# Design Jenny Alderbrant

**Please read the whole pattern before you start**

This pattern contains charts for adult size and smaller adult/childrens size.

This is what you will need to knit a pair:

Fingering yarn that is about 175-210m/50 gr

2-3mm DPNs or circular needles

Stitchholder or some scrap yarn to hold the thumb stitches

Tapestry needle to weave in loose ends

Gauge for the mittens(adult woman) is about 35 st/4 inches or 10 cm in stranded knitting with 2 colors. Same gauge for smaller size will get a mitten approx 8 cm wide.

You can adjust the size by changing the gauge.

## Higher gauge- smaller mittens

Lower gauge- larger mittens

## **Stitches and short terms used**

k-knit

p-purl

ssk-Slip,slip ,knit- Left leaning decrease

- 2tog-knit 2st together as one - Right leaning decrease

- ☒ S1k1pss0- slip1 kw, k1, pass slipped st over knitted.- Left leaning decrease

M-Make one. Use this increase on the cuff and on both sides of the thumbgusset.

Make 1 st by picking up the bar between 2 st, with your left needle from the front and knitting it in the backloop.

\*Chart is read from right to left.

X in the chart means no stitch and you should read and knit next st.



\*The eyes and nose of the cat can be embroidered afterwards. There is a link to a tutorial on the detail page for the pattern on Ravelry.

\*The black around the eyes and the nose is best knitted directly and this means knitting with 3 colors on those rows.

\*Back of thumb is knitted in same pattern as front – st 1, 17(for adult size).

\*Stitchcount within () is for smaller size/childsize.

\*Top of thumbcharts(thumbchart for smaller mittens) are read from left to right for left mittens

## Cuff

\*Cast on 56(48) st using double needles in patterncolor of your choise.

\*Join in the round and purl 1 row in same color.

The cuff is then kniited like this:

**Row 1:** \*M, k4(k3), ssk,p1, 2tog, k4(k3),M,p1\* Repeat \*-\* to end of row.

**Row 2:**\*k6(k5), p1\* Repeat \*-\* to end of row.

\*Repeat these 2 rows like this: 3 times in maincolor, 1 time in patterncolor, 1 time in main color, 1 time in patterncolor, 2 times in maincolor.

\*Knit 1 row in mc and at the same time increase to 60 st evenly.

\*Follow the chart for the mitten and make the increases for the thumbgusset when you get to the M symbol.

\*When you are done with your increases and get to the stitches marked with 

place those 15 (13)st on holder or some scrapyarn and co 15(13) new st behind them using your working yarn.

\*Keep following the chart and decrease for the top when you get to decreasing symbols.

\*When you have approx 8 st left cut yarn and pull it through the remaining st and through the top. Tighten.

## Thumb

\*Place your 15 (13)stfrom your st holder or scrapyarn and knit them following chart for thumb.

\*Pick up and knit 17(13) more st around the hole.

\*Keep knitting the thumb following the chart and finish the top the same way as the mitten.

\*Block your mittens and leave them to dry in the shape you want.





## Right adult




Smaller size R ©Jenny Alderbrant
