This is a very practical small shawl with an Art Deco influence. The shape allows it to stay on your shoulders without pinning or tying. Wear it over a coat or alone as a decorative accent.

Ideal for fall.

skill level intermediate

finished measurements

62" x 24" [157.5 x 61cm]

materials

Sweet Georgia Superwash DK, one skein each of the following colours:

Black Plum, Lettuce Wrap, Lucky
English Ivy, Cayenne

needles

7US [4.5mm]

gauge

22sts 4" [10cm] on 7US [4.5mm] needles in garter stitch

techniques & special abbreviations

ce – chain edge – keep yarn in front and slip the first stitch purlwise; take yarn to back between needles before the next stitch.

cdd – centred double decrease – slip 2 stitches together knitwise, knit 1, pass both slipped stitches over.

Crochet cast on at the **start of a row**

make a slip knot and put it on a crochet hook of about the same size as your needle. *Wrap the yarn around your knitting needle and draw it through the loop on the hook. Repeat from * for one less than the required number of stitches. Place the loop from the hook onto the knitting needle to form the last stitch.

Crochet cast on at the **end of the row**

knit into the front and the back of the last stitch, place the final stitch onto the crochet hook. Follow the previous instructions from *.

Changing Colours – before the last stitch in the row bring the old colour to the front and cut it, leaving a 10 cm tail. Leaving a similar tail of the new colour, knit the last stitch of the row in the new colour. This stitch will be slipped at the start of the next row. Work in both tails as you work the next row.

Section 1

With Black Plum, crochet cast on 56 sts

Row 1 (WS): ce, k 26, p2tog, k26, change colour to c2 (see notes for details on how to change colours

Row 2: (RS) ce, k25, cdd, k26

Row 3: ce, k25, p1, k26

Row 4: ce, k24, cdd, k25

Row 5: ce, k24, p1, k25

Row 6: ce, k23, cdd, k24

Row 7: ce, k23, p1, k24

Row 8: ce, k22, cdd, k23

Row 9: ce, k22, p1, k23

Row 10: ce, k21, cdd, k22

Row 11: ce, k21, p1, k22

Row 12: ce, k20, cdd, k21

Row 13: ce, k20, p1, k21

Row 14: ce, k19, cdd, k20

Row 15: ce, k19, p1, k20

Row 16: ce, k18, cdd, k19

Row 17: ce, purl to end

Row 18: ce, k17, cdd, k18

Row 19: ce, k17, p1, k18

Row 20: ce, k16, cdd, k17

Row 21: ce, k16, p1, k17

Row 22: ce, k15, cdd, k16

Row 23: ce, k15, p1, k16

Row 24: ce, k14, cdd, k15

Row 25: ce, k14, p1, k15

Row 26: ce, k13, cdd, k14

Row 27: ce, k13, p1, k14

Row 28: ce, k12, cdd, k13

Row 29: ce, k12, p1, k13

Row 30: ce, k11, cdd, k12

Row 31: ce, purl to end

Row 32: ce, k10, cdd, k11

Row 33: ce, k10, p1, k11

Row 34: ce, k9, cdd, k10

Row 35: ce, k9, p1, k10

Row 36: ce, k8, cdd, k9

Row 37: ce, k8, p1, k9

Row 38: ce, k7, cdd, k8

Row 39: ce, k7, p1, k8

Row 40: ce, k6, cdd, k7

Row 41: ce, k6, p1, k7

Row 42: ce, k5, cdd, k6

Row 43: ce, k5, p1, k6

Row 44: ce, k4, cdd, k5

Row 45: ce, k4, p1, k5

Row 46: ce, k3, cdd, k4

Row 47: ce, k3, p1, k4

Row 48: ce, k2, cdd, k3

Row 49: ce, k2, p1, k3

Row 50: ce, k1, cdd, k2

Row 51: ce, k1, p1, k2

Row 52: ce, cdd, k1

Row 53: ce, p1, k1

Row 54: cdd. Break yarn and pull tail through final stitch.

