KNITTING NEEDLES

3.25mm (US3) 12 - 16" circular needles (optional), a set of double pointed needles

4.0 mm (US6) 12 - 16" circular needles (optional), a set of double pointed needles

YARN

1) Green : The Loop with a leaf

Sport weight, *Shaliman Sport Enzo* , Loden : about 38 m (12 - 13 g)

2) Pumpkin Body (Dark Orange colour)

Worst weight, *Lion Brand Heartland* , Yosemite : about 52 m (32 g)

3) Pumpkin Body (Light Beige)

Worst weight, *Bernat Wool-up* , Caramel tweeds : about 52 m (24 - 25g)

NOTIONS 5 markers , tapestry needle

ABBREVIATIONS

BO : bind off

BOR : beginning of round

CDD : center double decrease

CO : cast on

dpn(s) : double pointed needle(s)

EOR : end of row

k : knit

kfb : knit in front and back

k tbl : knit through back loop

k2tog : knit 2sts together

M: marker

M1L : make 1 st left

M1R : make 1 st right

p : purl

PM : place marker

p tbl : purl through back loop

R : row

rep : repeat

RS : right side

sl1p : slip 1 stitch purl wise

st(s) : stitch(es)

WS : wrong side

wyif : with yarn in front

▪ How to make an I-cord :

- 1) knit sts on dpn normally,
- 2) slide the sts from one end of dpn to the other
- 3) without turning dpn, place the dpn on your left hand
- 4) pulling the yarn so that it is snug, knit sts from left to the right dpn

The Loop with a Leaf

3.25 mm (US3) dpns, Green colour ; Work in round

CO 3 sts

R1	k in round as when you work I-cord	
R2	(kfb) x 3	[6 sts]
R3	k in round	
R4	(k1, M1R, k1, M1L, k1) x 2	[10 sts]
R5	k in round	
R6	(k2, M1R, k1, M1L, k2) x 2	[14 sts]
R7	k in round	
R8	(k3, M1R, k1, M1L, k3) x 2	[18 sts]
R9	k in round	
R10	(k4, M1R, k1, M1L, k4) x 2	[22 sts]
R11	k in round	
R12	(k5, M1R, k1, M1L, k5) x 2	[26 sts]
R13	k in round	
R14	(k6, M1R, k1, M1L, k6) x 2	[30sts]
R15	k in round	
R16	[(k1, M1R) x 3, k4, M1R, k1, M1L, k4, (M1L, k1) x 3] x 2	[46 sts]




Pumpkin Pouch

Join stitches on needle #1 & #4 in round as shown in photo-1 & 2.

- R1 k8 (on needle #1), place center 3sts onto marker or scrap yarn, join to needle #4, k8 (work in round)
- R2 SSK, k12, k2tog
- R3 SSK, k10, k2tog
- R4 SSK, SSK, k4, k2tog, k2tog [8 sts]

Cut yarn. Thread through the remaining stitches. Pull tightly.



Join stitches on needle #2 & #3 in round as shown in photo-1 & 2.

- R1 k8 (on needle #2), join to needle #3, k8
- R2 k6, k2tog, SSK, k6
- R3 k5, k2tog, SSK, k5 [8 sts]
- R4 k2, k2tog, k2tog, SSK, SSK, k2

Cut yarn. Thread through the remaining stitches. Pull tightly.



Place 3 sts onto 3.25 mm (US3) dpn,
work on 3sts I-cord until it measures about 40 cm.

Join the I-cord with 3 sts from marker or scrap yarn on the other side,
as shown in photo-3 & 4. You have 6 sts on 1 dpn. Keep working on I-cord as below.

- Next R (k2tog) x 3 [3 sts]

For next 5 Rows, work on 3sts I-cord.


- Next R k, kfb, k [4 sts]

Keep working 4 sts I-cord until it measures 5 cm to make a stem.

Cut yarn.

Using a tapestry needle,
thread through the remaining stitches.
Pull tightly.

Tie a knot with the stem
to close the leaf.



Pumpkin Pouch

POUCH BODY

Stretchy hem

3.25 mm (US3) dpns, Green colour ; Work flat

Provisional CO 35 sts

R1(WS) p2, (k1, p1) to the last 1 st, p1

R2(RS) k2, (p1, k1) to the last 1 st, k1

Rep. R1(WS)-R2(RS), 7 more times.

Next R(WS) Rep. R1(WS)

Fold in half, put the Loop with a Leaf in between.

Place 2 needles parallel to each other :

needle #1 : stitches from provisional CO

needle #2 : stitches on working needle

Next R knit 2 sts together **from both needles** as shown in the photo-5



Body

Change needle to 4.0 mm (US6) ; Pumpkin colour ; Work flat

Set-up R(WS) p to EOR

R1(RS) sl1p, k2, PM, (p1, k1tbl, p1, k4, PM) x 4, p1, k1tbl, p1, k1tbl [35 sts]

R2(WS) sl1p, k1, p1tbl, k1, (p4, k1, p1tbl, k1) x 4, p2, p1tbl

R3(RS) sl1p, M1L, k1, M1L, k1, (p1, k1tbl, p1, k1, M1R, k2, M1L, k1) x 4, p1, k1tbl, p1, M1R, k1t [46 sts]

R4(WS) sl1p, p1, k1, p1tbl, k1, (p6, k1, p1tbl, k1) x 4, p4, p1tbl

R5(RS) sl1p, k1, (k1, M1L) x 2, k1, {p1, k1tbl, p1, (k1, M1R) x 2, k2, (M1L, k1) x 2} x 4,
p1, k1tbl, p1, M1R, k1, M1R, k1tbl [66 sts]

R6(WS) sl1p, p3, k1, p1tbl, k1, (p10, k1, p1tbl, k1) x 4, p6, p1tbl

R7(RS) sl1p, (k2, M1L) x 2, k2, {p1, k1tbl, p1, (k2, M1R) x 2, (k2, M1L) x 2, k2} x 4
p1, k1tbl, p1, k2, M1R, k1, M1R, k1tbl [86 sts]

Pumpkin Pouch

R8(WS) sl1p, p5, k1, p1tbl, k1, (p14, k1, p1tbl, k1) x 4, p8, p1tbl
R9(RS) sl1p, k8, (p1, k1tbl, p1, k14) x 4, p1, k1tbl, p1, k5, k1tbl
R10 - R13 Rep. R8(WS) - R9(RS)
R14(WS) Rep. R8(WS)

Join and work in round.

R15(RS) work in pattern to the last 1 st, move the last stitch to left needle, k2tog, k8
Marker here is BOR from now.
R16 -R26 work in pattern [85 sts]

R27 (p1, k1tbl, p1, k1, SSK, k8, k2tog, k1) x 5 [75 sts]
R28 work in pattern
R29 (p1, k1tbl, p1, k1, SSK, SSK, k2, k2tog, k2tog, k1) x 5 [55 sts]
R30 work in pattern
R31 (CDD, k2, SSK, k2tog, k2) x 5 [35 sts]
R32 work in pattern
R33 (k1, SSK, k2, k2tog) x 5 [25 sts]
R34 work in pattern
R35 (SSK, k1, k2tog) x 5 [15 sts]
R36 work in pattern

Cut yarn.

Using a tapestry needle, thread through the remaining stitches.

Pull tightly.
