## Materials And Tools:

- Original yarn:

Plush yarn **Premier Parfait Chunky** 120m (131 yds)/100g colors:

cream color 1150-41 Mushroom – 3 skeins - 250g

brown 1150-35 or 1150-36 – 1 skein 25 g



You can substitute plush yarn with any another bulky yarn with hook 4mm.

For nose and paw pads any pink yarn and some white yarn for whiskers. You can use bulky plush or regular yarn or for example fine regular yarn in 2 threads – 5 g

Substitute plush yarn: Himalaya Dolphin Baby 120m (131 yds)/100g, Dolce YarnArt 120m (131 yds)/100g, Velvet by Bernat 288m (315yds)/300g, Baby Bee Adore a ball 100g/84m. You can find plush yarn on Etsy, Amazon, LoveCrafts, Joann's, Walmart and Hobby Lobby and Woolwarehouse.

- Hook US size G/6 (4 mm)
- Glitter safety eyes 20 mm (you can substitute safety eyes with buttons). You can find them on Etsy, Amazon, Walmart, Joann's, AliExpress.
- Fiber fill stuffing – 250-300 g
- Cream or white regular thread for sewing
- Tapestry needle
- Scissors
- Pins

## Skill level:

**Easy.** Basic crocheting and sewing skills required.

You can use any yarn to make this amigurumi. For example, if you use a bigger hook and a suitable yarn, the toy will be bigger while maintaining the same proportions.

## Finished Measurements:

Approximately 20 in/ 50 cm with ears using original plush yarn and hook G/6 (4 mm).

## Crochet Abbreviations (US terminology):

ch - chain	sl st – slip stitch
dc - double crochet	st(s) - stitch(s)
dec – decrease	tr – treble crochet
hdc – half double crochet	() – rep the content of the parenthesis as many times as the number after parenthesis says.
inc – increase	The number after = is the total number of stitches in the rnd
rep – repeat	
rnd(s) - round(s)	
sc – single crochet	

## Beginning:

All pieces are worked in a spiral continuously. This means that you do not end the rnd with a slip stitch and do not start a rnd with a chain.

I start working every piece from a magic ring but you can ch2 and work the necessary number of sc in the second st from the hook.

You should crochet tight enough to prevent stuffing from sticking out.

## Head:

With cream plush yarn and hook G/6 (4 mm) make a magic ring.

<b>Round 1</b>	6 sc in magic ring =6 sts
<b>Round 2</b>	2 sc in each st around = 12 sts
<b>Round 3</b>	(sc in next st, 2 sc in next st)*6 times = 18 sts
<b>Round 4</b>	(sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st)*6 times = 24 sts
<b>Round 5</b>	(sc in next 3 sts, 2 sc in next st)*6 times = 30 sts
<b>Round 6</b>	(sc in next 4 sts, 2 sc in next st)*6 times = 36 sts
<b>Round 7</b>	(sc in next 5 sts, 2 sc in next st)*6 times = 42 sts
<b>Round 8</b>	(sc in next 6 sts, 2 sc in next st)*6 times = 48 sts
<b>Round 9</b>	(sc in next 7 sts, 2 sc in next st)*6 times = 54 sts

- Round 10** (sc in next 8 sts, 2 sc in next st)\*6 times = 60 sts  
**Round 11** (sc in next 9 sts, 2 sc in next st)\*6 times = 66 sts  
**Round 12** (sc in next 10 sts, 2 sc in next st)\*6 times = 72 sts  
**Round 13** (sc in next 11 sts, 2 sc in next st)\*6 times = 78 sts  
**Rounds 14-21** 78 sts **(8 rounds)**  
**Round 22** (sc in next 11 sts, sc dec)\*6 times = 72 sts  
**Round 23** (sc in next 10 sts, sc dec)\*6 times = 66 sts  
**Round 24** (sc in next 9 sts, sc dec)\*6 times = 60 sts  
**Round 25** (sc in next 8 sts, sc dec)\*6 times = 54 sts  
**Round 26** (sc in next 7 sts, sc dec)\*6 times = 48 sts  
**Round 27** (sc in next 6 sts, sc dec)\*6 times = 42 sts

Fasten off, cut yarn and weave in ends.



## Muzzle

With brown yarn and hook G/6 (4 mm) make chain 6.

- Round 1** sc in the 2<sup>nd</sup> st from the hook, sc 3, 3sc in the last st. Work on other side of your chain: sc 3, 2sc in the last st = 12 sts  
**Round 2** 2sc, sc 3, 2 sc\*3times, sc 3, 2sc \*2 times = 18 sts  
**Round 3** sc, 2sc, sc 3, (sc, 2sc)\*3 times, sc 3, (sc, 2sc)\*2 times = 24 sts  
**Round 4** sc 2, 2sc, sc 3, (sc 2, 2sc)\*3 times, sc 3, (sc2, 2sc)\*2times = 30 sts  
**Round 5** sc 3, 2sc, sc 3, (sc 3, 2sc)\*3 times, sc 3, (sc 3, 2sc)\*2times = 36 sts  
**Round 6** sc 4, 2sc, sc 3, (sc 4, 2sc)\*3 times, sc 3, (sc 4, 2sc)\*2times = 42 sts

Fasten off, leave long tail for sewing.



