

Canvas Jumper

Knitting Pattern

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Construction:

It's worked seamlessly from the top-down. Some short-rows are worked to create a higher back neck

Size:

XS (S, M, L)(XL, 2XL, 3XL) Sample photo shown in size M.

Measurements:

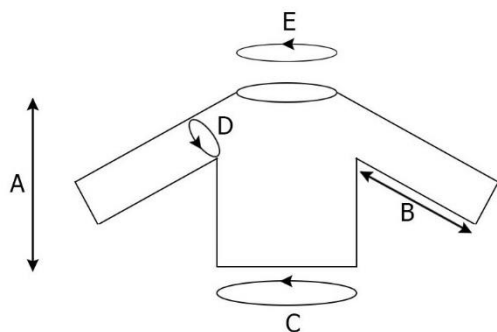
Guage:

22 sts and 30 rows = 10 x 10 cm (4 x 4") in stockinette after blocking.

Recommended ease: 8 ~ 12 cm (3~4.7"). Sample shown with 12 cm (4.7") positive ease.

Please check your guage and adjust needle size accordingly.

Schematic for measurements:



A: 42 (44, 45, 47)(48, 50, 52) cm / 16.5 (17.3, 17.7, 18.5)(18.8, 19.6, 20.4) "

B: 44 (45, 46, 47)(48, 49, 50) cm / 17.3 (17.7, 18.1, 18.5)(18.8, 19.2, 19.6) "

C: 93 (96, 100, 105)(109, 114, 118) cm / 36.6 (37.7, 39.3, 41.3)(42.9, 44.8, 46.4) "

D: 28 (30, 32, 35)(36, 39, 41) cm / 11 (11.8, 12.5, 13.7)(14.1, 15.3, 16.1) "

E: 50 (52, 54, 56)(58, 60, 62) cm / 19.6 (20.4, 21.2, 22)(22.8, 23.6, 24.4) "

Materials:

Yarns :

Olann Sock Lite, 425m/100g, 80% Soperwash Merino, 20% Nylon, Fingering Weight

Colour A: Passe --- 1 (1, 1, 1)(1, 1, 1)skein / 200 (210, 220, 265)(310, 355, 400)m

Colour B: Love Vigilantes --- 1 (1, 1, 2)(2, 2, 2)skein / 400 (410, 425, 470)(515, 560, 600)m

Colour C: Heartbreak --- 1 (1, 1, 2)(2, 2, 2)skein / 400 (410, 425, 470)(515, 560, 600)m

Isager Silk Mohair, 212m/25g, 75% Kid Mohair, 25% Silk

Colour No.0 --- 5 (5, 5, 6)(7, 7, 8) balls

For my sample I held 1 strand of fingering with 1 strand of mohair throughout.

Needles:

4.5mm (7 US) for body, 3.5 mm (4 US) for ribbing

Other Materials:

Stitch markers, Waste yarn

Abbreviations

appro approximately

BO bind off

BOR beginning of the round

CO cast on

CC Contrast color

DS double stitch (German short-rows techniques)

k knit

k2tog knit 2 together (decrease)

kDS knit double stitch (German short-rows techniques)

M1L make one left. With the left hand needle lift loop between stitches from front, and knit through the back loop.

M marker

p purl

pDS purl double stitch (German short-rows techniques)

PM place marker

RM remove marker

RS Right side

rep repeat

rnd(s) round(s)

st(s) stitch(es)

TS Total Stitches

WS Wrong side

[] means repeat sts within brackets

Special techniques

German Short-Rows techniques

1, (RS): Knit to the instructed stitch of the pattern, turn work to WS.

2, (WS): With yarn in front and slip the first stitch purlwise, bring yarn over the needle towards the back and pull tight, creating two loops out of the same stitch, so that double stitch (DS) has been made. Purl to the instructed stitch of the pattern, turn work to RS.

3, (RS): With yarn in front and slip the first stitch purlwise, bring yarn over the needle towards the back and pull tight, create a double stitch (DS) as before, knit the next stitch as usual.

4, When working over double stitch (DS), treat them as a single stitch, knit both loops together on a RS row (kDS), or purl both loops together on a WS row (pDS).

Instructions

With 4.5 mm / 7 US needle, 1 strand of Colour A and 1 strand of mohair held together, CO 76 (80, 84, 88) (92, 96, 100) sts , **PM** and join for working in the round. (Rounds begin at center back neck edge).

Next Rnd: p to end.

Yoke

1st Increase rnd: [k2, M1L] rep to end. TS: 114 (120, 126, 132) (138, 144, 150)

Work short rows to create a higher back neck:

Short-Row 1 (RS): k16 (18, 20, 22)(24, 26, 28), turn.

Short-Row 2 (WS): DS, p to M, **SM**, p16 (18, 20, 22)(24, 26, 28), turn.

Short-Row 3 (RS): DS, k to M, **SM**, k to DS, kDS, k6, turn.

Short-Row 4 (WS): DS, p to M, **SM**, p to DS, pDS, p6, turn.

Short-Row 5 (RS): DS, k to M, **SM**, k to DS, kDS, k6, turn.

