FREE KNIT PATTERN

# Garden Path Scarf



**TYPE:** Knit

**DESIGNER:** Tori Gurbisz for Premier® Yarns

**FINISHED MEASUREMENTS:**

**Width:** 10"

**Length:** 70"

**SIZE:**

One Size

**GAUGE:**

19 sts x 28 rows = 4" in patt

**Save time, check your gauge.**

**MATERIALS:**

Premier® Yarns Bamboo Fair® (60% Bamboo, 40% Cotton; 3.5oz/100g, 273yds/250m)

MC: 1077-07 Daffodil – 4 balls

CC1: 1077-18 Coral – 1 ball

CC2: 1077-13 Orchid – 1 ball

CC3: 1077-35 Moss – 1 ball

**NEEDLES & NOTIONS:**

- US Size 5 (3.75 mm) straight or size needed to obtain gauge
- Tapestry needle
- Cable Needle

**SKILLS/TECHNIQUES USED IN THIS PATTERN:**

- Knit and purl stitches.
- Cables.
- Knitting into rows below.
- S2kp decreases.
- Embroidery/duplicate stitch.
- Yarn overs.

## STITCH GUIDE

**2/2LC (2/2 Left Cross):** Slip 2 sts onto cable needle and hold in front, k2, k2 from cable needle.

**2/2 RC (2/2 Right Cross):** Slip 2 sts onto cable needle and hold in back, k2, k2 from cable needle.

## PATTERN NOTES

This Scarf is worked flat from end to end. The stitch count increases on Rows 5 and 11 and decreases on Rows 1 and 7. Duplicate stitch is used to add pops of color to the flowers in the stitch pattern. Stitch patterns are charted at the end of pattern.

## SCARF

With MC, cast on 48 sts and then work 6 rows even in Garter st.

### Setup

**Row 1 (RS):** K3, k1b, p1, k4, p1, k1b, purl to last 11 sts, k1b, p1, k4, p1, k1b, k3.

**Rows 2 and 4 (WS):** K3, p1, k1, p4, k1, p1, knit to last 11 sts, p1, k1, p4, k1, p1, k3.

**Row 3:** K3, k1b, p1, **2/2 RC**, p1, k1b, purl to last 11 sts, k1b, p1, **2/2 LC**, p1 k1b, k3.

**Row 5:** K3, k1b, p1, k4, p1, k1b, \*p2, [k1, yo, k1] into the st 3 rows below, p3; rep from \* to last 13 sts, p2, k1b, p1, k4, p1, k1b, k3 – 8 sts inc'd.

**Row 6:** K3, p1, k1, p4, k1, p1, k2, \*k3, p3, k2; rep from \* to last 11 sts, p1, k1, p4, k1, p1, k3.

### Main Body

*Note: Throughout this section the Scarf is increased by 8 sts on Rows 5 and 11 and decreased by 8 sts on Rows 1 and 7.*

**Row 1 (RS):** K3, k1b, p1, k4, p1, k1b, \*p2, s2kp, p3; rep from \* to last 13 sts, p2, k1b, p1, k4, p1, k1b, k3 – 8 sts dec'd.

**Rows 2, 4, 8, 10 (WS):** K3, p1, k1, p4, k1, p1, knit to last 11 sts, p1, k1, p4, k1, p1, k3.

**Rows 3 and 9:** K3, k1b, p1, **2/2 RC**, p1, k1b, purl to last 11 sts, k1b, p1, **2/2 LC**, p1, k1b, k3.

**Row 5:** K3, k1b, p1, k4, p1, k1b, \*p5, [k1, yo, k1] into the st 3 rows below; rep from \* to last 13 sts, p2, k1b, p1, k4, p1, k1b, k3 – 8 sts inc'd.

**Row 6:** K3, p1, k1, p4, k1, p1, k2, \*p3, k5; rep from \* to last 11 sts, p1, k1, p4, k1, p1, k3.

**Row 7:** K3, k1b, p1, k4, p1, k1b, \*p5, s2kp; rep from \* to last 13 sts, p2, k1b, p1, k4, p1, k1b, k3 – 8 sts dec'd.

**Row 11:** K3, k1b, p1, k4, p1, k1b, \*p2, [k1, yo, k1] into the st 3 rows below, p3; rep from \* to last 13 sts, p2, k1b, p1, k4, p1, k1b, k3 – 8 sts inc'd.

**Row 12:** K3, p1, k1, p4, k1, p1, k2, \*k3, p3, k2; rep from \* to last 11 sts, p1, k1,

p4, k1, p1, k3.

Rep Rows 1 -12, until piece meas approximately 69½" along center spine

from Garter Tab, end having just worked a Row 4 or 10.

Work 6 rows even in Garter st. Loosely bind off all sts.

## FINISHING

### Duplicate Stitch Flowers

Using photo as a guide, duplicate stitch the leaves in CC3 and duplicate stitch the flowers in CC1 and CC2. Follow the path of the existing “flower” sts. Mix it up and do a random sprinkling of flowers or a border at each end. Weave in ends.

## MEET THE DESIGNER



## ABBREVIATIONS

<b>CC</b>	contrast color
<b>dec('d)</b>	decrease(d)
<b>Garter st</b>	Knit every row.
<b>inc('d)</b>	increase(d)
<b>k</b>	knit
<b>k1b</b>	knit 1 on row below
<b>MC</b>	main color
<b>meas</b>	measures
<b>p</b>	purl
<b>RS</b>	right side
<b>s2kp</b>	slip 2 sts together as if to k, k1, pass both slipped sts over k st (2 sts dec'd)
<b>st(s)</b>	stitch(es)
<b>St st</b>	Stockinette stitch: knit on RS rows, purl on WS rows.
<b>WS</b>	wrong side
<b>yo</b>	yarn over


## SETUP CHART
