

Gray cable wristlets

Fitting wristlets with cable details in the back and i-cord beginning and finishing.

Size: One-size

Gauge: 19 stitches = 10 cm

Suggested yarn: Rowan Silky Tweed

Needles: Three 4 mm circular needles
4 mm double pointed needles

If you don't own three 4 mm circular needles, don't worry. They are just for casting the stitches and making the beginning i-cord. You can use any needles that are close to the right size and can fit 40 stitches.

If the fit feels too tight, use 4.5 mm needles.



Cast on 80 stitches using one 4 mm circular needle (I). Holding the other two circular needles in your right hand, pick up the stitches so that every other stitch is on circular needle II and every other on circular needle III.

Work first the beginning i-cord on circular needle II: CO 2 stitches. *Knit 2, SKPO (slip 1, k1, pass slipped stitch over). Slip the three stitches on the right hand needle back onto the left hand needle. Repeat from * until you have gone through the stitches on circular needle II. Slip the remaining three stitches onto circular needle III and bind them off. You should have 40 stitches on circular needle III.

Start working chart A. Work the first row flat. Move the stitches onto three DPNS so that needle 1 has 10 stitches, needle 2 20 stitches and needle 3 10 stitches. Join in round and work in the round from row 2 onwards. Repeat the four rows of chart A until you have worked 18 rows, ending with row 2.

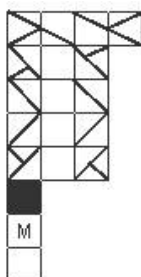
For right hand wristlet continue with working chart B. Once you have worked through the 18 rows of chart B start the thumb gusset increases on needle 3 from chart C and at the same time continue the cables on needle 2.

Once you have finished chart C continue as follows: k needle 1 and continue the cables on needle 2. On needle 3, k1, slip the 17 thumb gusset stitches on a spare yarn, CO 1 stitch, k 8. Continue working in the round until you have reached desired length. Bind off the stitches using i-cord bind off: CO 2 stitches, *k2, SKPO, slip the three stitches on the right hand needle back onto the left hand needle. Repeat from * until you have gone through all the stitches. Bind off the remaining three stitches. Break yarn.

Pick up the thumb gusset stitches plus 2 stitches from the cast on edge above the thumb. Bind off the stitches using i-cord bind off. Break yarn.

For left hand use chart D and work the thumb gusset increases on needle 1 from chart E.

use the yarn ends to join the i-cord CO and BO edges.



Pick up 2 stitches and leave them on a cable needle in front of the work, k2, k2 from cn

Pick up 2 stitches and leave them on a cn in front of the work, k1, k2 from cn

Pick up 2 stitches and leave them on a cn in front of the work, p1, k2 from cn

Pick up 1 stitch and leave it on a cn at back of the work, k2, p1 from the cn

Pick up 1 stitch and leave it on a cn at back of the work, k2, k1 from cn

No stich

Make 1 stich by lifting the yarn between the stitches onto the left needle and knitting it through the back loop
k on right side, p on wrong side

