Gauge:

19 sts x 30 rs = 10 x 10 cm / 4 x 4 inch
in StSt on main needle (after blocking)


Needles/Materials:

Circular or straight needles in a size to obtain gauge.
Suggested size: 3,5 mm needle
2 stitch markers

Yarn:

A sport to dk weight yarn is recommended.
Shown in De rerum natura / Ulysse, french merino
woolen yarn, 202 yds (185 m) / approx 50 g ball

Finished measurements:



Abbreviations:

CO: cast on
BO: bind off
st(s): stitch(es)
k: knit
p: purl
rs: right side
ws: wrong side
M: Marker
pM, sM: place marker, slip marker
MC, CC: Main Color, Contrast Color
slp1: slip stitch purlwise with yarn in front
bef: before
k2tog: knit 2 sts together
p2tog: purl 2 sts together
ssk: slip slip knit. Slip one stitch knitwise, slip another stitch knitwise, k those two stitches together
YO: Yarn over

see special techniques:

m1r / m1rp: make one right knitwise / purlwise
m1l / m1lp: make one left knitwise / purlwise
ds / mds / kds / pds: double stitch / make ds / knit ds / purl ds

Yarn requirements m/yds:

Main Color 1 (MC1): 370/404

Skeins of Ulysse: 2 x 50g balls (sample: goeland)

Main Color 2 (MC2): 185/202

Skeins of Ulysse: 2 x 50g ball (sample: poivre blanc)

Note: The sample is worked from only one ball MC2, but some testers are running short with MC2, so you will be save with 2 balls.

Contrast Color 1 (CC1): 30/33

Skeins of Ulysse: 1 x 50g ball (sample: pavot)

Contrast Color 2 (CC2): 22/24

Skeins of Ulysse: 1 x 50g ball (sample: plume de paon)



SPECIAL TECHNIQUES

INCREASES

m1r / m1rp: make one right knitwise / purlwise: lift strand between the needles from the back on the left needle, knit / purl into the front of the loop

m1l / m1lp: make one left knitwise / purlwise: lift strand between the needles from the front on the left needle, knit / purl into the back of the loop

DOUBLE STITCH

mds: make double stitch: With yarn in front slip st purlwise. Pull the stich with the yarn over the needle to the back. The two legs of the stitch are visible sit on the needle (double stitch = ds).

kds: knit double stitch: When coming across a ds in the next rs row knit the two legs as one.

pds: purl double stitch: When coming across a ds in the next ws row purl the two legs as one.

You start in the center of the back working increases on either side of the center stitch and both selvedges. After the center section is complete you work the straight wings of the shawl with increases on one edge, and decreases on the other, until you decrease on both edges to shape the corners.

Broken Lines

The Center

With main color 1 (MC1) CO 2 sts.

Work 4 rows in Stst.

Next row: k2, rotate work 90 degrees and pick up and knit 3 sts along edge, rotate work 90 degrees, pick up and k2 sts on cast on edge. You have 7 sts on your needle.

In the next row place marker

Set up row (ws): slp1, p2, pM, p1, pM, p2, slp1.

MC Row 1 (rs): k1, m1l, k to M, m1r, sM, k1, sM, m1l, k to 1 st bef end, m1r, k1. (4 incr'd sts)

MC Row 2 (ws): slp1, p to 1 st bef end, slp1.

Repeat MC Rows 1+2 7 more times.

You have increased 32 sts and have now 39 total sts/ 19 sts each section

General instruction for the broken lines.

Leave a tail on the rs of about 14cm (5.5in) when you join or cut CC yarn.

BL WS (Broken lines wrong side, worked over 4 rows)

Row 1: with Main Color repeat MC row 1. (4 incr'd sts)

BL WS row 2 (ws): with MC, slp1, [p the given sts] from the instruction below. Don't cut yarn. Join CC1 and k to 1 sts bef end, slp1.

BL WS row 3 (rs): with CC1, k1, m1rp, p to M, m1lp, sM, p1, sM, m1rp, p to color change. Cut CC yarn. With working MC yarn, mds, k to 1 st bef end, m1r, k1. (4 incr'd sts)

Row 4 (ws): with MC, slp1, p to ds, pds, p to 1 st bef end, slp1.

BL RS (Broken lines right side, worked over 4 rows)

BL RS row 1 (rs): with MC, k1, m1l, [k the given sts] from the instruction below. Don't cut yarn. Join CC1, p to M, m1lp, sM, p1, sM, m1rp, p to 1 st bef end, m1lp, k1. (4 incr'd sts)

BL RS row 2 (ws): with CC, slp1, k to color change. Cut CC yarn. With working MC yarn, mds, p to 1 st bef end, slp1.

Row 3 (rs): k1, m1l, k to ds, kds, k to M, m1r, sM, k1, m1l, k to 1 st bef end, m1r, k1. (4 incr'd sts)

Row 4 (ws): slp1, p to 1 st bef end, slp1.

