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**Yoda Slippers**  
The pattern

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**MAY THE FORCE BE WITH YOU**



## Intro

The instructions are written in US terms, for man's size (M-slipper) and woman's size (W-slipper). If you are making the slippers for a man choose M-slipper part of the pattern and ignore W-slipper part. If you are making the slippers for a woman choose W-slipper and ignore M-slipper.

## Finished foot length:

M (man) for size: 10.5"—11" (26.5—28 cm)

W (woman) for size: 9,5"—10" (24—25.5 cm)

There are instructions in the pattern how to change the size of the slippers if your foot is bigger or smaller than the numbers above. See the Foot and Heel section, *the notes written in italic*.

## Materials

- DK or worsted weight yarn (green, brown, beige). I used 50% Wool 50% Acrylic yarn, 100 g./3.53 Oz—240 mt./262 yds.
- 3.5 mm /E and 3mm crochet hooks
- tapestry needle
- black embroidery floss

## Gauge

5 sts = 1"

## Abbreviations

R = round/row

lp(s) = loop(s)

st(s) = stitch(es)

ch = chain

ch1 (2, 3, etc) = quantity of chs

sl st = slip stitch

sl st 1 (2, 3, etc) = quantity of sl sts

sc = single crochet

sc1 (2, 3, etc) = quantity of scs

inc = increase (single crochet twice in the same stitch)

inc1 (2, 3, etc) = quantity of incs

dec = decrease (single crochet 2 stitches together )

dec1 (2, 3, etc) = quantity of decs

in BLO = crochet in the back loop only

in FLO = crochet in the front loop only

WS = Wrong Side

RS = Right Side

## Notes

The Toe (after R2) is worked in joined, turned rounds. Rounds are joined with sl st into the first sc. Sl st at the end of the round is counted as the first stitch at the beginning of the next round. When, starting a piece, the pattern calls for a «ring», use whatever ring you would like: a slip knot, double ring, an adjustable loop, etc. The tail from the ring should be tightened, sewn into the piece and cut.

## Toe

With Brown and 3.5 mm /E crochet hook.

Ch7.

R1: sc1 into the second ch from hook, sc4, sc3 into the last ch; working along opposite side of chain, sc4, sc2 into the last ch (14), sl st into the first sc to join, ch1.

R2: inc1, sc4, inc3, sc4, inc2 (20), sl st into the first sc to join, ch1, turn.

Now continue to crochet in joined, turned rounds. Do not forget to count sl st as the first stitch of the round.

R3: (WS) sc1 in each sc around (20), sl st to join, ch1, turn.

R4: sc1, inc1, sc4, (sc1, inc1) repeat 3 times, sc4, (sc1, inc1) repeat 2 times (26), sl st to join, ch1, turn.

R5: sc1 in each sc around (26), sl st to join, ch1, turn.

R6: sc2, inc1, sc4, (sc2, inc1) repeat 3 times, sc4, (sc2, inc1) repeat 2 times (32), sl st to join, ch1, turn.

R7: sc1 in each sc around (32), sl st to join, ch1, turn.

R8: sc3, inc1, sc4, (sc3, inc1) repeat 3 times, sc4, (sc3, inc1) repeat 2 times (38), sl st to join, ch1, turn.

R9: sc1 in each sc around (38), sl st to join, ch1, turn.

R10: sc4, inc1, sc4, (sc4, inc1) repeat 3 times, sc4, (sc4, inc1) repeat 2 times (44), sl st to join, ch1, turn.

R11: sc1 in each sc around (44), sl st to join, ch1, turn.

### M-slipper:

R12: sc5, inc1, sc4, (sc5, inc1) repeat 3 times, sc4, (sc5, inc1) repeat 2 times (50), sl st to join, ch1, turn.

R13—R16: sc1 in each sc around (50), sl st to join, ch1, turn.

### W-slipper:

R12—R14: sc1 in each sc around (44), sl st to join, ch1, turn.

## Foot and Heel

Change to Beige in the last sc of the last round. See photos 1 and 2.

Now with Beige: sl st to join, ch1, turn and continue Single Crochet in Rows.

### M-slipper:

R1: make 36 scs only, then ch1 and turn (36).

R2—R10: sc1 in each sc along (36), ch1, turn.

R11: inc1, sc34, inc1 (38), ch1, turn.

R12—R34: sc1 in each sc along (38), ch1, turn.

*If your foot length is more than 10.5"—11" (26.5—28 cm) make 2 more rows here. If it's less than 10.5"—11" (26.5—28 cm) make 2 rows less.*



Start making heel now.

