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Yarn

Walk Collection Big Kid Mohair

78% mohair, 13% new wool 9% nylon:

219 yds/ 200 m per 100 g

Shown in color Oyster

approximately 438 - 481 yds (400 - 440 m)

Note: 2 skeins (a total of 438 yds/400 m) were used to complete the sample (excluding the gauge swatch), please consider buying an extra skein.

Needles

US 10 (6 mm) circular needle, 40" (100 cm) long, or size needed to get gauge

Gauge

10 sts x 16 rows = 4" (10 cm) in lace pattern after blocking.

Gauge is not crucial for this project but will affect yardage and final size when different.

Notions

Stitch markers (optional), tapestry needle, blocking tools.

Finished measurements

Approximately 78.75" (200 cm) wingspan, 59" (150 cm) long and 49.25" (125 cm) wide.

Lace pattern

The stitch pattern below is for swatching only. When working the *Cozy Walk shawl*, you just have to follow the written instructions in the pattern.

Cast on 21 sts

Set up row (WS): Purl to end.

Row 1 (RS): K1, (yo, k3, SK2P, k3, yo, k1) to end.

Row 2 and all WS rows: Purl to end.

Row 3 (RS): K1, (k1, yo, k2, SK2P, k2, yo, k2) to end.

Row 5 (RS): K1, (k2, yo, k1, SK2P, k1, yo, k3) to end.

Row 7 (RS): K1, (k3, yo, SK2P, yo, k4) to end.

Row 8: Purl to end.

Repeat **rows 1 to 8** for pattern 2 more times.

Abbreviations

CO: cast on

inc: increase

k: knit

k2tog: knit 2 stitches together

kfb: knit into front and back of the same stitch (increase)

LH: left hand

m: marker

p: purl

pm: place marker

RH: right hand

RS: right side

SK2P: slip 1 stitch knitwise with yarn held at back, k2tog, pass slipped stitch over (double decrease)

sl1 wyif: slip 1 stitch purlwise with yarn held in front

sl1-k1-ssso: slip 1 stitch knitwise with yarn held at back, k1, pass slipped stitch over

st(s): stitch(es)

WS: wrong side

yo: yarn over

(): repeat instructions in brackets

Special techniques and tips

Long tail cast on:

Cozy Walk is worked flat (sideways), increasing along one edge to create an asymmetrical triangle. Stitches are increased in pattern and then onward into the garter stitch edging. A built-in slip stitch edge, the beautiful lace pattern and the use of the soft and light weight yarn give this shawl a sophisticated yet casual look.

Add/reduce length and width by working more or less repeats of rows 1 to 40 (Lace pattern - shawl body, page 4). Be aware that the amount of yarn needed will change with each alteration.

Stitch counts are given after each increase row.

Instructions

With US 10 (6 mm) circular needle, CO 6 sts using the long tail cast-on. DO NOT JOIN.

Charts can be found on the last pages.

Lace pattern set up

Row 1 (RS) (inc row): K1, sl1 wyif, k2, kfb, k1. (7 sts)

Row 2 and all WS rows: Sl1 wyif, k1, purl to 3 sts before end, sl1 wyif, k1, sl1 wyif.

Row 3 (RS) (inc row): K1, sl1 wyif, k3, kfb, k1. (8 sts)

Row 5 (RS) (inc row): K1, sl1 wyif, k4, kfb, k1. (9 sts)

Row 7 (RS) (inc row): K1, sl1 wyif, k5, kfb, k1. (10 sts)

Row 9 (RS) (inc row): K1, sl1 wyif, k1, yo, k3, sl1-k1-ssso, kfb, k1. (11 sts)

Row 11 (RS) (inc row): K1, sl1 wyif, k2, yo, k2, sl1-k1-ssso, k1, kfb, k1. (12 sts)

Row 13 (RS) (inc row): K1, sl1 wyif, k3, yo, k1, SK2P, k1, yo, kfb, k1 (13 sts)

Row 15 (RS) (inc row): K1, sl1 wyif, k4, yo, SK2P, yo, k2, kfb, k1. (14 sts)

Row 17 (RS) (inc row): K1, sl1 wyif, k1, yo, k3, SK2P, k3, yo, kfb, k1. (15 sts)

Row 19 (RS) (inc row): K1, sl1 wyif, k2, yo, k2, SK2P, k2, yo, k2, kfb, k1. (16 sts)

Row 21 (RS) (inc row): K1, sl1 wyif, k3, yo, k1, SK2P, k1, yo, k4, kfb, k1 (17 sts)

