# Little Lace Scarf



**TYPE:** Knit

**DESIGNER:** Tori Gurbisz for Premier® Yarns

**SIZE:**

One Size

**FINISHED MEASUREMENTS:**

**Width (at widest point):** 7½"

**Length:** 42"

**GAUGE:**

21 sts x 27 rows = 4" in St st  
**Save time, check your gauge.**

**MATERIALS:**

Premier® Yarns Afternoon Cotton®  
(100% Egyptian Giza Mercerized  
Cotton; 50g/1.75oz, 125m/136yds)

- 3 balls per Scarf, shown in 2011-13 Pale Teal and 2011-06 Rouge

**NEEDLES & NOTIONS:**

- US Size 5 (3.75 mm) straight or size needed to obtain gauge
- Tapestry needle
- Stitch Markers

## SKILLS/TECHNIQUES USED IN THIS PATTERN:

- Knit and purl stitches.
- Yarn overs.
- K2tog, k3tog, ssk and sk2p decreases.

## PATTERN NOTES

This Scarf is worked flat from end to end, first increasing and then decreasing to create the pointed ends. The Main Body of the Scarf can be repeated to increase the length, though you may need additional yarn. All sections are charted at the end of the pattern.

## SCARF

Cast on 3 sts. Work 4 rows even in Garter st.

### Increase Section

*Note: Throughout this section the stitch count is increased by 2 sts every RS row.*

**Row 1 (RS):** K1, (k1, yo, k1) in next st, k1.

**WS Rows 2-36:** K2, purl to last 2 sts, k2.

**Row 3:** K2, yo, k1, yo, k2.

**Row 5:** K2, yo, k1, yo, ssk, yo, k2.

**Row 7:** K2, yo, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, yo, k2.

**Row 9:** K2, yo, k2, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, k2.

**Row 11:** K2, yo, k2, \*k5, yo, ssk; rep from \* to last 2 sts, yo, k2.

**Row 13:** (K2, yo) twice, \*ssk, k2, k2tog, yo, k1, yo; rep from \* to last 4 sts, ssk, yo, k2.

**Row 15:** K2, yo, k1, k2tog, yo, k1, \*k4, k2tog, yo, k1; rep from \* to last 4 sts, k2, yo, k2.

**Row 17:** K2, yo, k5, \*k2, yo, ssk, k3; rep from \* to last 5 sts, k3, yo, k2.

**Row 19:** (K2, yo) twice, ssk, k2, \*k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k2; rep from \* to last 6 sts, k2tog, (yo, k2) twice.

**Row 21:** K2, yo, \*k1, k2tog, yo, k4; rep from \* to last 7 sts, k1, k2tog, (yo, k2) twice.

**Row 23:** K2, yo, k1, \*k5, yo, ssk; rep from \* to last 8 sts, k6, yo, k2.

**Row 25:** K2, yo, k1, yo, \*ssk, k2, k2tog, yo, k1, yo; rep from \* to last 10 sts, ssk, k2, k2tog, (yo, k2) twice.

**Row 27:** K2, yo, k2tog, yo, k1, \*k4, k2tog, yo, k1; rep from \* to last 3 sts, k1, yo, k2.

**Row 29:** K2, yo, k4, \*k2, yo, ssk, k3; rep from \* to last 4 sts, k2, yo, k2.

**Row 31:** K2, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k2, \*k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k2; rep from \* to last 5 sts, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, k2.

**Row 33:** K2, yo, k2tog, yo, k4, \*k1, k2tog, yo, k4; rep from \* to last 6 sts, k1, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, k2.

**Row 35:** K2, yo, \*k5, yo, ssk; rep from \* to last 7 sts, k5, yo, k2.

Work Rows 1-36 once – 39 sts total.

### Main Body

*Note: The stitch count remains the same throughout this section.*

**Row 1 (RS):** K1, k2tog, yo, k3, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, \*ssk, k2, k2tog, yo, k1, yo;

rep from \* to last 8 sts, ssk, k4, yo, ssk, k1.

