



waxwing

## YARN

waxwing yarn cèdre  
25g / 91meters (100yards)

## COLOURS

mc - bison  
cc - mousse

## NEEDLES

3mm (US 2.5) straight needles or  
needles needed to achieve gauge

## YARDAGE

mc - 60 (91)meters / 66 (100) yards  
cc - 18 (18) meters / 20 (20) yards

## NOTIONS

Tapestry needle

## GAUGE

28 sts x 24 rows = 10cm / 4"



## CONSTRUCTION

The scarf / headband is knitted flat and worked back and forth. Colourwork is done using three strands of cc with the roosimine technique. For right side row (odd number), chart is read from right to left. For wrong side row (even number), chart is read from left to right.

## ABBREVIATIONS

cc - contrasting colour  
co - cast on  
dec - decrease(s)  
inc - increase(s)

k - knit stitch  
kfb - knit front and back  
mc - main colour  
pw - purl wise

rs - right side  
sl - slip one stitch  
st(s) - stitch(es)  
ws - wrong side

## FINAL MEASUREMENTS

sizes - 1 (2)  
headband - length x width: 94 x 11.5cm / 37 x 4.5"  
scarf - length x width: 68 x 6cm / 26.75 x 2.25"

## BEGIN PATTERN

Using one strand of mc, co 3 (3) sts.

Row 1&2: S1 PW, K to end.

Tip: Always slip the first stitch purl wise regardless of rs or ws to keep your borders neat.

## INCREASES

Row 1 (rs): S1 PW, KFB, K to end. (1inc) [4sts, 4sts]


Row 2 (ws) to 6: S1 PW, K to end.

Rep Row 1 to 6 for 13 (27) more times for a total of 14 (28) increases and 17 (31) sts.

Work should measure 17 (37)cm / 6.75 (14.5)" from cast on edge.

## BODY

CC is worked in three strands. Work top chart for narrower scarf and bottom chart for wider scarf. Repeat for a total of 12 (6) times or until desired length is reached.



## DECREASES

Row 1 (rs): S1 PW, K2tog, K to end. (1dec) [16 sts, 30sts]

Row 2 (ws) to 6: S1 PW WYF, K to end.

Rep Row 1-6 for 12 (26) more times for a total of 13 (27) times and (3) 3 sts.

Work measures 68 (94) cm / 26.75 (37)" from cast-on edge.

## FINISHING

Bind off. Weave in all ends. Wet block to shape.

## ROOSIMINE TECHNIQUE

Step 1: Knit the main colour stitches as you normally would according to the chart. When you get to a colourwork stitch, use three strands of contrasting colour, lay it in between the stitches on your needles.

Right side: The tail goes in the back and the working yarn goes in the front.

Wrong side, the working yarn goes to the back and the tail goes in the front.



Step 2: Using main colour, knit the number of stitches of contrasting colour marked on the chart.



Step 3: Right side: When you finish the sequence, drape your cc working yarn and move it from the front to the back between your needles. Continue knitting in main colour stitches according to the chart.

Wrong side: When you finish the sequence, drape your cc working yarn and move it from the back to the front between your needles. Continue knitting in main colour stitches according to the chart.