Row 23 (RS) (inc row): K1, sl1 wyif, k4, yo, SK2P, yo, k6, kfb, k1. (18 sts)

Row 25 (RS) (inc row): K1, sl1 wyif, k1, yo, k3, SK2P, k3, yo, k1, yo, k1, sl1-k1-ssso, kfb, k1. (19 sts)

Row 27 (RS) (inc row): K1, sl1 wyif, k2, yo, k2, SK2P, k2, yo, k3, yo, k1, sl1-k1-ssso, kfb, k1. (20 sts)

Row 29 (RS) (inc row): K1, sl1 wyif, k3, yo, k1, SK2P, k1, yo, k5, yo, k1, sl1-k1-ssso, kfb, k1. (21 sts)

Row 31 (RS) (inc row): K1, sl1 wyif, k4, yo, SK2P, yo, k7, yo, sl1-k1-ssso, k1, kfb, k1. (22 sts)

Row 33 (RS) (inc row): K1, sl1 wyif, k1, yo, k3, SK2P, k3, yo, k1, yo, k3, sl1-k1-ssso, k2, kfb, k1. (23 sts)

Row 35 (RS) (inc row): K1, sl1 wyif, k2, yo, k2, SK2P, k2, yo, k3, yo, k2, SK2P, k2, yo, kfb, k1. (24 sts)

Row 37 (RS) (inc row): K1, sl1 wyif, k3, yo, k1, SK2P, k1, yo, k5, yo, k1, SK2P, k1, yo, k2, kfb, k1. (25 sts)

Row 39 (RS) (inc row): K1, sl1 wyif, k4, yo, SK2P, yo, k7, yo, SK2P, yo, k4, kfb, k1. (26 sts)

Row 40 (WS): Repeat row 2.



Lace pattern (shawl body)

Row 1 (RS) (inc row): K1, sl1 wyif, k1, (yo, k3, SK2P, k3, yo, k1) to 3 sts before end, k1, kfb, k1. (27 sts)

Row 2 and all WS rows: Sl1 wyif, k1, purl to 3 sts before end, sl1 wyif, k1, sl1 wyif.

Row 3 (RS) (inc row): K1, sl1 wyif, k1, (k1, yo, k2, SK2P, k2, yo, k2) to 4 sts before end, k2, kfb, k1. (28 sts)

Row 5 (RS) (inc row): K1, sl1 wyif, k1, (k2, yo, k1, SK2P, k1, yo, k3) to 5 sts before end, k3, kfb, k1. (29 sts)

Row 7 (RS) (inc row): K1, sl1 wyif, k1, (k3, yo, SK2P, yo, k4) to 6 sts before end, k4, kfb, k1. (30 sts)

Row 9 (RS) (inc row): K1, sl1 wyif, k1, (yo, k3, SK2P, k3, yo, k1) to 7 sts before end, yo, k3, sl1-k1-
psso, kfb, k1. (31 sts)

Row 11 (RS) (inc row): K1, sl1 wyif, k1, (k1, yo, k2, SK2P, k2, yo, k2) to 8 sts before end, k1, yo, k2, sl1-k1-
psso, k1, kfb, k1. (32 sts)

Row 13 (RS) (inc row): K1, sl1 wyif, k1, (k2, yo, k1, SK2P, k1, yo, k3) to 9 sts before end, k2, yo, k1, SK2P, k1, yo, kfb, k1. (33 sts)

Row 15 (RS) (inc row): K1, sl1 wyif, k1, (k3, yo, SK2P, yo, k4) to 10 sts before end, k3, yo, SK2P, yo, k2, kfb, k1. (34 sts)

Row 17 (RS) (inc row): K1, sl1 wyif, k1, (yo, k3, SK2P, k3, yo, k1) to 11 sts before end, yo, k3, SK2P, k3, yo, kfb, k1. (35 sts)

Row 19 (RS) (inc row): K1, sl1 wyif, k1, (k1, yo, k2, SK2P, k2, yo, k2) to 2 sts before end, kfb, k1. (36 sts)

Row 21 (RS) (inc row): K1, sl1 wyif, k1, (k2, yo, k1, SK2P, k1, yo, k3) to 3 sts before end, k1, kfb, k1. (37 sts)

Row 23 (RS) (inc row): K1, sl1 wyif, k1, (k3, yo, SK2P, yo, k4) to 4 sts before end, k2, kfb, k1. (38 sts)

Row 25 (RS) (inc row): K1, sl1 wyif, k1, (yo, k3, SK2P, k3, yo, k1) to 5 sts before end, yo, k1, sl1-k1-
psso, kfb, k1. (39 sts)