**WS Rows 2-12:** K2, purl to last 2 sts, k2.

**Row 3:** K1, k2tog, yo, k4, k2tog, yo, k1, \*k4, k2tog, yo, k1; rep from \* to last 8 sts, k5, yo, ssk, k1.

**Row 5:** K1, k2tog, yo, k2, yo, ssk, k3, \*k2, yo, ssk, k3; rep from \* to last 8 sts, k2, (yo, ssk, k1) twice.

**Row 7:** K1, (k2tog, yo) twice, k1, yo, ssk, k2, \*k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k2; rep from \* to last 8 sts, k2tog, yo, k1, (yo, ssk) twice, k1.

**Row 9:** (K1, k2tog, yo) twice, k4, \*k1, k2tog, yo, k4; rep from \* to last 8 sts, k1, k2tog, yo, k2, yo, ssk, k1.

**Row 11:** K1, k2tog, yo, k5, yo, ssk, \*k5, yo, ssk; rep from \* to last 8 sts, k5, yo, ssk, k1.

Reps Rows 1-12, 20 more times or until piece meas approximately 37", end having just worked a Row 12.

## Decrease Section

*Note: Throughout this section the stitch count is decreased by 2 sts every RS row.*

**Row 1 (RS):** K2, yo, sk2p, k1, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, \*ssk, k2, k2tog, yo, k1, yo; rep from \* to last 9 sts, ssk, k2, k3tog, yo, k2.

**WS Rows 2-34:** K2, purl to last 2 sts, k2.

**Row 3:** K2, yo, sk2p, k1, k2tog, yo, k1, \*k4, k2tog, yo, k1; rep from \* to last 7 sts, k2, k3tog, yo, k2.

**Row 5:** K2, yo, sk2p, k3, \*k2, yo, ssk, k3; rep from \* to last 6 sts, k1, k3tog, yo, k2.

**Row 7:** K2, yo, sk2p, k2, \*k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k2; rep from \* to last 5 sts, k3tog, yo, k2.

**Row 9:** K2, yo, sk2p, k1, \*k1, k2tog, yo, k4; rep from \* to last 11 sts, k1, k2tog, yo, k3, k3tog, yo, k2.

**Row 11:** K2, yo, sk2p, \*k5, yo, ssk; rep from \* to last 10 sts, k5, k3tog, yo, k2.

**Row 13:** K2, yo, sk2p, k2, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, \*ssk, k2, k2tog, yo, k1, yo; rep from \* to last 10 sts, ssk, k3, k3tog, yo, k2.

**Row 15:** K2, yo, sk2p, k2, k2tog, yo, k1, \*k4, k2tog, yo, k1; rep from \* to last 8 sts, k3, k3tog, yo, k2.

**Row 17:** K2, yo, sk2p, k4, \*k2, yo, ssk, k3; rep from \* to last 7 sts, k2, k3tog, yo, k2.

**Row 19:** K2, yo, sk2p, k3, \*k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k2; rep from \* to last 6 sts, k1, k3tog, yo, k2.

**Row 21:** K2, yo, sk2p, k2, \*k1, k2tog, yo, k4; rep from \* to last 5 sts, k3tog, yo, k2.

**Row 23:** K2, yo, sk2p, k1, k6, k3tog, yo, k2.

**Row 25:** K2, yo, sk2p, k3, k2tog, yo, k3tog, yo, k2.

**Row 27:** K2, yo, sk2p, k3, k3tog, yo, k1, k1.

**Row 29:** K2, yo, sk2p, k1, k3tog, yo, k2.

**Row 31:** K2, sk2p, yo, k2tog, k2

**Row 33:** K2, sk2p, k2.

**Row 35:** K1, sk2p, k1.

**Row 36:** Knit.

Work Rows 1-36 once – 3 sts rem.

Work 3 rows even in Garter st, bind off all sts.

## FINISHING

Wash and block to Finished Measurements. Weave in ends.

