

Gryer

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Yarn

Kokon Worsted, 100% alpaca (218 yds/200m per 100g):

1 skein in color A; *shown in Cloud #WBA04*

1 skein in color B; *shown in Dew #WBA03*

1 skein in color C; *shown in Mist #WBA05*

Needles

US 7 (4.5 mm) circular needle, 40" (100 cm) long or size needed to get gauge.

Gauge

17.5 sts x 32 rows = 4 x 4" (10 x 10 cm) in Garter Stitch after blocking.

Gauge is not crucial for this project, but will affect yardage and final size when different.

Finished measurements

Approx 69" (175 cm) wingspan and 43" (110 cm) wide.

Notions

Tapestry needle, blocking tools.

Notes

Gryer is a simple but elegant tricolored triangular shawl. It is worked in worsted weight yarn starting at the narrow point of the left edge and increasing on every other row to a full side of the right edge. It is worked predominantly in garter stitch making it super soft and squishy. Eyelet rows and thin stripes are added when shifting to the next color to give it extra interest and the opportunity for individuality.

Note: This pattern makes an excellent stash buster project and is easy to adjust to incorporate more colors or to use the yarn you have available. To do this for any amount of yarn or any weight, you will need to use approx 3/5 of each color for the garter section and the remaining 2/5 of that color for the eyelet/stripe section. Every garter section should end with an even stitch count to make sure that the pattern instructions for the eyelet/stripe section work as written.

Abbreviations

CO: cast on

k: knit

kfb: knit into the front loop, then into the back loop of the same stitch (increase)

k2tog: knit 2 sts together (decrease)

LH: left hand

p: purl

rep: repeat

RH: right hand

RS: right side

sl: slip (purlwise)

st(s): stitch(es)

tbl: through the back loop(s)

yo: yarn over (increase)

WS: wrong side

wyif: with yarn held in front



Instructions

With US 7 (4.5 mm) circular needle and using the long-tail cast on, CO 5 sts with color A.

First Row (WS): Knit.

Please note: Increases are worked at the end of every RS row throughout.

Garter section (color A)

Row 1 (RS): Sl 1 wyif, knit to last 2 sts, kfb, k1 – 6 sts

Row 2 (WS): Knit to last 2 sts, sl 1 wyif, k1.

Rep last 2 rows 68 more times – 74 sts

Eyelet section (color A)

Row 1 (RS): Sl 1 wyif, knit to last 2 sts, kfb, k1 – 75 sts

Row 2 (WS): K2, (k2tog, yo) to last 3 sts, k1, sl 1 wyif, k1.

Row 3 (RS): Rep row 1.

Row 4 (WS): Knit to last 2 sts, sl 1 wyif, k1.

Row 5 to 8: Rep rows 3 + 4 two more times.

Rep rows 1 to 8 one more time, then rows 1 to 5 once more – 85 sts

Next row (WS): Knit to last 2 sts, sl 1 wyif, change to color B, k1.

Stripe section (color A + B)

Row 1 (color B): Sl 1 wyif, knit to last 2 sts, kfb, k1 – 86 sts

Row 2 (color B): Knit to last 2 sts, sl 1 wyif, change to color A, k1.

Row 3 (color A): Rep row 1.

Row 4 (color A): Knit to last 2 sts, sl 1 wyif, change to color B, k1.

Rep rows 1 to 4 two more times, break color A and continue in color B – 91 sts

Garter section (color B)

Row 1 (RS): Sl 1 wyif, knit to last 2 sts, kfb, k1 – 92 sts.

Row 2 (WS): Knit to last 2 sts, sl 1 wyif, k1.

Rep last 2 rows 22 more times – 114 sts

Eyelet section (color B)

Row 1 (RS): Sl 1 wyif, knit to last 2 sts, kfb, k1 – 115 sts

Row 2 (WS): K2, (k2tog, yo) to last 3 sts, k1, sl 1 wyif, k1.

Row 3 (RS): Rep row 1.

Row 4 (WS): Knit to last 2 sts, sl 1 wyif, k1.

Row 5 to 8: Rep rows 3 + 4 two more times.

Rep rows 1 to 8 one more time, then rows 1 to 5 once more – 125 sts

Next row (WS): Knit to last 2 sts, sl 1 wyif, change to color C, k1.

Stripe section (color B + C)

Row 1 (color C): Sl 1 wyif, knit to last 2 sts, kfb, k1 – 126 sts

Row 2 (color C): Knit to last 2 sts, sl 1 wyif, change to color B, k1.

Row 3 (color B): Rep row 1.

Row 4 (color B): Knit to last 2 sts, sl 1 wyif, change to color C, k1.

Rep rows 1 to 4 two more times, break color B and continue in color C to end – 131 sts

Garter section (color C)

Row 1 (RS): Sl 1 wyif, knit to last 2 sts, kfb, k1 – 132 sts.

Row 2 (WS): Knit to last 2 sts, sl 1 wyif, k1.

Repeat last 2 rows 14 more times – 146 sts

Eyelet section (color C)

Row 1 (RS): Sl 1 wyif, knit to last 2 sts, kfb, k1 – 147 sts

Row 2 (WS): K2, (k2tog, yo) to last 3 sts, k1, sl 1 wyif, k1.

Row 3 (RS): Rep row 1.

Row 4 (WS): Knit to last 2 sts, sl 1 wyif, k1.

Row 5 to 8: Rep rows 3 + 4 two more times.

Rep rows 1 to 8 one more time, then rows 1 to 4 once more – 156 sts

I-Cord Edging

Bind off all sts as follows: Sl 1 wyif, k1, (slip 2 sts back to LH needle, k1, k2tog tbl) to end, slip first stitch on RH needle over last stitch, break yarn and pull through last stitch.

Weave in ends and wet block.
