc)

Fasten off Light Grey, cc to Teal.

R11. Working in the BLs, 1dc in each st to the end (18dc)

R12-20. 1dc in each st (18dc)

Fasten off Teal, cc to Beige.

R21. Working in the BLs, 1dc in each st to the end (18dc)

R22. [4dc, dec] 3 times (15dc)

Start to stuff with fibre filling.

R23. [3dc, dec] 3 times (12dc)

R24. [2dc, dec] 3 times (9dc)

R25. [1dc, dec] 3 times (6dc)

Fasten off Beige, cc to Black.

R26-27. 1dc in each st (6dc)

Fasten off and sew in the ends.

Attach 15cm of Butchers twine to the end of the pencil and tie in a knot to secure, this forms the hanging loop.

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Toadstool

Stalk

Colour: White

Mc

- R1. 6dc in the mc (6dc)
- R2. [inc] 6 times (12dc)
- R3. [1dc, inc] 6 times (18dc)
- R4. [2dc, inc] 6 times (24dc)
- R5. Working in the BLs, 1dc in each st (24dc)
- R6-8. 1dc in each st (24dc)
- R9. [6dc, dec] 3 times (21dc)
- R10-11. 1dc in each st (21dc)
- R12. [5dc, dec] 3 times (18dc)
- R13. 1dc in each st (18dc)

Fasten off White and cc to Light Grey.

- R14. Working in the FLs, [2dc, inc] 6 times (24dc)
- R15. [3dc, inc] 6 times (30dc)
- R16. [4dc, inc] 6 times (36dc)

**Fasten off and sew in the ends.
Start to stuff with fibre filling.**

Cap

Colour: Red

Mc

- R1. 6dc in the mc (6dc)
- R2. [inc] 6 times (12dc)
- R3. [1dc, inc] 6 times (18dc)
- R4. [2dc, inc] 6 times (24dc)
- R5. [3dc, inc] 6 times (30dc)
- R6. [4dc, inc] 6 times (36dc)
- R7-10. 1dc in each st (36dc)

You will join the cap to the stalk for R11. Make sure to add stuffing before you finish the round.

- R11. 1dc through each st of the cap and stalk at the same time. (36dc)

**Fasten off and sew in the ends.

Spots

Make 6x small spots and 4x large spots.

Colour: White

Mc

R1. 6dc in the mc (6dc)
Fasten off here for small spots,
continue for large spots.

R2. [inc] 6 times (12dc)

Fasten off, leaving a long tail to
sew to the cap.

Position the spots and either
glue or sew in position.

Attach 15cm of Butchers twine
to the top of the toadstool and
tie in a knot to secure, this
forms the hanging loop.



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Milk

Colour: White

Ch11

R1. 1dc in the 2nd ch from the hook and in each st to the end, ch1, turn (10dc)

R2-5. 1dc in each st, ch1, turn (10dc)

R6. Now work around the four sides of the rectangle, working 1dc in each side post and 2dc in each corner st. (32dc)

R7. Working in the BLs, 1dc in each st around the rectangle (32dc)

R8-9. 1dc in each st (32dc)

Cc to Bright Blue, do not fasten off white.

R10-16. 1dc in each st (32dc)

Cc to White and fasten off Bright Blue.

R17-22. 1dc in each st (32dc)

Before fastening off, stuff lightly with fibre filling, pinch in the top two sides of the milk carton by 5sts on each side and crochet shut, 1dc in each st.

With black yarn, embroider the word 'milk' on to the front. Sew in all the ends.

Attach 15cm of Butchers twine to the top centre of the milk carton and tie in a knot to secure, this forms the hanging loop.

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Doughnut

Colour: Beige

Ch18 and sl st in the 1st ch to make a ring.

- R1-2. 1 dc in each st (18dc)
- R3. [2dc, inc] 6 times (24dc)
- R4. [3dc, inc] 6 times (30dc)
- R5. [4dc, inc] 6 times (36dc)
- R6. [5dc, inc] 6 times (42dc)
- R7-10. 1dc in each st (42dc)
- R11. [5dc, dec] 6 times (36dc)

Fasten off Beige and sew in the ends.

Icing

Repeat R1- R5 in White.

Sew both parts of the doughnut together using blanket stitch. With both WSs facing out, sew the inner rings together. Turn with the RSs facing out and sew the outer rings shut, stuff with fibre filling as you sew.

Use different colours to embroider the sprinkles, I used: Red, Mustard, Yellow, Teal and Hot Pink.

Attach 15cm of Butchers twine to the top of the doughnut and tie in a knot to secure, this forms the hanging loop.

