



LOVE IN A MIST HAT

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MATERIALS:

Yarn

Maincolour (MC, gray in chart): Bohei Trallafitti Merino Single Linen (366m / 100gr) ca. 32gr

Contrasting colour (CC, red in chart): Syincycle Yarns, Dyed in the wool, Fb. Rusted Rainbow, ca. 17 gr

Needles

3.0mm and 3,75mm , 40cm long circular needle and a set 3,75 double-point needles.

1 stitch marker

1 tapestry needle

Gauge:

Knit in the round, with 3.75mm needles, in colourwork pattern:

25 st/32rds = 4x4'' / 10x10cm

Technique:

The hat is worked using the fairisle (stranded colourwork) technique with 2 colours.

The yarn not in use must be carried loosely across the back of the work and trapped by twisting it with the working yarn every 5 st.

Make sure to shift the twisting place on the following row.

ABBREVIATIONS AND EXPLANATIONS

st	stitch/stitches
k	knit
p	purl
rd/rds	round/rounds
CDD	Centered double decrease
BOR	beginning of round
MC	main colour
CC	contrasting colour
M	stitch marker

INSTRUCTIONS:

Cuff:

With MC yarn, cast on 120 st loosely on the 3.0mm needles, place M (BOR). Join into the round, being careful not to twist the stitches.

Rd 1: knit

Rds 2 to 16: * k1, p1 *, repeat to the end.

Rd 17: knit.

Switch to 3,75mm ndl.

Next rnd: knit.

Now join CC yarn and work the **CHART**.

The pattern is worked 5 times around.

After round 64 break MC and CC yarn and pull the remaining 10st together.

Cut and carefully weave in all yarn ends. Wet block your knitting.