## MEET THE DESIGNER



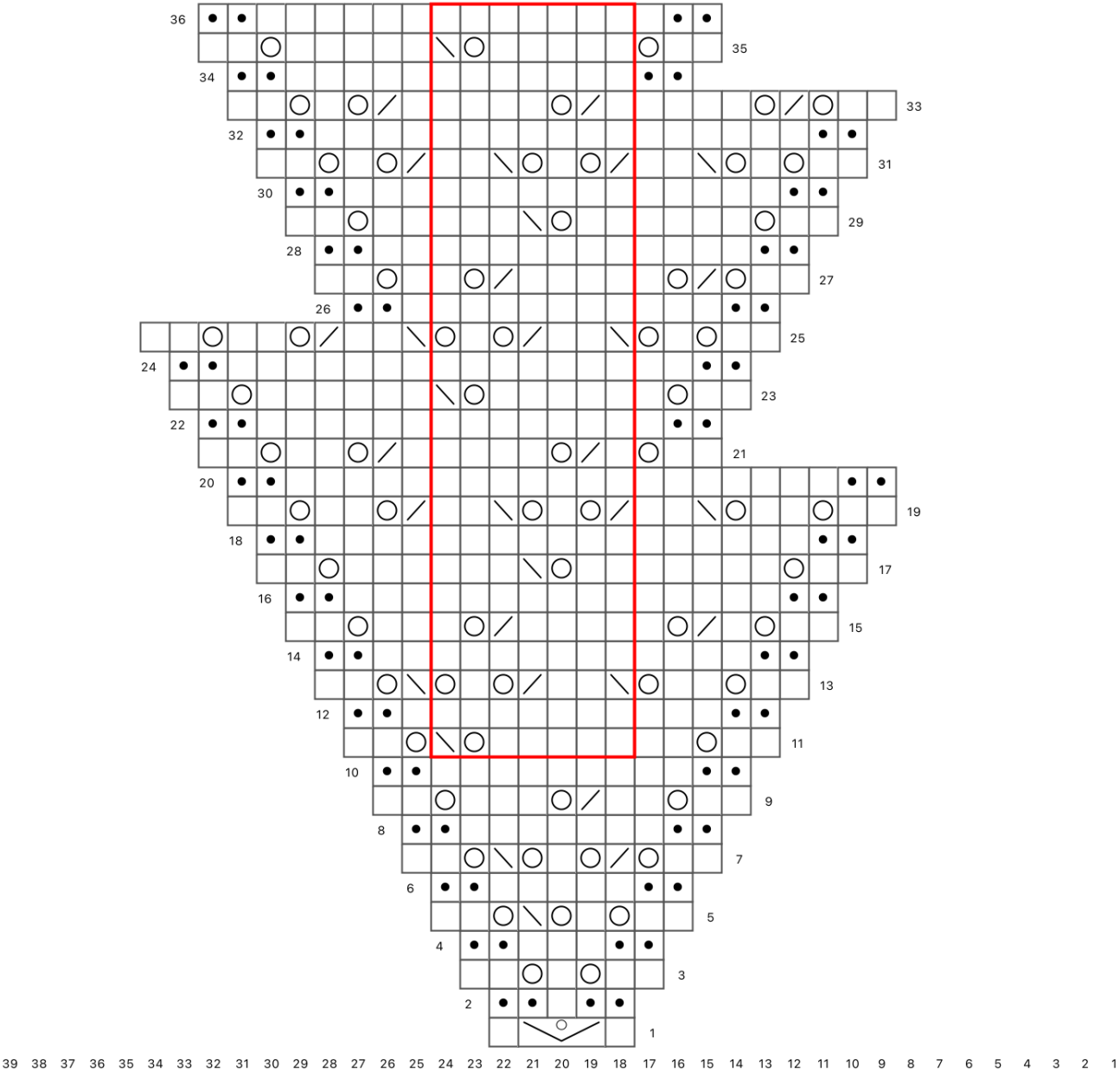

## ABBREVIATIONS





<b>dec('d)</b>	decrease(d)
<b>Garter st</b>	Knit every row.
<b>k</b>	knit
<b>k2tog</b>	knit 2 sts together (1 st dec'd)
<b>k3tog</b>	knit 3 sts together (2 sts dec'd)
<b>meas</b>	measures
<b>p</b>	purl
<b>rem</b>	remain(ing)
<b>RS</b>	right side
<b>sk2p</b>	slip 1 st as if to k, k2tog, pass slipped st over k2tog (2 sts dec'd)
<b>ssk</b>	slip next 2 sts individually knitwise, slip them back to left needle in this position, knit them together through the back loops (1 st dec'd)
<b>st(s)</b>	stitch(es)
<b>St st</b>	Stockinette stitch: knit on RS rows, purl on WS rows.
<b>WS</b>	wrong side
<b>yo</b>	yarn over



