Yarn

Fingering

MC - body: 415 (515, 540, 610, 675, 690, 775, 880, 920, 970, 1050, 1220) yards

380 (475, 495, 560, 615, 630, 705, 805, 840, 885, 960, 1120) meters

CC1 - sleeves: 270 (330, 350, 390, 430, 445, 495, 656, 590, 620, 675, 710) yards

254 (305, 320, 360, 395, 405, 455, 520, 540, 565, 615, 650) meters

CC2 - sprinkles: 125 (155, 160, 180, 200, 205, 230, 260, 270, 285, 310, 350) yards

115 (140, 150, 170, 185, 190, 210, 240, 250, 260, 285, 320) meters

Needles

US 3 (3.00mm) 16-40" circular needles

US 5 (3.75mm) 16-40" circular needles

Gauge - with gentle blocking

22 sts x 26 rows in US 5 stockinette knit flat and in the round = 4" x 4"

Finished measurements - suggest 2-8" positive ease

A) Bust: 31 (34, 36, 39.5, 42.5, 45, 49, 53, 56, 59, 61, 65)"

79 (86.5, 91.5, 100, 108, 114, 124, 135, 142, 147, 155, 165)cm

B) Yoke Depth: 8 (8.25, 8.5, 9.25, 9.75, 9.75, 10.5, 12, 12, 12.6, 13.25, 13.5)"

20.5 (21, 22, 23.5, 25, 25, 27.5, 30.5, 30.5, 32, 33.5, 35)cm

C) Biceps: 11 (12.5, 12.5, 12.5, 13, 14.5, 16.5, 19.5, 20.5, 20.5, 21, 22.5)"

28 (32, 32, 32, 33, 37, 42, 49.5, 52, 53, 54.5, 57)cm


D) Body Length: customizable: leave space for a 2.5" (6.5cm) hem

E) Sleeve length: customizable: leave space for a 2.5" (6.5cm) cuff

Abbreviations

- BOR - Beginning of round
- CC1 - contrast color one - sleeves
- CC2 - contrast color two - sprinkles
- CO - cast on
- K - knit (P on WS) established color, either MC or CC1
- K2tog - knit 2 together
- M Kfb - knit front and back - 1st increased
- MC - main color - body
- Rep - repeat
- RS - right side
- P - purl
- P2tog - purl two together
- Pm - place marker
- Sl - slip purlwise
- St(s) - stitch(es)
- WS - wrong side
- Yo - yarn over




1. Collar and set up

1. With smaller needles in MC, CO 100 (100, 108, 116, 124, 124, 124, 132, 148, 148, 156, 164)sts and join in the round, placing BOR.
2. Work in (k1, p1) ribbing for 8 rounds.
3. Switch to larger needles, in MC yo, K37 (37, 41, 49, 53, 53, 53, 49, 53, 53, 57, 61)sts and pm1 (*back*), in CC1 k13 (13, 13, 9, 9, 9, 9, 17, 21, 21, 21, 21)sts and pm2 (*left sleeve*), in MC k37 (37, 41, 49, 53, 53, 53, 49, 53, 53, 57, 61)sts and pm3 (*front*), in CC1, k12 (12, 12, 8, 8, 8, 8, 16, 20, 20, 20, 20)sts to 1st before the BOR. Take off BOR marker, k2tog the last st of the round with the yo from the start of the round. Replace BOR and turn your work.

We are no longer working in the round. In order to work the intarsia with a separate sleeve color, we will be turning at the end of each row, working an invisible "seam" to continue creating a seamless raglan sweater.

