

Barnaba Shawl

Yarn – Lace weight handspun.

Yarn – 1350 yards.

Needles – US size 3.

Size – 82 inches x 30 inches. Size can be easily changed by increasing or decreasing the number of pattern repeats.

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Cast on multiple of 34 plus 8 stitches. I used 144 stitches.

Rows 1-4: (k1, p1) repeat until last stitch, k1.

Row 5: (k1, p1) repeat until last 6 stitches, k2tog, p1, k1, p1, k1

All even rows are k1, p1, k1, p1, k1, purl to last 5 stitches, k1, p1, k1, p1, k1

Do Chart 1 once. Note that all even rows on all the charts are k1, p1, k1, p1, k1, purl to last 5 stitches, k1, p1, k1, p1, k1.

Then do Chart 2 repeating it until shawl is desired length. I did 8 repeats.

Do Chart 3 once.

Finish shawl with the following 5 rows.

Row 1: (k1, p1) repeat until last 6 stitches, m1, k1, p1, k1, p1, k1

Rows 2-5: (k1, p1) repeat until last stitch, k1.

Bind off loosely and block.

☐ RS: purl WS: knit

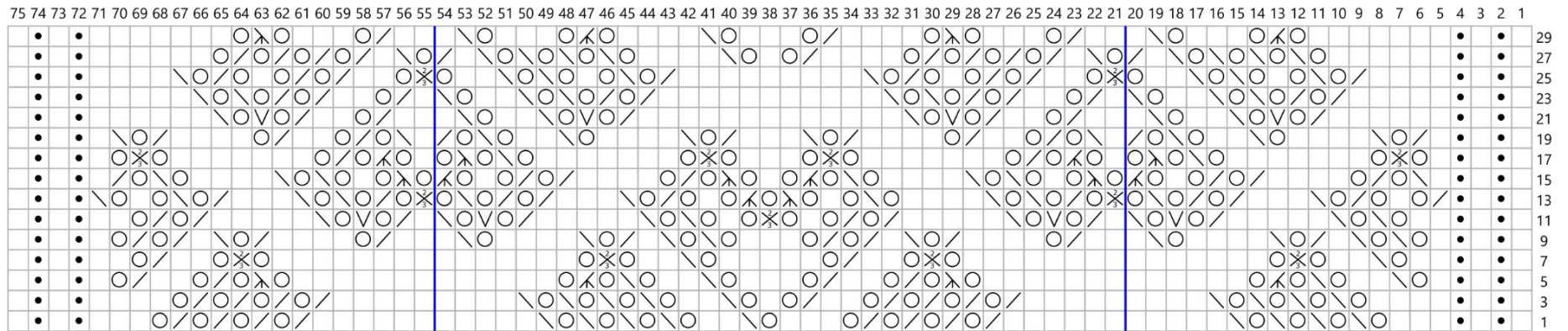

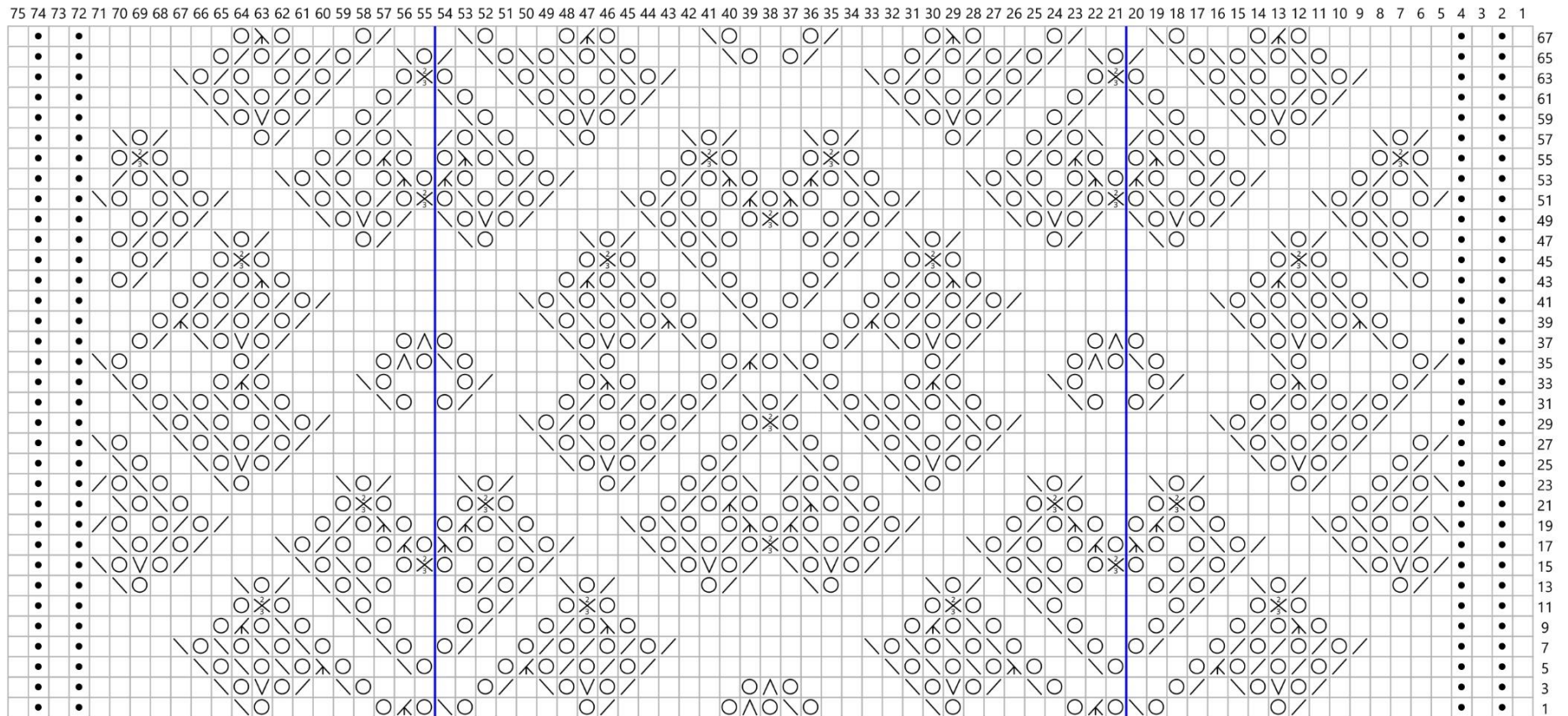
