





Dimensions when completed Width at top edge approx. 160 cm / 63 in; height at back midpoint approx. 76 cm / 30 in

Demand Novita Woolly Wood

(281) Fall Colours 150 g,

(358) Tussock 100 g,

(384) Pine <100 g and

(010) Off White 50 g

Circular needles (80 cm / 32 in) Novita 4½–5 mm (UK 6–7 / US 7–8) or size needed to obtain gauge

Stitch patterns *Garter stitch*: knit all rows. *Seed stitch*: Row 1: *k1, p1*, repeat *–*. Row 2: purl the knit sts and knit the purl sts. Keep repeating row 2. *Textured pattern*: Row 1: *k2, p2*, repeat *–*. Row 2: knit the knit sts and purl the purl sts. Row 3: *p2, k2*, repeat *–*. Row 4: knit the knit sts and purl the purl sts. Keep repeating rows 1–4. *Stockinette stitch*: knit the right side rows and purl the wrong side rows. *Colourwork*: follow the chart and instructions. *Lace pattern*: follow the chart and instructions.

Gauge 20 sts in garter st = 10 cm / 4 in

Note The shawl is started at the midpoint of the top back edge and knitted downwards.

Using *Fall Colours*, cast on 7 sts and knit 1 row. Place a marker at the centre st.

Row 1: (RS) k2, yarn over (yo), k1, yo, k1 (centre st), yo, k1, yo, k2 = 11 sts.

Row 2: (WS) k11.

Row 3: k2, yo, k3, yo, k1 (centre st), yo, k3, yo, k2 = 15 sts.

Row 4: k15.

Keep increasing in this manner at both ends and on either side of the centre st for the whole of the work. 4 sts increased on every increase row.

When the side of the shawl measures 20 cm (do not measure at the centre st), switch to *Pine*. Keep increasing and working the centre st and 2 sts at both ends in garter st. With the other sts, work seed st for 7 cm.

Now work garter st, alternating *Fall Colours* and *Tussock*: *2 rows in *Fall Colours*, 2 rows in *Tussock**, repeat *–* 3 times in total.

Using *Pine*, work garter st for 2 rows.

Join *Off White* and work as follows: k2, yo, *k3, slip 1 with yarn in back*, repeat *–* to centre st, yo, k1 (centre st), yo, mirror right side.

Switch to *Pine* and work as before but always slip the middle white st. Repeat row in both colours once more.

Using *Off White*, work garter st for 2 rows.

Eyelet row: k2, yo, k1, *k2tog, yo*, repeat *–* to last 1–2 st(s) before centre st, k1–2, yo, k1 (centre st), yo. Mirror right side: knit same number of sts as before centre st, *yo, skp (slip 1 knitwise, k1, pass the slipped st over)*, repeat *–* to last 3 sts, k1, yo, k2.

Purl 1 row, then work 2 rows in garter st.

Using *Tussock*, work textured pattern for 7 cm.

Work garter st, alternating *Fall Colours* and *Pine*: *2 rows in *Fall Colours*, 2 rows in *Pine**, repeat *–* 3 times in total, work 2 more rows in garter st using *Fall Colours*.

Switch to *Off White* and work 2 rows in stockinette st.

Also join *Tussock* and begin the colourwork pattern on row 1 of chart I: work 4 sts at the right end of the chart, repeat 8 st pattern repeat to centre st, yo using *Off White*, work centre st, yo, mirror right side. Work rows 2–8 of the chart.

Using *Off White*, work stockinette st for 2 rows.

Join *Fall Colours* and begin the lace pattern on row 1 of chart II: k2, yo, repeat 11 st pattern until there are not enough sts before centre st for a full repeat, work garter st to centre st, yo, work centre st, yo, mirror right side. Work row 2 of the lace chart, then keep repeating rows 1–2 until the shawl measures approx. 76 cm at the centre st. Loosely bind off in garter st.

Finishing

Pin to measurements wrong side up, mist and allow to dry.




- = knit st (358) Tussock, purl on WS rows
- = purl st, knit on WS rows
- = slip 1 st knitwise, k1, pass the slipped st over
- = knit 2 sts together
- = yarn over
