

# DALIA



Dalia, with a refined ivory color, made with New One, Fine Merino wool is a must-have for any occasion.



**Yarn:** NEW ONE col 207

**Crochet:** n. 5.5

**Weight:** 900 g (9 balls)

**Stiches Used:** Single Crochet, Double Crochet

## Abbreviations:

(\*) repeat from ( to )

ch chain

sl st slip stitch

sc single crochet

dc double crochet

Fantasy stitch IN FRONT OF STITCH \* in last dc: 5 ch and close with dc on next stitch\* ending round with 1dc

Picot 3rd RND OF THE FLOWER: on 4th dc of each petal, 3ch, sl st to close picot (see photo)

Work is made of 7 GRANNY, each one made of 1 FLOWER and 1 GRANNY.



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**FLOWER made of 8 petals (with NEW ONE yarn, the size of the flower is 15 cm)**

Magic Ring

1st rnd

ch3, dc15, sl st (in 3rd ch) = 16 dc

2nd rnd


In sl st of last round: sc1, ch2 (which counts as 1dc), in same stitch ch3, dc1 slip ch1, \*dc1, ch3, dc1\* until 8 arches are made, close with sl st in 2nd chain at the beginning of the round

3rd rnd

In sl st of last rnd: sc1, ch2 (=dc1)

dc3 in the arch of chains (B) – 1 picot – dc4 in same arch (see graphic)

side (C) dc6 in dc of last rnd (turn work from left to right) – end of 1st arch

sc1 in chain of last round (PHOTO 1)



2nd arch and followings archs  
\* side (A) dc6 in dc of last round (turn work from right to left – 2nd PHOTO)



dc4 – 1 picot, 4dc in arch (B)  
side (C) dc6 in dc of last round (turn work from left to right – 3rd PHOTO)



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sl st in chain of last round \*

N.B.: round started on 1st arch (B) with 3 chains + 3 dc etc... Now close 1st petal with:  
(A) dc6 on 1st dc slipped of 1st arch  
sl st in 2nd starting chain. Fasten off and cut yarn.

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## GRANNY

1st rnd

Start working in the arch between 2 petals: ch1, ch4 (photo 5)

\* in next arch sc1, ch4 \*

close with sc1 in 1st arch

2nd rnd

N.B. in each arch (ch4) only 5 dc can be worked – the pattern for the exagonal granny is worked on 7 dc + 2 ch as follows:

1st ARCH - on sc of 1st rnd: ch2 (= 1dc) + dc2

2nd ARCH - dc4-ch2-dc1

3rd ARCH – dc5

4th ARCH – dc1-ch2-dc4

5th ARCH – dc3-ch2-dc2

6th ARCH – dc5-ch2

7th ARCH – dc5

8th ARCH – dc2-ch2-dc3

9th ARCH – dc4-ch2

sl st in 2nd ch of 1st arch

Total: 3 dc

3rd rnd

N.B.: there should be 7dc between each corner – pay attention at the hide stitch in the corners

In sl st: sc1+ch2 = (1 dc) – 6dc in each stitch of last rnd until corner made of 2 ch.

In corner: dc2 + ch2 + dc2

\* dc7 in each stitch of last rnd until corner made of 2 ch.

In corner: dc2 + ch2 + dc2

Sl st in 2nd ch of 1st dc.

4th rnd

N.B.: In this round use stitch markers to mark flowers tips (photo 6) and fix them (photo 7) in the dc.



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PHOTO 7

- - Start with sc1+ch2 (=1dc) – dc10 in each st of last rnd
- - In corner dc1+ch1+dc1
- - Work as follows until end of rnd \*dc11 – dc1+ch1+dc1\*
- 

Sl st IN FRONT of stitch

5st rnd–FANTASY STITCH – IN FRONT OF STITCHES

N.B.: Mark first and last dc of each corner to easily work 6th round

In sl st of last rnd: sc1+ch2 (=1dc)-ch5

\*In each stitch of last rnd dc1+ch5, in corners ch2\* Close with a sl st.

6st rnd– IN BACK OF STITCHES

In the stitches formed on the back of fantasy stitch, work dc between markers of each side

in corners dc1+ch1+dc1 working in the middle of corner of 4th rnd and the 2ch of 5st rnd corner

In each side there should be 13dc

Sl st to close rnd.

7th rnd – IN FRONT OF STITCHES

As 5st rnd.

8th rnd– IN BACK OF STITCHES

As 6st rnd.

In each side there should be 14dc.

9st rnd

\*dc15 – corner dc1+ch1+dc1\* Sl st to close rnd

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EACH GRANNY MUST HAVE THE SAME NUMBER OF STITCHES IN FINAL ROUND TO JOIN SIDES WITH CROCHET. ALTERNATIVELY YOU CAN PROCEED WITH NEEDLE STITCHING (you won't have the same relief effect)

FINAL MEASUREMENT OF EACH GRANNY 29/30 cm.

JOIN 7 GRANNY – (photo 8)



Using a stitch marker - or another method - temporarily join the grannies (photo 8) to help the correct assembly of the bag.

The 7th granny will form the central part of the back of the bag.

Join the central granny (front and then back) in double crochet stitch (photo 8 red line) – (photo 9)

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PHOTO 9

Join in single crochet remaining sides.  
(photo 10)  
Finish in sl st the upper side of the Bag.  
Lining and inserting a shoulder handle