R2. [inc] 6 times (12dc)

R3. [1dc, inc] 6 times (18dc)

R4. [2dc, inc] 6 times (24dc)

R5. [3dc, inc] 6 times (30dc)

R6. Working in the BLs, 1dc in each st (30dc)

R7-13. 1dc in each st (30dc)

R14. Working in the FLs, 1dc in each st (30dc)

R15. 1dc in each st (30dc)

R16. Working in the FLs, [4dc, inc] 6 times (36dc)

R17. 1dc in each st (36dc)

Fasten off and sew in the ends, turn the top of the pot down to create a lip.

Colour: Chocolate

R1. 6dc in the mc (6dc)

R2. [inc] 6 times (12dc)

R3. [1dc, inc] 6 times (18dc)

R4. [2dc, inc] 6 times (24dc)

R5. [3dc, inc] 6 times (30dc)

Fasten off, leaving a long tail to sew to the BLs of R13 of the pot, stuff with fibre filling before sewing shut

Leaves

Small Leaf (make 2)

Colour: Teal

Mc

R1. 6dc in the mc (6dc)

- R2. [1dc, inc] 3 times (9dc)
 R3. 1dc in each st (9dc)
 R4. [2dc, inc] 3 times (12dc)
 R5. 1dc in each st (12dc)
 R6. [2dc, dec] 3 times (9dc)
 R7. 1dc in each st (9dc)
 R8. [1dc, dec] 3 time (6dc)

Fasten, leaving a long tail to sew to the soil.

Large Leaf (make 1)

Colour: Teal

- Mc
 R1. 6dc in the mc (6dc)
 R2. [1dc, inc] 3 times (9dc)
 R3. 1dc in each st (9dc)
 R4. [2dc, inc] 3 times (12dc)
 R5-7. 1dc in each st (12dc)
 R8. [2dc, dec] 3 times (9dc)
 R9. 1dc in each st (9dc)
 R10. [1dc, dec] 3 times (6dc)

Fasten, leaving a long tail to sew to the soil.

Using photo as a guide, sew the leaves to the soil. Sew in ends.

Attach 15cm of Butchers twine to the top of the plant on the largest leaf and tie in a knot to secure, this forms the hanging loop.



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Rocket

Colour: Light Grey

- R1. 6dc in the mc (6dc)
- R2. [inc] 6 times (12dc)
- R3. [1dc, inc] 6 times (18dc)
- R4. 1dc in each st (18dc)
- R5. [2dc, inc] 6 times (24dc)
- R6-7. 1dc in each st (24dc)

Fasten off Light Grey and cc to Coral.

- R8. Working in the BLs, 1dc in each st (24dc)
- R9-14. 1dc in each st (24dc)
- R15. [3dc, inc] 6 times (30dc)
- R16-21. 1dc in each st (30dc)

Fasten off and sew in the ends.

Base

Colour: Coral

Mc

- R1. 6dc in the mc (6dc)
- R2. [inc] 6 times (12dc)
- R3. [1dc, inc] 6 times (18dc)
- R4. [2dc, inc] 6 times (24dc)
- R5. [3dc, inc] 6 times (30dc)

Fasten off, leaving a long tail. Sew the base to the main part of the rocket, stuff with fibre filling before sewing shut.

Fin (make 2)

Colour: Light Grey

Mc

- R1. 6dc in the mc (6dc)
- R2-3. 1dc in each st (6dc)

R4. [1dc, inc] 3 times (9dc)
R5-6. 1dc in each st (9dc)
R7. [2dc, inc] 3 times (12dc)
R8-10. 1dc in each st (12dc)

Fasten off, leaving a long tail to sew shut and attach to each the side of the rocket.

Motor mount

Colour: Light Grey

Mc
R1. 6dc in the mc (6dc)
R2. [inc] 6 times (12dc)
R3. Working in the BLs, 1dc in each st (12dc)
R4. 1dc in each st (12dc)

Fasten off, leaving a long tail.
Sew to the underside of the rocket

Exhaust flame (make 3)

Mustard

Ch15
R1. 2dc in the 2nd ch from the hook, 2dc in each st to the end (28dc)

Fasten off, leaving a long tail.
Sew the flames inside the Motor mount.



Window

Colour: Black

Mc
R1. 6dc in the mc (6dc)
R2. [inc] 6 times (12dc)

Fasten off Black, cc to Light Grey.

R3. [1dc, inc] 6 times (18dc)

Fasten off, leaving a long tail.
Sew to the front of the rocket.

Attach 15cm of Butchers twine to the top of the rocket and tie in a knot to secure, this forms the hanging loop.

Melon

Colour: Teal

Mc

R1. 6dc in the mc (6dc)

R2. [inc] 6 times (12dc)

R3. [1dc, inc] 6 times (18dc)

R4. [2dc, inc] 6 times (24dc)

R5. [3dc, inc] 6 times (30dc)

R6. [4dc, inc] 6 times (36dc)

R7-10. 1dc in each st (36dc)

Fasten off, leaving a long tail to sew both parts of the melon together.