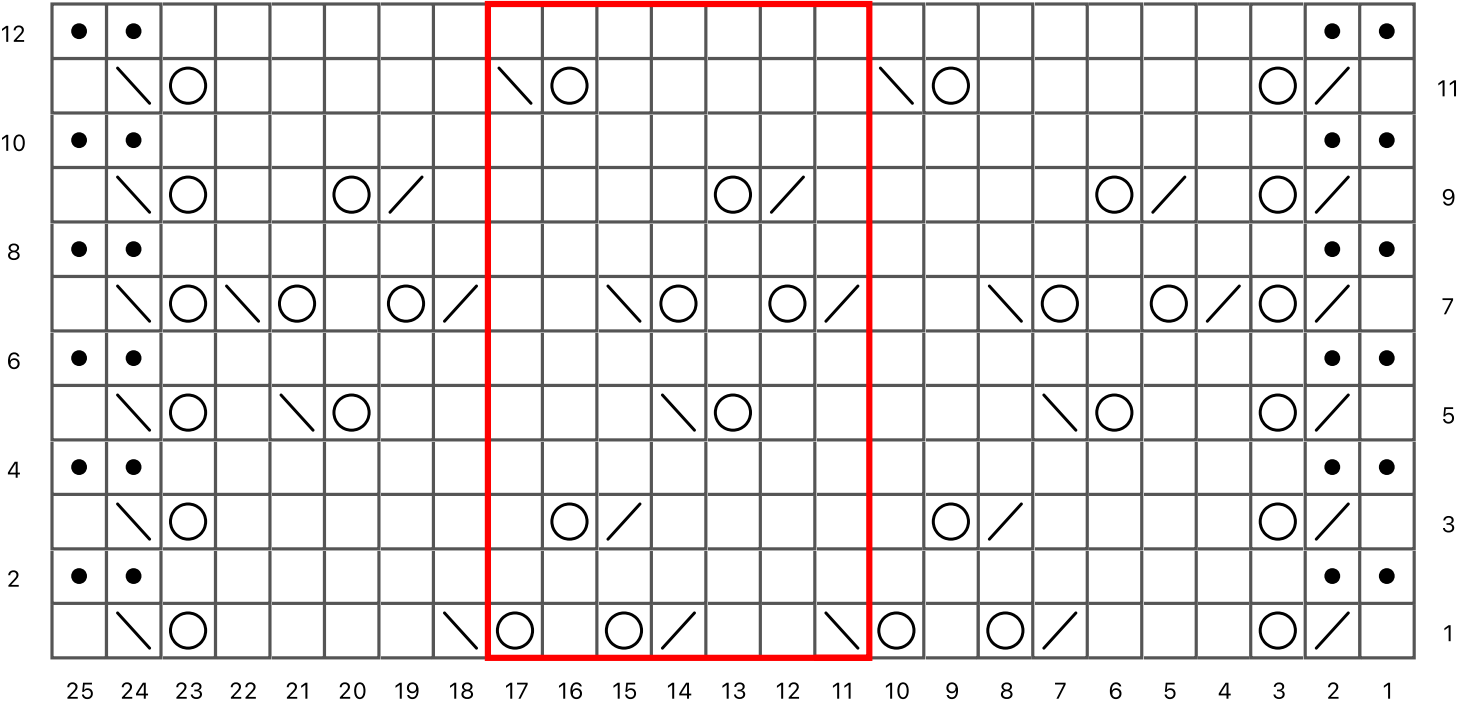
INCREASE SECTION CHART
