



Gauge swatch 18 sts x 60 rows on 3,5 mm needle = 10 x 10 cm in brioche stitch
Yarn 100 g Sandnes Garn Double Sunday (50 g = 108 m), or 2 x 50 g
Size fits a head circumference of 46 – 56 cm

The hat is knitted top down. This means the pattern is ideal to use up leftovers.

Adjusting the size

The pattern is only written in one size. Since the brioche stitch is quite stretchy the hat should fit most head circumferences. The size can be adjusted by using a thinner or thicker yarn and/ or using a different needle size. You can also knit more or less increases than written in the pattern

Brioche stitch in the round

row 1	knit 1 stitch (st) including yarn over, yarn over while slipping 1 st purlwise
row 2	yarn over while slipping 1 st purlwise, purl 1 st including yarn over

Two coloured brioche is created by knitting row 1 in colour A and row 2 in colour B.

Increases in brioche stitch

Knit 1 st without slipping the st off the left needle, yarn over, knit into the same st again, this time slipping the st to the right needle (= increased by two st)

Pattern

Beginning

Cast on four sts.

row 1 *knit 1 st without slipping the st off the needle, knit into the back leg of the st and slip the st onto the right needle*, repeat from * to * for the whole round

row 2 *yarn over while slipping 1 st purlwise, purl 1 st including yarn over*, repeat from * to * for the whole round (= 8 sts)

Increases 1

row 1 *increase, yarn over while slipping 1 st purlwise *, repeat from * to * for the whole round (= 16 sts)

row 2 *yarn over while slipping 1 st purlwise, purl 1 st including yarn over*, repeat from * to * for the whole round (= 16 sts)

Knit row 1 and 2 for a total of 2 times (= 32 sts).

Increases 2

Place stitch markers (SM) after 2, 7, 10, 15, 18, 23, 26 and 31 sts.

row 1 Knit in pattern to SM 1, slip SM1 onto the right needle, **increase**
Knit in pattern to SM 2, **increase**, slip SM2 onto the right needle,
Knit in pattern to SM 3, slip SM3 onto the right needle, **increase**,
Knit in pattern to SM 4, **increase**, slip SM4 onto the right needle,
Knit in pattern to SM 5, slip SM5 onto the right needle, **increase**,
Knit in pattern to SM 6, **increase**, slip SM6 onto the right needle
Knit in pattern to SM 7, slip SM7 onto the right needle, **increase**,
Knit in pattern to SM 8, **increase** slip SM8 onto the right needle
Knit in pattern to the end of the round (= 16 increases/ 48 sts)

row 2 *yarn over while slipping 1 st purlwise, purl 1 st including yarn over*, repeat from * to * for the whole round

row 3 *knit 1 st including yarn over, yarn over while slipping 1 st purlwise*, repeat from * to * for the whole round

row 4 as row 2

row 5 as row 3

row 6 as row 2

row 7 as row 3

row 8 as row 2

Knit row 1-8 a total of four times (= 96 sts).

Straight part

Keep knitting straight in brioche stitch:

- row 1 *knit 1 st including yarn over, yarn over while slipping 1 st purlwise*, repeat from * to * for the whole round
- row 2 *yarn over while slipping 1 st purlwise, purl 1 st including yarn over*, repeat from * to * for the whole round

Knit until the hat measures 28 cm, you run out of yarn or to the length that you prefer.

Cast off loosely using the italian bind off. Weave in all the ends.

Hanna hat

Gauge swatch	18 sts x 60 rows on 3,5 mm needle = 10 x 10 cm in brioche stitch

Brioche stitch in the round

row 1	knit 1 stitch (st) including yarn over, yarn over while slipping 1 st purlwise
row 2	yarn over while slipping 1 st purlwise, purl 1 st including yarn over

Two coloured brioche is created by knitting row 1 in colour A and row 2 in colour B.

Increases in brioche stitch

Knit 1 st without slipping the st off the left needle, yarn over, knit into the same st again, this time slipping the st to the right needle (= increased by two st)

Pattern

Beginning

Cast on four sts.

row 1	*knit 1 st without slipping the st off the needle, knit into the back leg of the st and slip the st onto the right needle*, repeat from * to * for the whole round
row 2	*yarn over while slipping 1 st purlwise, purl 1 st including yarn over*, repeat from * to * for the whole round (= 8 sts)

Increases 1

row 1	*increase, yarn over while slipping 1 st purlwise *, repeat from * to * for the whole round (= 16 sts)
row 2	*yarn over while slipping 1 st purlwise, purl 1 st including yarn over*, repeat from * to * for the whole round (= 16 sts)

Knit row 1 and 2 for a total of 2 times (= 32 sts).

Increases 2

Place stitch markers (SM) after 2, 7, 10, 15, 18, 23, 26 and 31 sts.

row 1	Knit in pattern to SM 1, slip SM1 onto the right needle, increase Knit in pattern to SM 2, increase , slip SM2 onto the right needle, Knit in pattern to SM 3, slip SM3 onto the right needle, increase , Knit in pattern to SM 4, increase , slip SM4 onto the right needle, Knit in pattern to SM 5, slip SM5 onto the right needle, increase , Knit in pattern to SM 6, increase , slip SM6 onto the right needle Knit in pattern to SM 7, slip SM7 onto the right needle, increase , Knit in pattern to SM 8, increase slip SM8 onto the right needle Knit in pattern to the end of the round (= 16 increases/ 48 sts)
row 2	*yarn over while slipping 1 st purlwise, purl 1 st including yarn over*, repeat from * to * for the whole round
row 3	*knit 1 st including yarn over, yarn over while slipping 1 st purlwise*, repeat from * to * for the whole round
row 4	as row 2
row 5	as row 3
row 6	as row 2
row 7	as row 3
row 8	as row 2

Knit row 1-8 a total of four times (= 96 sts).

Straight part

Keep knitting straight in brioche stitch:

row 1	*knit 1 st including yarn over, yarn over while slipping 1 st purlwise*, repeat from * to * for the whole round
row 2	*yarn over while slipping 1 st purlwise, purl 1 st including yarn over*, repeat from * to * for the whole round

Knit until the hat measures 28 cm, you run out of yarn or to the length that you prefer.

Cast off loosely using the italian bind off. Weave in all the ends.
