HALIBUT MITTENS



MATERIALS

Yarn:

Rauma Finullgarn (100% wool)

190 yards [174 m] - 50 g or other fingering or light sport weight yarn

Sample shown in:

MC: 411 (brown)

CC: 400 (cream)

Needles:

Main: US 2 [2.75 mm] circular needle for Magic Loop

Ribbing: US 1 [2.25 mm] circular needle for Magic Loop

Double pointed needles of the same sizes suitable for small circumference knitting for the crown decreases

Notions: Stitch Marker, darning needle, scissors, row counter (optional)

GAUGE

30 sts and 30 rounds = 4 inches [10 cm] in colorwork and on main gauge needles.

Note- You should always knit your swatch the same way that the pattern is knit—in this case, in the round. Block your swatch as you will your finished garment and allow it to dry fully before measuring.

Size (adult medium)

Finished circumference at palm: 8.25" [21cm]

Yardage: Please note that yardage is estimated, and can vary between knitters.

MC : 150 yards [m]

CC : 90 yards [m]

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DIRECTIONS

With ribbing needles and C2, CO 62 sts. Pm and join in the round.

Chart

Begin working chart, changing colors as shown.

Change to main needles at Round 21.

Afterthought Thumb Set-up

Worked at Round 43 (see chart for placement).

The place where the thumb hole will be is marked by a section of Left Thumb sts or Right Thumb sts. These indicate either the left (L) or right (R) thumb hole. Work only one per mitten, making sure you make one of each.

When you reach the thumb sts as marked on the chart, knit those 12 sts with contrasting scrap yarn. Then transfer all 12 sts knit with the scrap yarn back to the left needle and knit them again, following the chart. Continue on with the remainder of the hand chart.

Top Shaping

Make decreases as shown on chart until you have 6 sts remaining (3 front and 3 back). Graft the 3 front and 3 back sts together using the Kitchener Stitch method.

Thumb (both hands worked the same)


Remove the scrap yarn from the thumb set-up and distribute 24 sts to needles (12 top and 12 bottom sts). Begin knitting sts, according to Thumb Chart (worked twice, same for top and bottom). Work all rounds of chart, making decreases as shown until you have 4 sts remaining (2 front and 2 back). Graft front and back sts together using Kitchener Stitch method.

Weave in ends and block.




FRONT