R35: sc13, (dec1, sc3) repeat 2 times, dec1, sc13 (35), ch1, turn.

R36: sc13, (dec1, sc2) repeat 2 times, dec1, sc12 (32), ch1, turn.

R37: sc12, (dec1, sc1) repeat 2 times, dec1, sc12 (29), ch1, turn.

R38: sc12, dec3, sc11 (26).

Do not fasten off and proceed to make a back seam with sl sts on the WS. If you wish you can fasten off and sew the back seam with a tapestry needle.

#### W-slipper:

R1: make 30 scs only, then ch1 and turn (30).

R2—R10: sc1 in each sc along (30), ch1, turn.

R11: inc1, sc28, inc1 (32), ch1, turn.

R12—R20: sc1 in each sc along (32), ch1, turn.

R21: sc1, inc1, sc28, inc1, sc1 (34), ch1, turn.

R22—R31: sc1 in each sc along (34), ch1, turn.

*If your foot length is more than 9,5"—10" (24—25.5 cm), make 2 more rows here. If it's less than 9,5"—10" (24—25.5 cm) make 2 rows less.*

Start making heel now.

R32: sc11, (dec1, sc3) repeat 2 times, dec1, sc11 (31), ch1, turn.

R33: sc11, (dec1, sc2) repeat 2 times, dec1, sc10 (28), ch1, turn.

R34: sc10, (dec1, sc1) repeat 2 times, dec1, sc10 (25), ch1, turn.

R35: sc10, dec3, sc9 (22).

Do not fasten off and proceed to make a back seam with sl sts on the WS. If you wish you can fasten off and sew the back seam with a tapestry needle.

#### **Head**

With Green and 3.5 mm /E crochet hook.

Leave a long tale when you make a slip knot. Take your slipper with the tip of the Toe pointed away from you. Now work with remaining brown sts of the Toe.

R1: join green yarn with sc to the same brown st where the last st of the first beige row is (on the right at the moment). Make another 15 scs.

See photos 3 and 4 on the next page.

*Note, that the last green sc is going into the same brown st where the Beige was joined to the Toe (on the left at the moment).*

Finally, you have 16 scs for the Yoda's head. Ch1, turn.

R2—R11: sc1 in each sc along (16), ch1, turn.

R12: dec1, sc12, dec1 (14), ch1, turn.

R13: dec1, sc10, dec1 (12), ch1, turn.

R14: dec1, sc8, dec1 (10), ch1, turn.

R15: dec1, sc6, dec1 (8), ch1, turn.

R16: dec1, sc4, dec1 (6).

Fasten off. Sew the Head to the Foot on both sides matching green rows with beige rows (about 10 rows). See photo 5. Top off the Foot with scs along the edge making dec1 or dec2 at the back seam. Use 3mm crochet hook for that.



**Ear** (make 2)

With Green and 3.5 mm /E crochet hook.

Leave a long tale for sewing when you make a slip knot.

Ch8.

R1: sc1 into the 2nd ch from hook, sc6 (7), ch1, turn.

R2: dec1, sc3, dec1 (5), ch1, turn.

R3: sc1 in each sc along (5), ch1, turn.

R4: dec1, sc1, dec1 (3), ch1, turn.

R5—R6: sc1 in each sc along (3), ch1, turn.

R7: skip sc1, dec1.

Fasten off, weave in end.

**Arm** (make 2)

With 3.5 mm /E crochet hook. Begin with Beige.

Leave a long tale for sewing when you make a slip knot.

Ch6.

R1: sc1 into the second ch from hook, sc4 (5), ch1, turn.

R2—R10: sc1 in each sc along (5), ch1, turn.

R11: sc1 in each sc along (5), change to Green, ch1, turn. Leave a long beige tale for sewing.

Continue with Green.

R12 in FLO: sc1 in each sc along (5), ch3, turn.

R13: (sc1, sl st1, ch3) repeat 2 times, sc1 and sl st1 into the same st.

Fasten off, weave in end.

**Eyelid** (make 2)

With Green and 3.5 mm /E crochet hook.

*Note: The eyelid are worked in normal joined rounds.*

R1: sc6 into a ring (6).

R2: inc6 (12).



Fasten off leaving a long tale for sewing.



## Finishing

Bend the Ears (see scheme 1) and sew them to the Head. Sew on Eyelids. Embroider nose and wrinkles with green yarn, eyes and mouth with black embroidery floss. Use the photos on the page 2 of this pattern as a reference.

Sew arms as shown in photos 6 and 7. Then fold arms, find the position that you like and sew them on the Toe along the red lines in photo 8.