Work BL WS with [12 sts] to color change. (8 incr'd sts, 23 sts each sec)

Repeat MC rows 1+2 once. (4 incr'd sts) 25 each sec

Work BL RS with [12 sts] to color change. (8 incr'd sts)

Repeat MC rows 1+2 6 times (24 incr'd sts) 41 each sec

Work BL WS with [36 sts] to color change. (8 incr'd sts)

Repeat MC rows 1+2 4 times (16 incr'd sts) 53 each sec

Cut MC1. Change to MC2.

Repeat MC rows 1+2 2 times (8 incr'd sts) 57 each sec

Work BL RS with [16 sts] to color change. (8 incr'd sts)

Repeat MC rows 1+2 6 times (24 incr'd sts) 73 each sec

Work BL WS with [36 sts] to color change. (8 incr'd sts)

Repeat MC rows 1+2 2 times (8 incr'd sts)

You have 81 sts each section

SEPARATING THE WINGS

Work BL RS rows 1+2 with [10 sts] to color change. (4 incr'd sts)

You have 83 sts each section

Put the center st, the marker and the stitches of the left wing on holder or waste yarn.

Right wing

In the first row kds, when you come to it.

MC Row 1 (rs): k1, m1l, k to 3 sts bef end, ssk, k1.

MC Row 2 (ws): slp1, p to 1 st bef end, slp1.

Repeat MC Rows 1+2 once.

Cut MC2. Change to MC1.

Repeat MC Rows 1+2 4 times.

Broken lines on the right wing.

BL WS

Row 1 (rs): with Main Color repeat MC row 1.

BL WS row 2 (ws): with MC, slp1, [p the given sts] from the instruction below. Join CC1 and k to 1 sts bef end, slp1.

BL WS row 3 (rs): with CC1, k1, m1rp, p to color change. Cut CC. With working MC yarn, mds, k to 3 sts bef end, ssk, k1.

Row 4 (ws): with MC: slp1, p to ds, psd, p to 1 st bef end, slp1.

BL RS

BL RS row 1 (rs): with MC, k1, m1l, [k the given sts] from the instruction below. Join CC1, p to 3 st bef end, ssk, k1.

BL RS row 2 (ws): with CC, slp1, k to color change. Cut CC. With working MC yarn, mds, p to 1 st bef end, slp1.

Row 3 (rs): k1, m1l, k to ds, kds, k to 3 st bef end, ssk, k1.

Row 4 (ws): slp1, p to 1 st bef end, slp1.

Work BL RS with [16 sts] to color change.

Repeat MC rows 1+2 4 times.

Work BL WS with [24 sts] to color change.

Repeat MC rows 1+2 2 times

Work BL RS with [30 sts] to color change.



Repeat MC rows 1+2 6 times.
 Work BL RS with [16 sts] to color change.
 Repeat MC rows 1+2 4 times.
 Work BL WS with [16 sts] to color change.
 Repeat MC rows 1+2 6 times.
 Work BL RS with [40 sts] to color change.
 Repeat MC rows 1+2 2 times.
 Work BL WS with [12 sts] to color change.
 Repeat MC rows 1+2 2 times. Cut yarn MC1.
 Cut MC1. Change to MC2
 Repeat MC rows 1+2 4 times.
 Work BL RS with [12 sts] to color change.
 Repeat MC rows 1+2 5 times.
 Work BL WS with [24 sts] to color change.
 Repeat MC rows 1+2 2 times.
 Work BL RS with [24 sts] to color change.

RIGHT WING CORNER

MC Row 1 (rs): k1, k2tog, k to 3 sts bef end, ssk, k1
 MC Row 2 (ws) slp1, p to 1 st bef end, slp1.
 Repeat MC rows 1+2 once.
 Cut MC2. Change to MC1
 Repeat MC rows 1+2 3 times.

Broken lines on the right wing corner.

BL WS

Row 1 (rs): with Main Color repeat MC row 1.
 BL WS row 2 (ws): with MC, slp1, [p the given sts] from the instruction below. Join CC1 and k to 1 sts bef end, slp1.
 BL WS row 3 (rs): with CC1, k1, p2tog, p to color change. Cut CC1. With working MC yarn, mds, k to 3 sts bef end, ssk, k1.
 Row 4 (ws): with MC: slp1, p to ds, psd, p to 1 st bef end, slp1.

BL RS

BL RS row 1 (rs): with MC, k1, k2tog, [k the given sts] from the instruction below. Join CC1, p to 3 st bef end, p2tog, k1.
 BL RS row 2 (ws): with CC1 slp1, k to color change. Cut CC1. With working MC yarn, mds, p to 1 st bef end, slp1.
 Row 3 (rs): k1, k2tog, k to ds, kds, k to 3 st bef end, ssk, k1.
 Row 4 (ws): slp1, p to 1 st bef end, slp1.