Section 2

With RS facing, using Black Plum, pick up and knit 27 sts along upper left edge of section 1, then crochet cast on 63 more sts (90 sts total)

Row 1: ce, k61, p2tog, k25, change colour to Lettuce Wrap, k1

Row 2: ce, k24, cdd, k to end

Row 3 and all WS rows: CE, knit to decrease st, p1, knit to end

Row 4: ce, k23, cdd, k to end

Continue in the same manner until 11 ridges (one Black Plum, ten Lettuce Wrap) are completed, changing colour to Lucky at end of final WS row.

Complete 9 ridges with Lucky, changing to English Ivy at the end of the final WS row.

Complete 7 ridges with English Ivy; place remaining 37 sts on a holder.

Section 3

This is a mirror image of section 2. With Black Plum, crochet cast on 63 st, then pick up and knit 27 sts along the upper right edge of section 1 (90 sts total).

Row 1: ce, k25, p2tog, k61, change colour to Lettuce Wrap, k1

Row 2: ce, k60, cdd, k25

Continue as for section 2.

Place last 37 sts on a holder.

Section 4

With Black Plum, pick up and knit the 11 sts closest to the centre on the upper left edge of section 3, one st from the top of section 1, then the 11 sts closest to the centre on the upper right edge of section 2. (23 sts)

Row 1: ce, k10, p1, k10, change to Lettuce Wrap and k1

Row 2: ce, k9, cdd, k10

Continue as for previous sections until only 1 st remains. Break yarn and pull tail through.

Section 5

With Black Plum, pick up and knit 11 sts from upper left edge of section 4, 15 sts from upper right of section 2, then knit 37 sts from holder. (63 sts)

Row 1: ce, k50, p2 tog, k9, change colour to Cayenne, k1

Row 2: ce, k8, cdd, k50

Continue as for previous sections until 10 ridges of Cayenne are completed. Place remaining 42 sts on a holder.

Section 6

This is a mirror image of section 5. With Black Plum, knit 37 sts from holder in section 3, pick up and knit 15 sts from upper left edge of section 3, then 11 from upper right edge of section 4.

Row 1: ce, k9, p2 tog, k50, change colour to Cayenne, k1

Row 2: ce, k48, cdd, k9

Continue as for previous sections until 10 ridges of Cayenne are completed. Place remaining 42 sts on a holder.

Section 7

With Black Plum, knit leftmost 8 sts from holder of section 6, then pick up and knit 10 sts from same left edge, 1 st at point of section 4, 10 sts from upper right edge of section 5, then knit first 8 sts from holder of section 5 (37 sts).

Row 1: ce, k17, p1, k17, change colour to Lucky, k1

Row 2: ce, k16, cdd, k17

Continue as for previous sections until only 1 st remains. Break yarn and pull tail through.

Section 8

With Black Plum, pick up and knit 18 sts along upper left edge of section 7, then knit up remaining 34 sts from holder in section 5 (52 sts).

Row 1: ce, k32, p2 tog, k16, change colour to English Ivy, k1

Row 2: ce, k15, cdd, k32

Continue as for previous sections until 17 ridges of English Ivy are completed. Place remaining 17 sts on a holder.

Section 9

This is a mirror image of section 8. With Black Plum, knit up remaining 34 sts from holder in section 6, then pick up and knit 18 sts along upper right edge of section 7 (52 sts).

Row 1: ce, k16, p2 tog, k32, change colour to English Ivy, k1

Row 2: ce, k31, cdd, k16

Continue as for previous sections until 17 ridges of English Ivy are completed. Place remaining 17 sts on a holder.

Section 10

With Black Plum, pick up and knit 17 sts along upper left edge of section 9, 1 st in point of section 7, and 17 sts along upper right edge of section 8.

Row 1: ce, k16, p1, k16, change colour to Lettuce Wrap, k1

Row 2: ce, k15, cdd, k16

Continue as for previous sections until only 1 st remains. Break yarn and pull tail through.

Section 11

With Black Plum, pick up and knit 17 sts along the upper left edge of section 10, then knit up the 17 sts on the holder from section 8.