Short-Row 6 (WS): DS, p to M, **SM**, p to DS, pDS, p6, turn.

Short-Row 7 (RS): DS, k to M, **SM**, k to DS, kDS, k6, turn.

Short-Row 8 (WS): DS, p to M, **SM**, p to DS, pDS, p6, turn.

Short-Row 9 (RS): DS, k to M.

Next step: k through 1 rnd. (kDS when you come to them)

Then k 8 rnds.

2nd Increase rnd: [k3, M1L] rep to end. TS: 152 (160, 168, 176) (184, 192, 200)

Then k 8 rnds.

3rd Increase rnd: [k4, M1L] rep to end. TS: 190 (200, 210, 220) (230, 240, 250)

Then k 8 rnds.

4th Increase rnd: [k5, M1L] rep to end. TS: 228 (240, 252, 264) (276, 288, 300)

Rnd1: with Colour B and mohair, k to end.

Rnd2: with Colour A and mohair, k to end.

Rep Rnd 1~2 for 3 more times, until you have completed Rnd 8.

5th Increase rnd: with Colour B and mohair, [k6, M1L] rep to end. TS: 266 (280, 294, 308) (322, 336, 350)

Rnd1: with Colour A and mohair, k to end.

Rnd2: with Colour B and mohair, k to end.

Rep Rnd 1~2 for 3 more times, until you have completed Rnd 8.

6th Increase rnd: with Colour A and mohair, [k7, M1L] rep to end. TS: 304 (320, 336, 352) (368, 384, 400)

Rnd1: with Colour B and mohair, k to end.

Rnd2: with Colour A and mohair, k to end.

Rep Rnd 1~2 for 3 more times, until you have completed Rnd 8.

With Colour B and mohair, continue to work in stockinette stitch in rounds until yoke measures

19 (20, 21, 22)(23, 24, 25)cm/ 7.4 (7.8, 8.2, 8.6)(8, 9.4, 9.8)" from center front CO edge.

Dividing Sleeves from Body

With Colour B and mohair:

Dividing Rnd : k 48 (50, 52, 54)(56, 58, 60) sts, place the following 56 (60, 64, 68)(72, 76, 80) sts on a holder, CO

6 (6, 6, 8)(8, 10, 10)sts for right underarm, k 96 (100, 104, 108)(112, 116, 120) sts, place the following

56 (60, 64, 68)(72, 76, 80) sts on a holder, CO 6 (6, 6, 8)(8, 10, 10)sts for left underarm, k to M.

TS: 204 (212, 220, 232)(240, 252, 260)

Body

Section 1 : With Colour B and mohair, k 18 rnds.

Section 2 : Rnd1: with Colour C and mohair, k to end.

Rnd2: with Colour B and mohair, k to end.

Rep Rnd 1~2 for 12 more times, until you have completed Rnd 26.

Section 3 : With Colour C and mohair, continue to work in stockinette stitch in rounds until measures 19 (20, 21, 22)(23, 24, 25)cm/ 7.4 (7.8, 8.2, 8.6)(9, 9.4, 9.8)" from underarm edge.(Or until desired length)

Ribbing

Change to 3.5mm/ 4 US needle, with Colour C and mohair:

Rnd 1 : k to end.

Rnd 2 : [k1, p1] rep to end.

Rep last Rnd until ribbing measures approx. 5 cm / 1.9 " .

BO in pattern.

Sleeves (Both alike)

With Colour B and mohair, use 4.5 mm/ 7 US needle, beginning at center of underarm, pick up and k 3 (3, 3, 4)(4, 5, 5) sts along the underarm CO edge, then work the held sleeve sts: k 56 (60, 64, 68)(72, 76, 80) sts, pick up and k 3 (3, 3, 4)(4, 5, 5) sts along the left underarm CO edge, **PM** for BOR, join to work in the round. TS: 62 (66, 70, 76)(80, 86, 90)

Section 1 : With Colour B and mohair, k 18 rnds.

Section 2 : Rnd1: with Colour C and mohair, k to end.

Rnd2: with Colour B and mohair, k to end.

Rep Rnd 1~2 for 12 more times, until you have completed Rnd 26.

Section 3 : With Colour C and mohair, continue to work in stockinette stitch in rounds until measures 39 (40, 41, 42)(43, 44, 45)cm/ 15.3 (15.7, 16.1, 16.5)(16.9, 17.3, 17.7)" from underarm edge.(Or until desired length)

Decrease rnd:

XS, S, M, 2XL, 3XL: [k2tog] rep to last 2 sts, k2.

L, XL: [k2tog] rep to end.

TS: 32 (34, 36, 38)(40, 44, 46)

Ribbing

Change to 3.5mm/ 4 US needle, with Colour C and mohair:

Rnd 1 : k to end.

Rnd 2 : [k1, p1] rep to end.

Rep last Rnd until ribbing measures approx. 5 cm / 1.9 " .

BO in pattern. (With any preferred stretchy BO method)

Neck Finishing

With Colour C and mohair, use 4.5mm/ 7 US needle, pick up stitches from CO edge and BO loosely.

Finishing

Weave in ends and block to measurements.
