Design Jenny Alderbrant

Please read the whole pattern before you start

This is what you will need to knit a pair:

Fingering yarn that is about 175-210m/50 gr. 1 skein of each color + a little bit of black and yellow yarn.

2-3mm DPNs or circular needles

Stitchholder or some scrap yarn to hold the thumb stitches

Tapestry needle to weave in loose ends

Gauge for the mittens is about 35 st/4 inches or 10 cm in stranded knitting with 2 colors.

You can adjust the size by changing the gauge

Higher gauge- smaller mittens Lower gauge- larger mittens

Stitches and short terms used

k-knit

p-purl

☐ 2tog-knit 2st together as one - Right leaning decrease

☐ S1k1psso- slip1 kw, k1, pass slipped st over knitted.- Left leaning decrease.

*Chart is read from right to left for right mitten and from left to right for left mitten.

X in the chart means no stitch and you should read and knit next st.

Red sts can be embroidered afterwards and if you do just knit those st in maincolor.



Cuff

Cast on 72 st using double needles in one of the colors.

* Purl 1 row and after that knit garter st (k 1 row, p 1 row) for a total of 6 rows

*Follow the chart for the cuff using smaller needles.

*Knit 1 row in maincolor of your choice

*Follow the chart for the mitten.

*When you get to the stitches marked with ☐ place those 15 st on holder or some scrap yarn and co 15 new st behind them using your working yarn.

*Keep following the chart and decrease for the top when you get to decreasing symbols.

*When you have approx 8 st left cut yarn and pull it through the remaining st and through the top. Tighten.

Thumb

*Place your 15 st from your st holder or scrapyarn and knit them following chart for thumb.

*Pick up and knit 17 more st around the hole.

*Keep knitting the thumb following the chart.

*Top of thumb is decreased and finished the same way as the mitten.

*Block your mittens and leave them to dry in the shape you want.

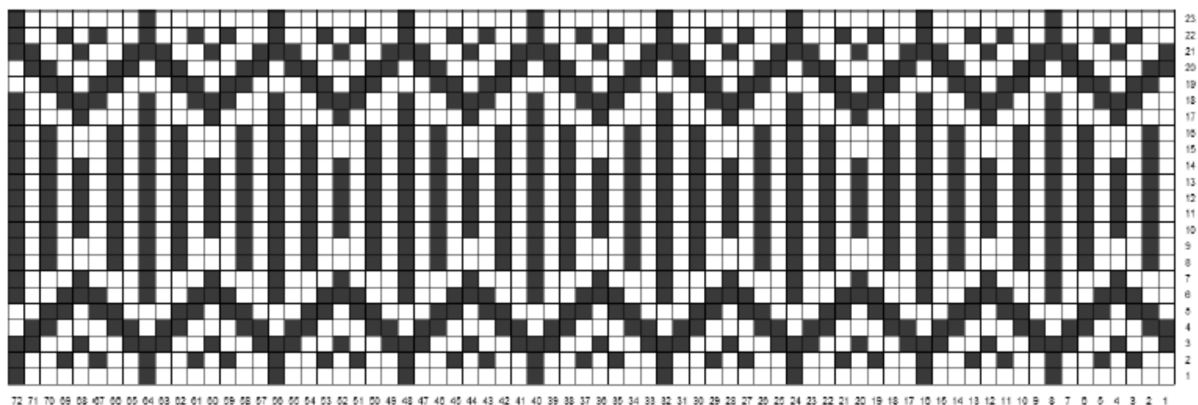

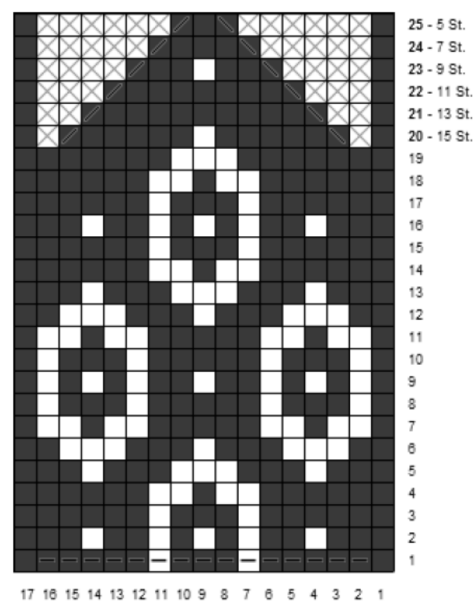