Work BL WS with [24 sts] to color change.
 Repeat MC rows 1+2 5 times.
 Work BL RS with [6 sts] to color change.
 Repeat MC rows 1+2 5 times.
 Work BL WS with [12 sts] to color change.
 Repeat MC rows 1+2 2 times.
 Work BL RS with [12 sts] to color change.
 Repeat MC rows 1+2 2 times.

Cut MC1. Change to MC2.
 Repeat MC rows 1+2 3 times.
 Work BL WS with [6 sts] to color change
 Repeat MC rows 1+2 until 5 sts left
 Next row (rs): k2, k2tog, k1.
 Next row (ws): p1, p2tog, p1.
 Next row (rs): slp1, k2tog, pss0.
 Break yarn and pull through.

Left wing

With right side facing, take MC2
 Set up Row (rs): slp1, rM, k2tog, pss0, k to 1 st bef end, m1r, k1
 Next row (ws) slp1, p to 1 st bef end, slp1.
 MC Row 1 (rs): k1, k2tog, k to 1 st bef end, m1r, k1
 MC Row 2 (ws): slp1, p to 1 st bef end, slp1.
 Cut MC2. Change to MC1.
 Repeat MC rows 1+2 4 times.

Broken lines on the left wing.

BL WS

Row 1 (rs): with Main Color repeat MC row 1.
 BL WS row 2 (ws): with MC, slp1, [p the given sts] from the instruction below. Join CC2 and k to 1 sts bef end, slp1.
 BL WS row 3 (rs): with CC2, k1, p2tog, p to color change. Cut CC2. With working MC yarn, mds, k to 1 st bef end, m1r, k1.
 Row 4 (ws): with MC: slp1, p to ds, psd, p to 1 st bef end, slp1.

BL RS

BL RS row 1 (rs): with MC, k1, k2tog, [k the given sts] from the instruction below. Join CC2, p to 1 st bef end, m1p, k1.
 BL RS row 2 (ws): with CC2, slp1, k to color change. Cut CC2. With working MC yarn, mds, p to 1 st bef end, slp1.
 Row 3 (rs): k1, k2tog, k to ds, kds, k to 1 st bef end, m1r, k1.
 Row 4 (ws): slp1, p to 1 st bef end, slp1.

Work BL WS with [16 sts] to color change.
 Repeat MC rows 1+2 4 times.
 Work BL RS with [24 sts] to color change.
 Repeat MC rows 1+2 2 times
 Work BL WS with [30 sts] to color change.
 Repeat MC rows 1+2 6 times.
 Work BL WS with [16 sts] to color change.
 Repeat MC rows 1+2 4 times.
 Work BL RS with [16 sts] to color change.
 Repeat MC rows 1+2 6 times.
 Work BL WS with [40 sts] to color change.
 Repeat MC rows 1+2 2 times.
 Work BL RS with [12 sts] to color change.



Repeat MC rows 1+2 2 times. Cut yarn MC1.

Cut MC1. Change to MC2

Repeat MC rows 1+2 4 times.

Work BL WS with [12 sts] to color change.

Repeat MC rows 1+2 5 times.

Work BL RS with [24 sts] to color change.

Repeat MC rows 1+2 2 times.

Work BL WS with [24 sts] to color change.

LEFT WING CORNER

MC Row 1 (rs): k1, k2tog, k to 3 sts bef end, ssk, k1

MC Row 2 (ws): slp1, p to 1 st bef end, slp1.

Repeat MC rows 1+2 once.

Cut MC2. Change color to MC1

Repeat MC rows 1+2 3 times.

Broken lines on the left wing corner.

Repeat the BL instructions for right wing corner

Repeat MC rows 1+2 5 times.

Work BL RS with [12 sts] to color change.

Repeat MC rows 1+2 2 times.

Work BL WS with [12 sts] to color change.

Repeat MC rows 1+2 2 times.

Cut MC1. Change to MC2.

Repeat MC rows 1+2 3 times.

Work BL RS with [6 sts] to color change

Repeat MC rows 1+2 until 5 sts left

Next row (rs): k2, k2tog, k1.

Next row (ws): p1, p2tog, p1.

Next row (rs): slp1, k2tog, pss0.

Break yarn and pull through.

FINISHING

Weave in the ends of MC1 and MC2.

Secure the ends of CC1 and CC2 with knots as follows:

First tighten the ends with a simple knot, then place a half hitch knot (treating both strands as one) above the simple knot.

Cut the ends of CC1 and CC2 to a 5 cm (2 in) tail.

Block the shawl to finished measurements.

Work BL RS with [24 sts] to color change.

Repeat MC rows 1+2 5 times.

Work BL WS with [6 sts] to color change.
