

Lingerie socks

I love the look of the knitted lingerie of the 1940's. Feminine details like a wide lace border at the hem of a camisole, a lace insertion at the neckline, broad ribbing with a small lace pattern, and narrow 1x1 ribbing in places where you'd want a little shaping. But I'm not sure that knitted underwear would be very practical. So I've gathered all these details into something more wearable, a delicate lace sock.

Lingerie socks

Sizing

S[M, L, XL]

To fit foot circumference: 7 [8, 9, 10] inches

17.5 [20, 22.5, 25] cm

Finished foot length: 8.5 [9, 9.5, 10] inches

21 [23, 25, 27] cm

Yarn

Regia Silk, 210 m/50 g, appr. 70 [80, 90, 100] g

Other suggestions: Online Supersocke Silk,

KnitPicks Gloss, Panda Silk

Needles

1.75 mm/ US 00 and 2.0 mm/ US 0

DPNs or circular/s or size needed to get gauge

Gauge

9 sts, 12 rows per inch/2.5 cm in stockinette

Abbreviations

st: *Stitch*

k: *Knit*

p: *Purl*

tbl: *Through the back of the loop.*

yo: *Yarn over.*

k2tog: *Knit two stitches together.*

ssk: *Slip two stitches knitwise from left to right needle. Slip back to the left needle and knit together through the back of the loops.*

p2tog: *Purl two stitches together.*

k3tog: *Knit three stitches together.*

sssk: *Slip three stitches knitwise from left to right needle. Slip back to the left needle and knit together through the back of the loops.*

p3tog: *Purl three stitches together.*

sk2po: *Slip 1, knit 2 together, pass slipped stitch over.*

sskpo: *Work ssk, slip back to left needle, pass next stitch over, slip to right needle.*

Special stitches

Picot stitch

Knit 1, slip it back to the left-hand needle, pass the next 8 stitches over this stitch. Make a yarn over, and knit the stitch again. This results in a yarn over and a normal stitch. 7 sts decreased.

Wrapped yarn-over stitches

These special wrapped stitches create a clean yarnover outline of the heel and instep shaping.

Wrapped yarn-over stitch, knit

With yarn in front, slip the next stitch purlwise. Insert the right needle through the yarn-over in the row below, from the back to the front, and pull through a loop (a new stitch). With the left needle, pass the slipped stitch over the new stitch.

Wrapped yarn-over stitch, purl

With yarn in back, slip the next stitch as if to purl through the back loop (twisted). Insert the right needle through the yarn-over in the row below, from the front to the back, and pull through a loop (a new stitch). With the left needle, pass the slipped stitch over the new stitch.

Notes

The lace cuff is knit on smaller needles because otherwise the lace tends to become wider than the rest of the sock. To accommodate a wider calf, knit the lace cuff on the same size needles as the rest of the sock.

First published in Knitty First Fall 2011. This is an expanded version, with two more sizes, three different cuff lengths and a rounded toe option.

Lace cuff

With 1.75 mm/US 00 needles, cast on 105 [120, 135, 150] sts using the long tail method. Divide sts on DPNs or circular/s. Join for working in the round, being careful not to twist the cast on row.

Picot round:

*K1, yo, ssk, k1, picot stitch, k2tog, yo; repeat from * to end. 56 [54, 72, 80] sts

Choose a Cuff Chart (Short, Medium, Long), and work it until it is complete. (Photos show the long cuff.)

Leg

Change to 2.0 mm/US 0 needle/s. Knit 0 [4, 0, 4] sts. This is now the beginning of the round, center back.

Leg Chart

The Leg Chart is provided in two formats, the whole chart on one page, or separated into a Left and Right half, to be joined in the middle.

The round starts and ends in the middle of the Leg Chart. Start with stitch 1, work across to the left, then continue on the right hand side towards the middle. The last stitch of the round is on the same line as the first stitch of the next round.

Choose the appropriate chart, and work until complete. When the Leg Chart is complete, the ribbed gusset will have 33 [37, 41, 45] sts, including the wrapped yarn-over stitches at each end. 68 [78, 86, 94] sts

Heel

The short row heel is worked over 29 [33, 37, 41] sts.



Making the yarn-over pairs

Right side

Bring yarn to front of work. Insert needle into the stitch knitwise, and bring yarn to the back over the needle and knit the first stitch. This will create a yarn over paired with a normal stitch.

Wrong side

Bring yarn to back of work. Insert right needle into the stitch purlwise, bring yarn forward over needle and purl the stitch. This creates another yarn-over pairing.

Top of Heel

Work 15 [17, 19, 21] sts in twisted rib pattern as established, turn. Slip the first stitch as if to purl through the back of the loop, and put it back on the left needle. Make a yarn-over pair, work 28 [32, 36, 40] sts in twisted rib pattern (the p sts are worked tbl). Turn.

Make a yarn-over pair, work 27 [31, 35, 39] sts in twisted rib pattern, turn.

