

FAIR ISLE HAT

Materials

- Scheepjes Stonewashed XL (70% cotton, 30% acrylic, 50g/75m)
- 1 skein of each of the following colours:
 - Yarn A: 850 Garnet
 - Yarn B: 841 Moonstone
 - Yarn C: 853 Amazonite
 - Yarn D: 845 Blue Apatite
 - Yarn E: 854 Crystal Quartz
 - Yarn F: 849 Yellow Jasper
 - Yarn G: 852 Lemon Quartz
 - Yarn H: 846 Canada Jade
 - Yarn I: 860 Rose Quartz
- 5mm circular needles, 40cm (16in)
- 5mm circular needles, 60cm (24in)
- 5mm double pointed needles
- 6 stitch markers
- Large pom-pom maker
- Darning needle

Tension/Gauge

14 sts and 19 rows to 10 x 10cm (4in x 4in)
over stocking stitch using 5mm needle

Abbreviations

st/s stitch/es

k knit

p purl

tog together

Pattern Notes

Change to double pointed needles when it becomes too difficult to use circular needle due to stitch count.

When working from Chart, use Fair Isle technique: hold stranding yarn not in use loosely across back of work to avoid puckering.

Instructions

With yarn A and 5mm circular needle (40cm/16in), cast on 72 sts. Being careful not to twist sts join to a round, place marker to show start of round and continue as follows:

Round 1 [k2, p2] to end.

This round forms rib.

Continue in rib until work measures 11cm (4.3in)

Change to 5mm circular needle (60cm/24in) and work from Chart,



increase 12 sts evenly on first round, work 28 st pattern repeat 3 times around. - 84 sts

At end of Chart row 26 weave in loose yarn ends before continuing to shape crown.

Shape Crown

Continue in yarn E only, changing to double pointed needles when necessary.

Next round Knit to end.

Next round Knit to end placing markers after every 14 sts.

Next round [K to 2 sts before marker, k2tog] around. - 78 sts
Repeat last round until 2 sts remain between each marker.

Cut yarn leaving a long tail, thread tail through remaining stitches. Use remainder of thread to sew on pom pom.