Row 27 (RS) (inc row): K1, sl1 wyif, k1, (k1, yo, k2, SK2P, k2, yo, k2) to 6 sts before end, k1, yo, k1, sl1-k1-
psso, kfb, k1. (40 sts)

Row 29 (RS) (inc row): K1, sl1 wyif, k1, (k2, yo, k1, SK2P, k1, yo, k3) to 7 sts before end, k2, yo, k1, sl1-k1-
psso, kfb, k1. (41 sts)

Row 31 (RS) (inc row): K1, sl1 wyif, k1, (k3, yo, SK2P, yo, k4) to 8 sts before end, k3, yo, sl1-k1-
psso, k1, kfb, k1. (42 sts)

Row 33 (RS) (inc row): K1, sl1 wyif, k1, (yo, k3, SK2P, k3, yo, k1) to 9 sts before end, yo, k3, sl1-k1-
psso, k2, kfb, k1. (43 sts)

Row 35 (RS) (inc row): K1, sl1 wyif, k1, (k1, yo, k2, SK2P, k2, yo, k2) to 10 sts before end, k1, yo, k2, SK2P, k2, yo, kfb, k1. (44 sts)

Row 37 (RS) (inc row): K1, sl1 wyif, k1, (k2, yo, k1, SK2P, k1, yo, k3) to 11 sts before end, k2, yo, k1, SK2P, k1, yo, k2, kfb, k1. (45 sts)

Row 39 (RS) (inc row): K1, sl1 wyif, k1, (k3, yo, SK2P, yo, k4) to 2 sts before end, kfb, k1. (46 sts)

Row 40 (WS): Repeat row 2.

Repeat **rows 1 to 40** for shawl body 3 more times, then work **rows 1 to 24** once more. (118 sts)

Garner stitch edging

Row 1 (RS) (inc row): K1, sl1 wyif, k1, (yo, k3, SK2P, k3, yo, k1) to 5 sts before end, yo, k1, sl1-k1-ssso, kfb, k1. (119 sts)

Row 2 (WS): Sl1 wyif, k1, p3, k1, (k2, p7, k1) to 3 sts before end, sl1 wyif, k1, sl1 wyif.

Row 3 (RS) (inc row): K1, sl1 wyif, k1, (k1, yo, k2, SK2P, k2, yo, k2) to 6 sts before end, k1, yo, k1, sl1-k1-ssso, kfb, k1. (120 sts)

Row 4 (WS): Sl1 wyif, k1, p3, k2, (k3, p5, k2) to 3 sts before end, sl1 wyif, k1, sl1 wyif.

Row 5 (RS) (inc row): K1, sl1 wyif, k1, (k2, yo, k1, SK2P, k1, yo, k3) to 7 sts before end, k2, yo, k1, sl1-k1-ssso, kfb, k1. (121 sts)

Row 6 (WS): Sl1 wyif, k1, p3, k3, (k4, p3, k3) to 3 sts before end, sl1 wyif, k1, sl1 wyif.

Row 7 (RS) (inc row): K1, sl1 wyif, k1, (k3, yo, SK2P, yo, k4) to 8 sts before end, k3, yo, sl1-k1-ssso, k1, kfb, k1. (122 sts)

Row 8 (WS): Sl1 wyif, k3, p1, k4, (k5, p1, k4) to 3 sts before end, sl1 wyif, k1, sl1 wyif.

Row 9 (RS) (inc row): K1, sl1 wyif, knit to 2 sts before end, kfb, k1. (123 sts)

Row 10 (WS): Sl 1 wyif, knit to 3 sts before end, sl1 wyif, k1, sl1 wyif.

Repeat **rows 9 + 10** 5 more times (128 sts) or to desired length.

Bind-off

Rearrange the first 2 stitches for a neat looking edge:

Insert RH needle tip into the first 2 stitches from left to right from the back, let them slide off the LH needle, turn RH needle tip clockwise and place them onto LH needle.

Slip first stitch to RH needle and start binding off.

