BERET in Hayfield BONUS ARAN

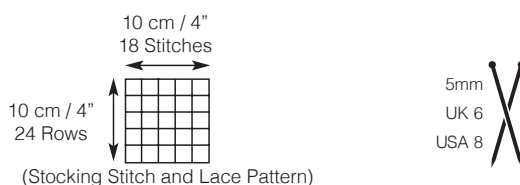
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MEASUREMENTS

Circumference	49 cm 19 1/4"
Yarn* No Balls	1
Yarn	F236 Hayfield Bonus, Aran, 100g, shade 591 Sky Marl
You also need	1 5mm (UK6 – USA8) 40cm Circular Needle (or longer if magic loop method is preferred), 1 4mm (UK8 – USA6) 40cm Circular Needle (or longer if magic loop method is preferred). 1 set of 5mm (UK6 – USA8) Double Pointed Needles (if required) for Crown Shaping.

*Average number of balls required when you use the specified Hayfield yarn and tension shown below

STITCHES & ABBREVIATIONS

alt – alternate
beg – beginning
cm – centimetres
cont – continue
g – grammes
in – inch(es)
k – knit
mm – millimetres
p – purl
patt – pattern
psso – pass slipped stitch over
rem – remain(ing)
rep – repeat
rnd(s) – round(s)
s1 – slip 1 stitch knitways
st(s) – stitch(es)
tog – together
yfwd – yarn forward
m1 – pick up loop between last and next stitch and knit into the back of this loop

Using 4mm circular needle and thumb method cast on 98 sts.

Place a marker for beg of rnd.

1st Rnd. * K1, p1, rep from * to end.

1st rnd sets **1x1 rib**.

Work 7 rnds more in rib.

9th Rnd. K2, (m1, k5) 5 times, (m1, k4) 11 times, (m1, k5) 5 times, m1, k2. 120 sts.

Change to 5mm circular needle and proceed as follows:-

Next Rnd. Knit.

Last rnd sets **st-st** (stocking stitch).

Work 1 rnd more in st-st.

Proceed as follows:-

1st Rnd. * K4, k2tog, yfwd, rep from * to end.

2nd to 4th Rnd. Knit.

5th Rnd. K1, * k2tog, yfwd, k4, rep from * to last 5 sts, k2tog, yfwd, k3.

6th to 8th Rnd. Knit.

9th Rnd. * K4, k2tog, yfwd, rep from * to end.

From 1st to 9th rnd sets lace patt.

Proceed as follows:-

Working in st-st (throughout) cont until beret measures 11.5cm, (4 1/2 in).

Shape Crown

1st Rnd. * S1, k1, psso, k10, rep from * to end. 110 sts.

2nd and 3rd Rnds. Knit.

4th Rnd. * S1, k1, psso, k9, rep from * to end. 100 sts.

5th and 6th Rnds. Knit.

7th Rnd. * S1, k1, psso, k8, rep from * to end. 90 sts.

8th and 9th Rnds. Knit.

10th Rnd. * S1, k1, psso, k7, rep from * to end. 80 sts.

11th and Every Alt Rnd. Knit.

12th Rnd. * S1, k1, psso, k6, rep from * to end. 70 sts.

14th Rnd. * S1, k1, psso, k5, rep from * to end. 60 sts.

16th Rnd. * S1, k1, psso, k4, rep from * to end. 50 sts.

18th Rnd. * S1, k1, psso, k3, rep from * to end. 40 sts.

20th Rnd. * S1, k1, psso, k2, rep from * to end. 30 sts.

22nd Rnd. * S1, k1, psso, k1, rep from * to end. 20 sts.

24th Rnd. * S1, k1, psso, rep from * to end. 10 sts.

Break off yarn. Thread yarn through rem 10 sts, draw up and fasten off.

TO COMPLETE

Cover with a damp cloth and leave until dry. See ball band for washing and further care instructions.