## Arm (Make 2)

With brown yarn and hook G/6 (4 mm) make a magic ring.

**Round 1** 6 sc in magic ring = 6 sts

**Round 2** 2 sc in each st around = 12 sts

**Rounds 3-5** 12 sts **(3 rounds)**

Change yarn color to cream, cut brown yarn

**Round 6 (BLO)** 12 sts

**Rounds 7-12** 12 sts **(7 rounds)**

Stuff the arm to half. Fasten off.

Rep rnds 1-12 for the second arm.



Embroider paw pads with pink yarn as shown on the photo.

Use photo as a guide.

## **Legs & Body**

With brown yarn and hook G/6 (4 mm) make a magic ring.

**Round 1** 6 sc in magic ring = 6 sts

**Round 2** 2 sc in each st around = 12 sts

**Round 3** (sc in next st, 2 sc in next st)\*6 times = 18 sts

**Round 4** (sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st)\*6 times = 24 sts

**Rounds 5 - 6** 24 sts **(2 rounds)**

Change yarn color to cream, cut brown yarn

**Rounds 7 - 10** 24 sts **(4 rounds)**

**Round 11** (sc in next 3 sts, 2 sc in next st)\*6 times = 30 sts

Fasten off, leave the tail about 10 cm and cut the yarn. One leg is done.

Rep rnds 1-11 for the second leg. Don't cut yarn when the second leg is finished.

Continue with cream yarn from second leg:

**Round 12** 30 sc around the 1st leg's sts, then make 30 sc around the 2nd leg's sts (this is how legs are attached to each other) = 60 sts

## Siamese cat Crochet pattern by Fionadolls

!!!To prevent hole between the legs when you join legs make first single crochet to the last stitch of the round 11.

**Round 13** (sc in next 9 sts, 2 sc in next st)\*6 times = 66 sts

**Rounds 14-29** 66 sts **(16 rounds)**

**Round 30** (sc in next 9 sts, sc dec)\*6 times = 60 sts

**Rounds 31-41** 60 sts **(11 rounds)**

**Round 42** (sc in next 8 sts, sc dec)\*6 times = 54 sts

**Rounds 43-48** 54 sts **(6 rounds)**

**Round 49** (sc in next 7 sts, sc dec)\*6 times = 48 sts

**Rounds 50-53** 48 sts **(4 rounds)**

**Round 54** (sc in next 6 sts, sc dec)\*6 times = 42 sts

Stuff the legs and body tightly. Fasten off. Leave long tail for sewing (40 cm).



**Ears (Make 2)**

With brown yarn and hook G/6 (4 mm) make a magic ring.

- Round 1** 6 sc in magic ring = 6 sts
- Round 2** 2 sc\*2times, sc, 2 sc\*2times, sc = 10 sts
- Round 3** 2 sc\*2times, sc 3, 2 sc\*2times, sc 3 = 14 sts
- Round 4** 2 sc\*2times, sc 5, 2 sc\*2times, sc 5 = 18 sts
- Round 5** 2 sc\*2times, sc 7, 2 sc\*2times, sc 7 = 22 sts
- Round 6** 22 sts



Fasten off. Leave the long tail for sewing.

Rep rnds 1-6 for the second ear.

## Tail

With brown yarn and hook G/6 (4 mm) make a magic ring.

- Round 1** 6 sc in magic ring = 6 sts
- Round 2** 2 sc in each st around = 12 sts
- Rounds 3-16** 12 sts



Fasten off. Leave the long tail for sewing.

## Heart Patch

The size of the heart is about **5cm/2in**, so if you use bulky plush yarn, you can crochet only round1, if you use another thinner yarn you need to crochet also round 2.


With pink yarn and hook G/6 (4 mm) make a ch 4.

- Round 1** in 3 chain from the hook: 3tr, 4dc, 1tr, 4dc, 3tr, ch 2, sl st = 15 sts
- Round 2** sc 3, 3hdc, sc 13, 3hdc, sc 3, sc st = 25 sts

Fasten off. Leave the tail for sewing.

## Assembly:

**IN CASE IF YOU HAVE SOME PROBLEMS WITH ASSEMBLY FEEL FREE TO CONTACT ME, I HAVE VIDEOS FOR YOU.**

1. Insert safety eyes into brown face and head between rounds 3 ad 4 of the brown muzzle (about 8 sts between them) and then insert eyes into head (between 17 and 18 rounds) and fix the eyes inside.
2. Sew the face to the head with the tail of the thread.
3. Stuff the head tightly.



4. Pin and sew the head to the body (42 sts of round 27 of the head to 42 sts from round 54 of the body). You can use the tail of the plush yarn or cotton thread.

*To make sure the head does not dangle, stuff the body and neck strongly.*



5. Pin and sew arms to the body between rounds 53 and 47.



6. Pin end sew the ears on the top of the head between rounds 4 and 14.



7. With pink yarn embroider nose between eyes between round 1 and 3 with 4 sts between and make long stitch down to round 6.

(1 - make several short vertical stitches to the 1 stitch, 2 - then make horizontal stitch, 3 - make long vertical stitch)

8. Also you can embroider smile with pink thread. And with white thread embroider whiskers as shown at the photo.



9. Pin and sew tail to the back between rounds 22 and 23 with 6 sts between.



***That's all. Your toy is ready!***