4. Yo, in established colors p back to BOR, p2tog the last st of the row with the yo from the start of row.



2. Yoke

We will now be following the colorwork chart

1. Work rows 1-4 for 46 (48, 48, 52, 56, 62, 70, 70, 70, 72, 74, 76) rows.
 - **Row 1 (RS) Colorwork row:** Turn work, yo, in established colors work row one of chart in each of the four sections. When you reach the last st of the row, remove BOR and kfb with both the last st, and the yo from the start of the row. *8sts increased*
 - **Rows 2 and 4 (WS):** Turn work, yo, in established colors p back to BOR, p2tog the last st of the row with the yo from the start of row.
 - **Row 3:** Turn work, yo, in established colors work row three of chart in each of the four sections. When you reach the last st of the row, remove BOR and kfb with both the last st, and the yo from the start of the row. *8sts increased*
- 59 (61, 61, 61, 65, 71, 79, 87, 91, 93, 95, 97)sts in each sleeve section and 83 (85, 89, 101, 109, 115, 123, 119, 123, 125, 131, 137)sts in each the front and back.
2. Sizes 31 (34, 36, 39.5, 42.5, 45, 49, -, -, -, -) only, work 6 (6, 6, 6, 6, 6, 6, -, -, -, -) more rows in colors as established working the offset sprinkles (*no increases*), then move onto splitting for the sleeves..
 3. Sizes -, (-, -, -, -, -, -, 53, 56, 59, 61, 66) work rows 1-2 below for - (-, -, -, -, -, -, 8, 8, 10, 12, 14) rows (*continue working offset sprinkles*):
 - **Row 1 (RS):** Turn work, yo, in MC, kfb, k to last sts of the back, kfb. In CC1, k across sleeve, In MC, kfb, k to last sts of front, kfb. in CC1, k to the last st of the row, remove BOR and k2tog with both the last st, and the yo from the start of the row. *4sts increased*
 - **Row 2 (WS):** Turn work, yo, in established colors p back to BOR, p2tog the last st of the row with the yo from the start of row.
- (-, -, -, -, -, -, 87, 91, 93, 95, 97)sts in each sleeve section and - (-, -, -, -, -, -, 127, 131, 135, 143, 151)sts in each the front and back.



2. Split sts

1. In established colors K83 (85, 89, 101, 109, 115, 123, 127, 131, 135, 143, 151)sts. Place the next 59 (61, 61, 61, 65, 71, 79, 87, 91, 93, 95, 97)sts on a stitch holder for the sleeve. Using the backwards loop method CO 5 (7, 7, 7, 7, 9, 13, 17, 21, 21, 21, 25)sts for underarm and k83 (85, 89, 101, 109, 115, 123, 127, 131, 135, 143, 151)sts across the front. Place the next 59 (61, 61, 61, 65, 71, 79, 87, 91, 93, 95, 97)sts on a st holder for the sleeve. Using the backwards loop method CO 5 (7, 7, 7, 7, 9, 13, 17, 21, 21, 21, 25)sts for the underarm. Join body in the round and replace BOR under the middle of the underarm.

You should now have 59 (61, 61, 61, 65, 71, 79, 87, 91, 93, 95, 97)sts set aside for each sleeve, and 176 (184, 192, 216, 232, 248, 272, 288, 304, 312, 328, 352)sts in the body of your sweater.

3. Body

1. Continue working in stockinette with the offset sprinkles as established 12 (12, 12, 12.5, 12.5, 12.5, 12.5, 13, 13, 13.5)", or until your desired length.
2. In smaller needles, work in a (k1, p1) ribbing for 2.5".
3. Cast off using the twisty bind off method.

4. Sleeves

Worked twice, once for each sleeve.

1. Pick up your sts set aside for your sleeves. 59 (61, 61, 61, 65, 71, 79, 87, 91, 93, 95, 97)sts per sleeve.
2. Pick up and knit 5 (7, 7, 7, 7, 9, 9, 17, 21, 23, 21, 27)sts for underarm, and place a BOR in the middle of your underarm.
3. Continue working in stockinette with the offset sprinkles as established for 13 (14, 14, 14, 14, 14, 14, 14, 15, 15, 15, 15)".
A note on sleeve length: for optimum drape in your sleeve, we recommend knitting it a bit short (1-2") and wet blocking your sleeves more aggressively length-wise.
4. **Decrease round before cuff:**
 - Sizes 31 (34, 36, 39.5, 42.5, 45, 49, -, -, -, -, -): *K2tog, k2* 15 (17, 17, 17, 18, 20, 22, -, -, -, -, -) times, k to end of round.
 - Sizes -, (-, -, -, -, -, -, 53, 56, 59, 61, 66): *K2tog, 3 times, k1* - (-, -, -, -, -, -, 15, 16, 16, 16, 17) times, k to end of round.
5. In smaller needles, work in a (k1, p1) ribbing for 2.5". *Work a p2tog at the end of round if necessary to have an even number of sts.*
6. Cast off sleeves using the sewn bind off method.

5. Finishing

1. Weave in all ends.
2. Block to size shown in measurements. Make sure to watch the fit video for tips on blocking the perfect neckline.
3. Wear and be fabulous!