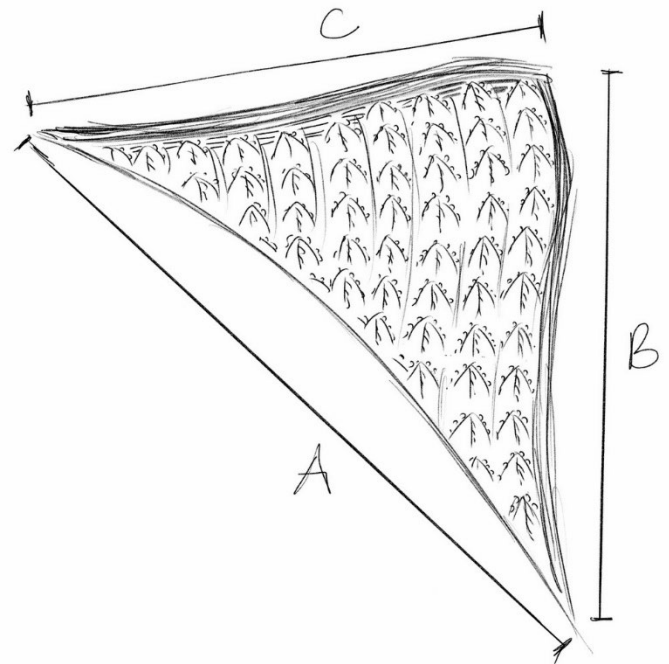

This video was made for the Kallias cardigan, where we have the slip stitch edge on both fronts, for the Cozy Walk shawl you only need to rearrange the first 2 stitches (watch the beginning of the video, maybe up to minute 1:25)

Finishing

Weave in all ends and wet block to measurements.

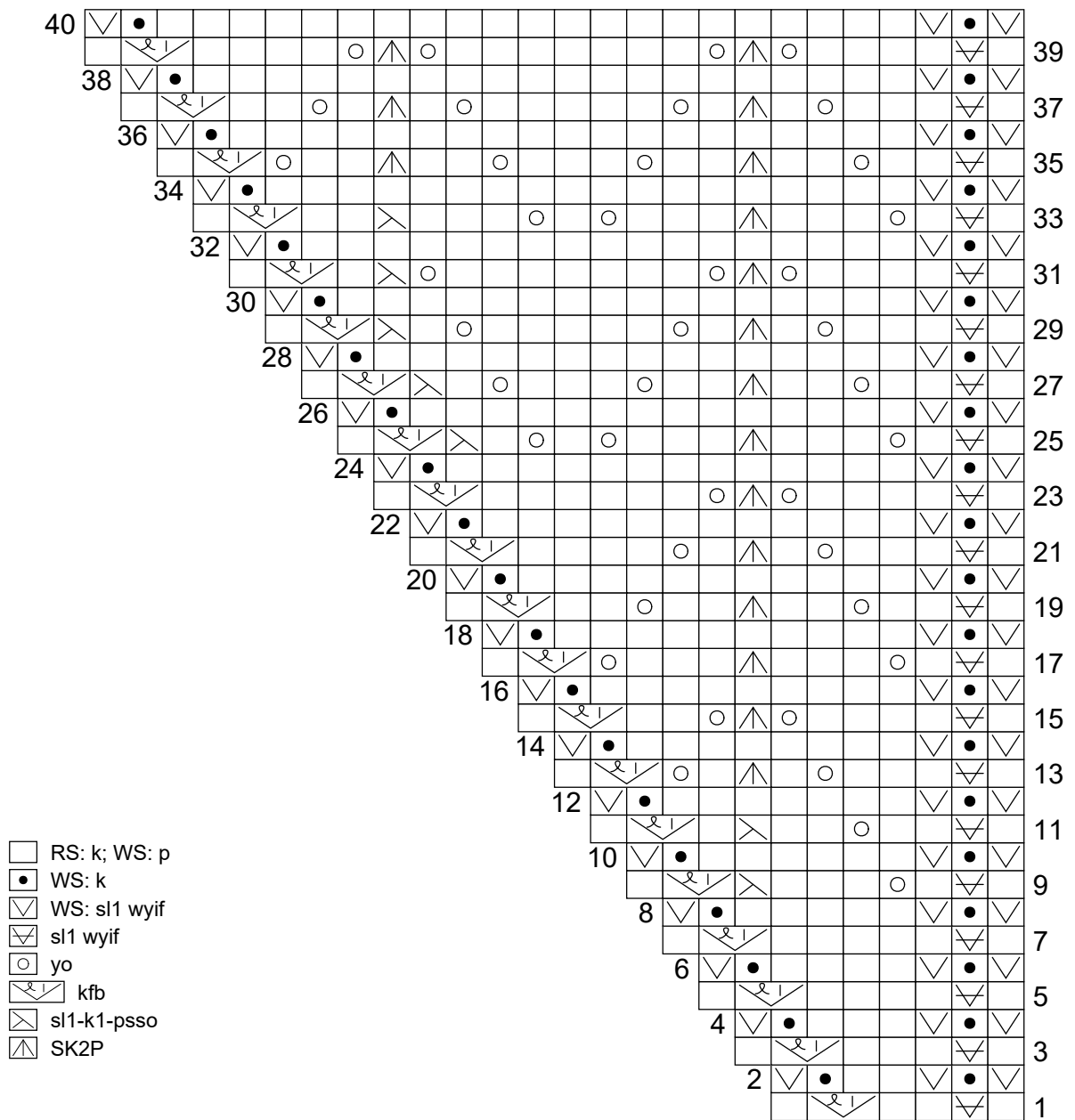
Approximately

C: 49.25" (125 cm)