Row 1: ce, k15, p2 tog, k14, change colour to Cayenne, k2tog

Row 2: ce, k13, cdd, k13, k2tog

Row 3: ce, k13, p1, k12, k2tog

Row 4: ce, k11, cdd, k11, k2tog

Row 5: ce, k11, p1, k10, k2tog

Row 6: ce, k9, cdd, k9, k2tog

Row 7: ce, k9, p1, k8, k2tog

Row 8: ce, k7, cdd, k7, k2tog

Row 9: ce, k7, p1, k6, k2tog

Row 10: ce, k5, cdd, k5, k2 tog

Row 11: ce, k5, p1, k4, k2tog

Row 12: ce, k3, cdd, k3, k2tog

Row 13: ce, k3, p1, k2, k2tog

Row 14: ce, k1, cdd, k1, k2tog

Row 15: ce, k1, p1, k2tog

Row 16: sl2 tog knitwise, k2tog, p2sso

Break yarn and thread through final st.

Section 12

With Black Plum, knit up the 17 sts on the holder from section 9, then pick up and knit 17 sts along the upper right edge of section 10. Follow the instructions for section 11.

Front Left Wing

With Black Plum, pick up and knit 57 sts along upper left edge of back sections, starting with the ridge of Black Plum from section 11 and ending at the starting ridge of Black Plum in section 2.

Edge Row: ce, k56

Row 1: With Black Plum, crochet cast on 99.

Row 2: sl1, k97, ssk last st and one stitch from edge

Row 3: with English Ivy, sl1, k39, turn

Row 4: sl1, k39, ssk last st and one Black Plum st from edge.

Row 5: sl1, k49, turn

Row 6: sl1, k49, ssk with last st and one edge st

Row 7: sl1, k59, turn

Row 8: sl1, k59, ssk with last st and one edge st

Row 9: sl1, k69, turn

Row 10: sl1, k69, ssk with last st and one edge st

Row 11: sl1, k79, turn

Row 12: sl1, k79, ssk with last st and one edge st

Row 13: sl1, k89, turn

Row 14: sl1, k89, ssk with last st and one edge st

Row 15: With Black Plum, sl1, k98

Row 16: sl1, k 98, ssk last st and one stitch from edge

Repeat rows 3 to 14 with Lucky, rows

15-16 with Black Plum, rows 3-14 with Lettuce Wrap and rows 15-16 with Black Plum. Repeat rows 3 to 16 with Cayenne.

Row 17: Continuing with Cayenne, sl1, k89, turn

Row 18: sl1, k89, ssk with last st and one st edge

Row 19: sl1, k79, turn

Row 20: sl1, k79, ssk with last st and one edge st

Row 21: sl1, k69, turn

Row 22: sl1, k69, ssk with last st and one edge st

Row 23: sl1, k59, turn

Row 24: sl1, k59, ssk with last st and one edge st

Row 25: sl1, k49, turn

Row 26: sl1, k49, ssk with last st and one edge st

Row 27: sl1, k39, turn

Row 28: sl1, k39, ssk last st and one Black Plum st from edge.

Row 29: With Black Plum, sl1, k98

Row 30: sl1, k98, ssk last st and one stitch from edge

Repeat rows 17 to 28 with Lettuce Wrap, rows 29-30 with Black Plum, rows 17 to 28 with Lucky, rows 29-30 with Black Plum, rows 17 to 28 with English Ivy, row 30 with Black Plum, then cast off all stitches with Black Plum.

Front Right Wing

With Black Plum, pick up and knit 57 sts along upper right edge of back sections, starting at the first ridge of Black Plum in section 2 and ending with the ridge of Black Plum from section 11.

Repeat the instructions for the left front wing, starting with the edge row.

Neck Edge

With Black Plum, pick up and knit: 1 st in Black Plum ridge at start of right front wing

1 st in Black Plum ridge at start of section 12, 15 sts across top of section 12,

1 in each of the next ridge of Black Plum, the top of section 10, and next ridge of Black Plum

15 sts across top of section 11,

1 sts in Black Plum ridge of section 11,

1 sts in ridge at start of left front.

37 sts total

Cast off all sts.