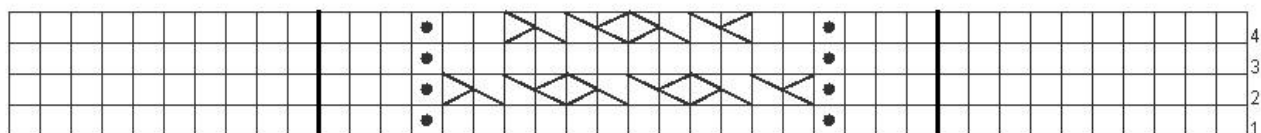

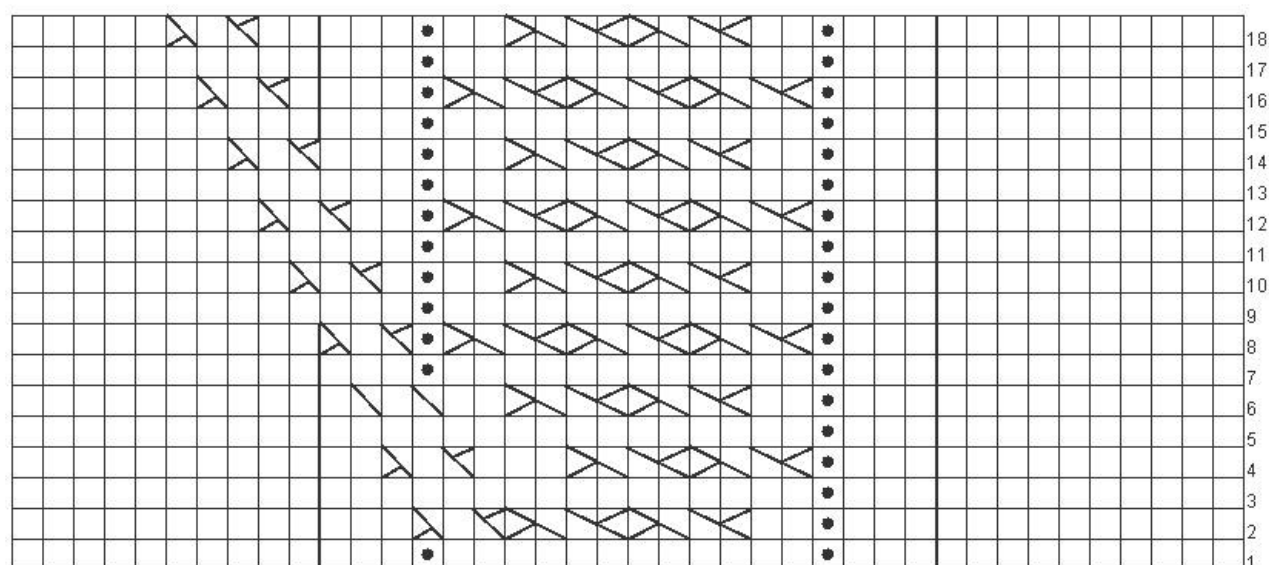

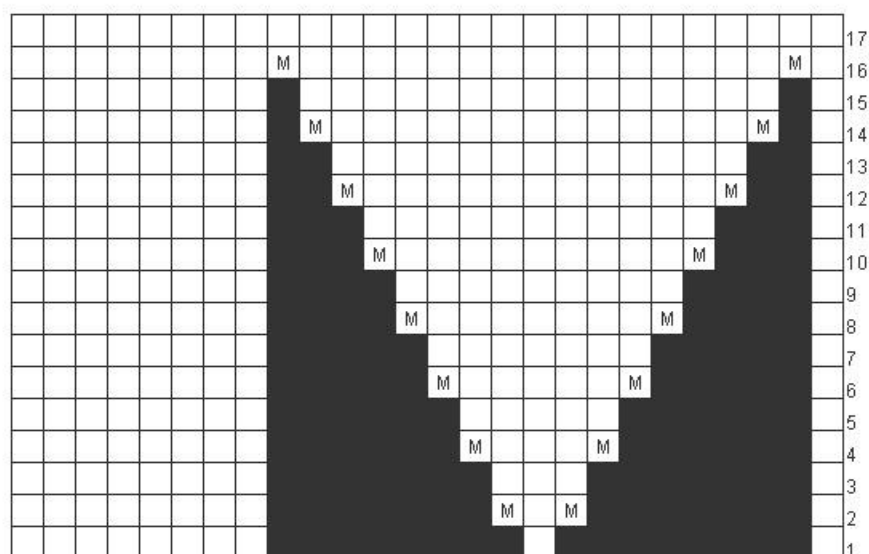

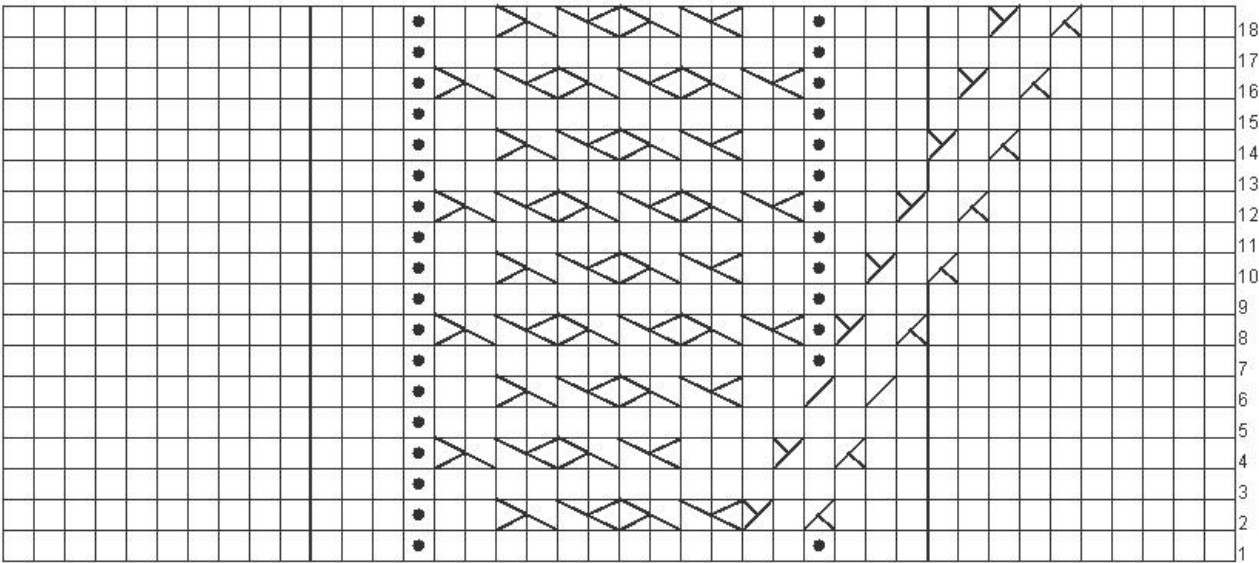