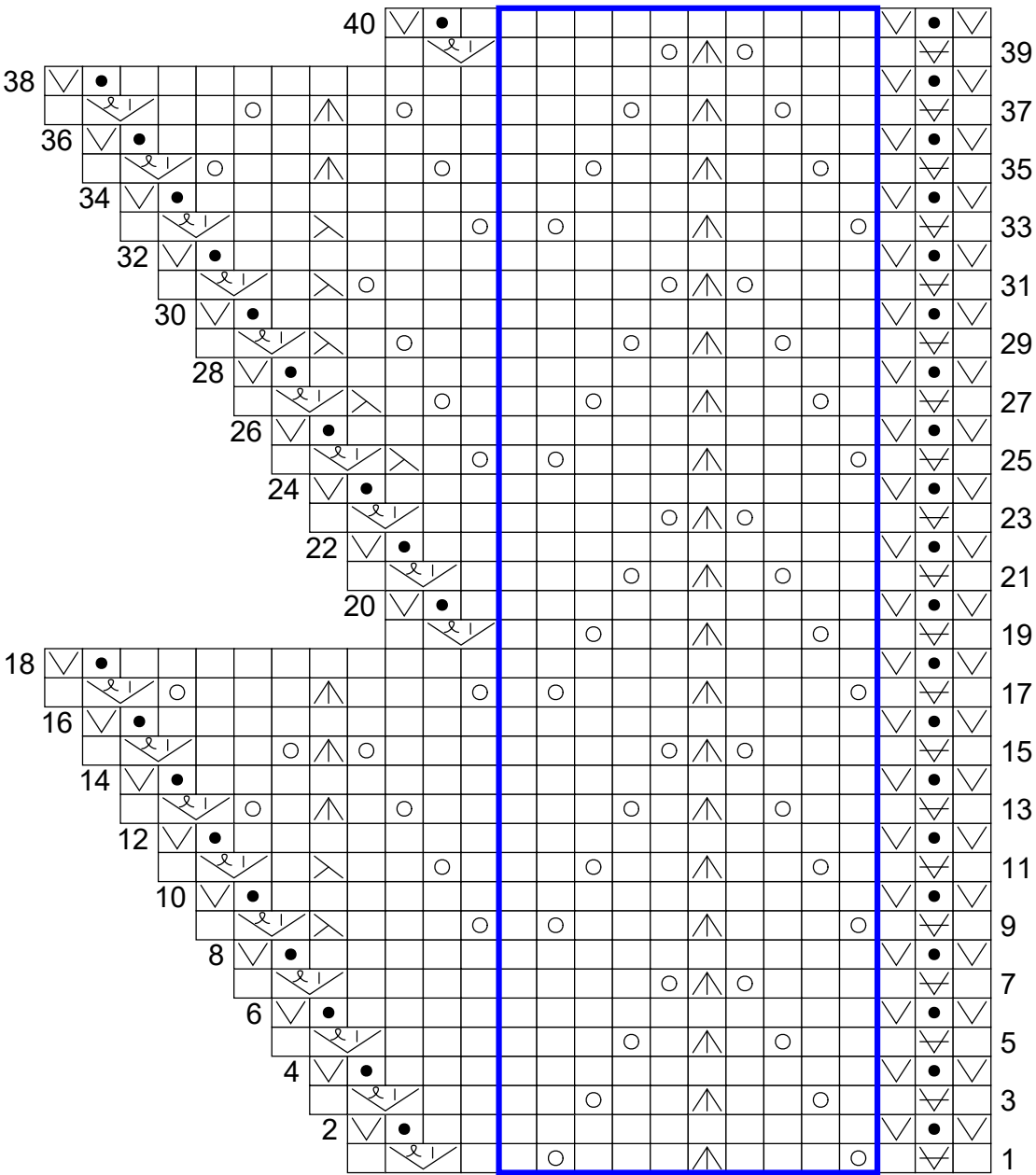
Lace pattern set up chart

 RS rows from right to left, WS rows from left to right.

The chart key applies to all charts.
