

# Sweet Moon Mitts



Here's a pair of sweet mitts to wear while staying up late writing, reading a book, or just gazing out the window at the moon with your chin in your hands.

**Needles:** US 2/2.75 mm dpns or size to obtain gauge

**Yarns used:**

Knit Picks Palette (fingering, 100% wool, 231 yards/211 meters):

MC: Navy 24001, 1 skein

CC: Mist 23733, 1 skein

**Gauge:**

36 sts and 38 rows per 4"/10cm in pattern.

**Notions:**

Yarn needle and extra yarn or stitch holder for holding thumb stitches

Marker for thumb stitches



**Stitches:**

Twisted Rib: Knit one through back loop, purl one. Repeat to end of round.

**Both Gloves, Cuff:**

Cast on 56 stitches in MC and join in round, being careful not to twist. Work in twisted rib until piece measures 1 inch.

**Left Glove:** On first 28 stitches, work the first row of Chart 1 (Left Hand). On second 28, work the first row of chart 3 (palm). Work in pattern until row 25 of chart.

**Left Glove Thumb Gusset:** Work Left hand Chart 1 as written, and Palm chart 3 for 22 stitches. 6 stitches remain in row. Place marker. Begin thumb gusset as shown in

chart 4 with a yarnover. Place marker. Continue as established, working thumb gusset in between markers.

When thumb gusset is complete (row 19 of thumb chart, row 44 of palm chart) put the stitches on a piece of yarn or a stitch holder. On the next row, continue in both charts as established. Be sure it pull stitches snugly over the thumb.

**Right glove:** On first 28 stitches, work the first row of chart 2. On second 28, work the first row of chart 3. Work in pattern until row 25 of chart.

**Right Glove Thumb Gusset:** Work Left hand Chart 1 as written, and Palm chart 3 for 6 stitches. 22 stitches remain in row. Place marker. Begin thumb gusset as shown in chart 4 with a yarnover. Place marker. Continue as established, working thumb gusset in between markers.

When thumb gusset is complete (row 19 of thumb chart, 44 of palm chart) put the stitches on a piece of yarn or a stitch holder. On the next row, continue in both charts as established. Be sure it pull stitches snugly over the thumb.

### **Both gloves**

Knit to the end of both charts.

### **Top Ribbing**

Work  $\frac{1}{2}$  inch of twisted rib and bind off in pattern.

### **Thumb Finishing**


Take the 17 stitches off the stitch holder on the thumb gusset. Pick up 3 additional stitches at the top of the gusset. 20 stitches. Work in Twisted Rib in round for  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch and bind off in pattern.

### **Finishing**


Weave in all ends. Block.

## Charts


1 - Left Glove




2 - Right Glove