Colour: Red

Mc

R1. 6dc in the mc (6dc)

R2. [inc] 6 times (12dc)

R3. [1dc, inc] 6 times (18dc)

R4. [2dc, inc] 6 times (24dc)

R5. [3dc, inc] 6 times (30dc)

Fasten off Red and cc to White.

R6. [4dc, inc] 6 times (36dc)


Fasten off White and sew in the ends.

With Black yarn, embroider the melon seeds on to the Red part of the melon.

Sew both parts of the melon together and stuff with fibre filing before you sew shut.

Attach 15cm of Butchers twine to the top of the watermelon and tie in a knot to secure, this forms the hanging loop.

- R2. [1dc, inc] 3 times (9dc)
- R3. 1dc in each st (9dc)
- R4. [2dc, inc] 3 times (12dc)
- R5. 1dc in each st (12dc)
- R6. [3dc, inc] 3 times (15dc)
- R7. 1dc in each st (15dc)
- R8. [4dc, inc] 3 times (18dc)
- R9. 1dc in each st (18dc)
- R10. [2dc, inc] 6 times (24dc)
- R11. [3dc, inc] 6 times (30dc)
- R12. [4dc, inc] 6 times (36dc)
- R13-18. 1dc in each st (36dc)
- R19. [4dc, dec] 6 times (30dc)
- R20. [3dc, dec] 6 times (24dc)

Start to stuff with fibre filling.

- R21. [2dc, dec] 6 times (18dc)

Fasten off and sew shut.

- R1. 6dc in the mc (6dc)
- R2. [inc] 6 times (12dc)
- R3. [1dc, inc] 6 times (18dc)
- R4. [2dc, inc] 6 times (24dc)
- R5-9. 1dc in each st (24dc)

Insert safety eyes between R6 and R7, 8sts apart.

- R10. [2dc, dec] 6 times (18dc)

Start to stuff with fibre filling.

- R11. [1dc, dec] 6 times (12dc)
- R12. [dec] 6 times (6dc)

**Fasten off, leaving a long tail.
Sew to the body**

Embroider a simple mouth with black yarn and two teeth with White yarn.

Cheeks (make 2)

Colour: Hot Pink

Mc

R1. 6dc in the mc (6dc)

Fasten off, leaving a long tail.
Sew on either side of the face.

Legs (make 4)

Colour: Teal

Mc

R1. 6dc in the mc (6dc)

R2. [inc] 6 times (12dc)

R3-4. 1dc in each st (12dc)

Stuff with fibre filling, fasten off and leave a long tail. Sew to the underside of the dinosaur.


Spikes

Colour: Coral

R1. [ch4, miss the 1st ch, 1dc, 1htr, 1tr] 10 times.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail, sew down the back of the head, body and tail of the dinosaur.

Attach 15cm of Butchers twine to the top of the dinosaur, between back of the head and body and tie in a knot to secure, this forms the hanging loop.



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Strawberry Jam

Colour: Coral

Mc

- R1. 6dc in the mc (6dc)
- R2. [inc] 6 times (12dc)
- R3. [1dc, inc] 6 times (18dc)
- R4. [2dc, inc] 6 times (24dc)
- R5. [3dc, inc] 6 times (30dc)
- R6. Working in BLs, 1dc in each st (30dc)
- R7-8. 1dc in each st (30dc)
- R9. Work with Coral but carry Red. *4dc with Coral, 5tr in the next st with Red. Repeat from * 6 times. (24dc, 30tr)

Fasten off Red and continue with Coral.

- R10. Work with Coral but carry Teal. *4dc with Coral, 5tr together in the next st with Teal. Repeat from * 6 times. (24dc, 6tr)

Fasten off Teal and continue with Coral.

- R11-18. 1dc in each st (30dc)

Fasten off coral and attach White.

- R19. 1dc in each st (30dc)

Fasten off White, leaving a long tail to attach the lid.

**Lid
Colour: White**

- R1. 6dc in the mc (6dc)
- R2. [inc] 6 times (12dc)
- R3. [1dc, inc] 6 times (18dc)
- R4. [2dc, inc] 6 times (24dc)
- R5. [3dc, inc] 6 times (30dc)

Join Red, do not fasten off White.

R6. Working in FLs, 1dc in each st (30dc)

Fasten off Red and continue with White.

R7. Ch2 (does not count as a st), 3htr in each st around (90htr)

Fasten off and sew in the ends.

Sew R6 BLs to R19 of the jar, stuff with fibre filling as you sew shut.