Wrong side

Make a yo pair, work across in twisted rib pattern (the p sts are worked tbl) until the first yarn-over pair. Turn.

(When the first stitch on the wrong side is a purl stitch, slip it as if to purl through the back of the loop, and put it back on the left needle, then make a yarn-over pair.)

Right side

Make a yarn-over pair, work across in twisted rib pattern until the first yarn-over pair. Turn

Continue to create yarn-over pairs at each end of the row until 13 [15, 17, 19] stitches remain between, but not counting the yarn-over pairs. You will have 8 [9, 10, 11] yarn-over pairs on each side, ending on a right side row.

Bottom of Heel

Now the twisted ribbing stops, and the sole of the heel is worked in stockinette.

Work in twisted rib pattern until the first yarn-over pair. Knit the next stitch (the normal stitch in the first yarn-over pair). Turn.

Make a yarn-over pair, p14 [16, 18, 20]. Slip the next stitch purlwise (yarn over-stitch

Decreasing the yarn-over pairs

To work the k3tog

Knit the next three stitches (two yarn-over stitches and the normal stitch from the next yarn-over pair) together.

To work the p3tog tbl

Slip the next two stitches purlwise (two yarn-over stitches), slip the normal stitch knitwise, place the stitches back on the left needle one by one, and purl the stitches through the back loop.

OR

Slip the stitches as directed, put them back on left needle. Purl the first stitch tbl, put it back on the left needle, then with yarn in front, pass the next two stitches over. Slip stitch over to right needle, and tighten the yarn.

from the next yarn-over pair), slip the normal stitch knitwise, place the stitches back on the left needle one by one, and purl the two stitches through the back of the loop. Turn.

Right side

Make a yarn-over pair, knit across the row stopping after the normal stitch in the first yarn-over pair, k3tog. Turn.

Wrong side

Make a yarn-over pair, purl across the row stopping after the normal stitch in the first yarn-over pair, p3tog tbl. Turn.

Continue in this manner creating a yarn-over pair at the beginning of each row, and decreasing three stitches at the end of each row. When all the yarn-over pairs have been decreased, you will have two lonely yarn-overs left on each side.

You should now be on a wrong side row. Using the normal stitch that was not included in the heel turning, p3tog tbl. Turn.

Make a yarn-over pair, knit until the two yarn-overs on the right side. Using the normal stitch that was not included in the heel turning, k3tog. Turn.

Make a yarn-over pair, purl across the row stopping after the normal stitch. Slip the yarn-over stitch, and then pick up the topmost leg of the normal stitch from the decrease on the previous row. (This will tighten the next normal stitch.) Slip the next stitch (the wrapped stitch) knitwise, and put all three stitches back on the left needle, and p3tog tbl. Turn.

Do not make a yarn-over!

Slip the first stitch, and knit across, stopping after the normal stitch. Slip the yarn-over stitch, and then pick up the topmost leg of the normal stitch from the decrease on the previous row, slip the next stitch (the wrapped stitch) knitwise, and put them all back on the left needle and k3tog.

When the heel is finished you will again have 68 [78, 86, 94] sts.

Instep

Now you go back to working in the round.

Gusset setup round

Start working the Gusset Chart (first row starts at stitch 4) across instep sts, k27 [31, 35, 39]. This is now the start of the round.

Continue to work the Gusset Chart across instep sts, k to end of round. When the Gusset Chart is complete, you will have 56 [64, 72, 80] sts.



Toe lace, size Medium

Foot and toe

Now work the Foot Chart. The toe decreases start at row 59 [61, 65, 69]. For longer or shorter socks, start toe lace portion, row 21 [25, 29, 33] of the Foot Chart at 12.25 [12.75, 13, 13.5] cm (4.9 [5, 5.25, 5.4] inches) before desired foot length. For a more rounded toe, work the Rounded Toe Chart.

Toe decrease round

Continue the Foot Chart (OR Rounded Toe Chart) across instep; k2tog, k to last 2 sts of sole, ssk.

After the last decrease round, put the 12 [14, 16, 18] (8 [8, 10, 10]) first sts on one needle (front needle) and the 12 [14, 16, 18] (8 [8, 10, 10]) last sts on one needle (back needle).

Knitted grafting

Cut the yarn leaving an end that is 4 times as long as the gap that will be grafted. Hold the sock with the front needle closest to you. The yarn will come from the first stitch to the right on the back needle.

* Purl the first stitch on the needle in front, and pull the yarn through. Drop the stitch from the needle. Knit the next stitch, pull the

yarn through, but leave the stitch on the needle. Now knit the first stitch on the needle in the back, pull the yarn through, and drop the stitch from the needle. Purl the next stitch, pull the yarn through, but leave the stitch on the needle;

Repeat from *. When you reach the last stitch, pull the yarn through, then pull the yarn through to the inside and weave in the ends.