Label

Colour: White

Ch9

R1. 1dc in the 2nd ch from the hook, 1dc in each st (8dc)

R2-3. Ch1, turn, 1dc in each st (8dc)

Fasten off, leaving a long tail to sew to the jar. Embroider the word 'jam' on to the label using Black.

Attach 15cm of Butchers twine to the top, middle of the jam jar lid and tie in a knot to secure, this forms the hanging loop.



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Post box

Mc

R1. 6dc in the mc (6dc)

R2. [inc] 6 times (12dc)

R3. [1dc, inc] 6 times (18dc)

R4. [2dc, inc] 6 times (24dc)

R5-6. 1dc in each st (24dc)

R7. Working in the BLs, 1dc in each st (24dc)

R8-22. 1dc in each st (24dc)

Fasten off Red and attach Black.

R23. Working in the BLs, 1dc in each st (24dc)

R24-25. 1dc in each st (24dc)

Fasten off leaving a long tail to sew to the base.

Base

Colour: Black

R1. 6dc in the mc (6dc)

R2. [inc] 6 times (12dc)

R3. [1dc, inc] 6 times (18dc)

R4. [2dc, inc] 6 times (24dc)

Fasten off and sew in the ends.

Attach the top to the base sewing into the back loops, stuff with fibre filling as you sew shut.

Heart label

Colour: White

Ch6

R1. 1dc in 2nd ch from the hook and in each st to the end (5dc)

R2-6. Ch1, turn, 1dc in each st (5dc)

R2. [inc] 6 times (12dc)

R3. [1dc, inc] 6 times (18dc)

R4. [2dc, inc] 6 times (24dc)

R5. [3dc, inc] 6 times (30dc)

R6. [4dc, inc] 6 times (36dc)

R7. 1dc in each st (36dc)

Cc to Red, do not fasten off Bright Blue.

R8. 1dc in each st (36dc)

Cc to Yellow, fasten off Red, do not fasten off Bright Blue.

R9. 1dc in each st (36dc)

Cc to Teal, fasten off Yellow, do not fasten off Bright Blue.

R10. 1dc in each st (36dc)

Cc to Lilac, fasten off Teal, do not fasten off Bright Blue.

R11. 1dc in each st (36dc)

Cc to Hot Pink, fasten off Lilac, do not fasten off Bright Blue.

R12. 1dc in each st (36dc)

Fasten off Hot Pink and continue with Bright Blue.

R13. [10dc, dec] 3 times (33dc)

R14. 1dc in each st (33dc)

R15. [9dc, dec] 3 times (30dc)

R16. 1dc in each st (30dc)

R17. [8dc, dec] 3 times (27dc)

R18. 1dc in each st (27dc)

R19. [7dc, dec] 3times (24dc)

R20. [2dc, dec] 6times (18dc)

Start to stuff with fibre filling.

R21. [1dc, dec] 6 times (12dc)

R1. 6dc in the mc (6dc)
R2. [inc] 6 times (12dc)

Fasten off and sew in the ends, sew both parts of the balloon into the BLs, stuffing as you go.

R1. 6dc in the mc (6dc)
R2. [inc] 6 times (12dc)
R3. [1dc, inc] 6 times (18dc)
R4-6. Working in the BL's, 1 dc in each st (18dc)



Fasten off, leaving a long tail to attach to the balloon. Leave a space of approximately 1.5cm between the balloon and the basket.

Attach 15cm of Butchers twine to the top of the hot air balloon and tie in a knot to secure, this forms the hanging loop.

- R6-10. 1dc in each st (30dc)

Insert safety eyes between R6 and R7, 6sts apart.

- R11. [3dc, dec] 6 times (24dc)
- Start to stuff with fibre filling.
- R12. [2dc, dec] 6 times (18dc)
- R13. [1dc, dec] 6 times (12dc)
- R14. 1dc in each st (12dc)
- R15. [1dc, inc] 6 times (18dc)
- R16. [2dc, inc] 6 times (24dc)
- R17. [3dc, inc] 6 times (30dc)
- R18. [4dc, inc] 6 times (36dc)
- R19-23. 1dc in each st (36dc)
- R24. [4dc, dec] 6 times (30dc)

Start to stuff with fibre filling and continue.

- R14. Working in BLs, 1dc in each st (18dc)







R14. [7dc, cc, popcorn, cc back to mustard] 6 times (42dc, 6popcorn)

For the popcorns, make 1 of each of the following colours; red, yellow, teal, bright blue, lilac and pink.

R15-16. 1dc in each st (48dc)
R17. Working in the BLs, 1dc in each st to the end (48dc)
R18. 1dc in each st (48dc)
R19. *Miss 2sts, [2tr, 2dtr, picot, 2dtr, 2tr], miss 2sts, sl st. repeat from * 8 times.

Fasten off and sew in all the ends.



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
