22 sts = 4" (10.2 cm); 28 rows = 4"
(10.2 cm) in St st

22 sts = 4" (10.2 cm); 33 rows = 4"
(10.2 cm) in GARTER st

22 sts = 4" (10.2 cm); 44 rows = 4"
(10.2 cm) in mosaic pattern

**NOTE**

This shawl is worked flat from the upper left tip towards the right edge, then neatly finished with a 2 stitch I-cord bind-off. Its slightly asymmetrical triangle shape is achieved by working simple increases at the end of each RS row. Mosaic pattern bands add some color.

General principle of mosaic patterns:

Mosaic patterns are 2 color slip-stitch patterns. 2 different colors are used, one at a time.

Every slip stitch is slipped purlwise with yarn in back on RS rows and with yarn in front on WS rows.

Every WS row is like the preceding RS row, with the same stitches being worked and the same stitches being slipped.

Mosaic pattern, see chart on page 108 (pattern repeat = 12 sts)

Row 1 (CC2): Sl 1 wyif, knit to last 2 sts, kfb, k1.

Row 2 (CC2): Knit to last 2 sts, sl 1 wyif, change to CC1, k1.

Row 3 (CC1): Sl 1 wyif, k2, [(k2, sl 1 wyib) twice, k1, sl 1 wyib, k2, sl 1 wyib, k1] to last 3 sts, k1, kfb, k1.

Row 4 (CC1): K4, [(k1, sl 1 wyif, k2, sl 1 wyif) twice, k2] to last 3 sts, k1, sl 1 wyif, change to CC2, k1.

Row 5 (CC2): Sl 1 wyif, k2, [(sl 1 wyib, k2) 4 times], to last 4 sts, sl 1 wyib, k1, kfb, k1.

Row 6 (CC2): K4, sl 1 wyif, [(k2, sl 1 wyif) 4 times] to last 3 sts, k1, sl 1 wyif, change to CC1, k1.

Row 7 (CC1): Sl 1 wyif, k2, [k1, sl 1 wyib, k2, sl 1 wyib, k3, sl 1 wyib, k2, sl 1 wyib] to last 5 sts, k1, sl 1 wyib, k1, kfb, k1.

Row 8 (CC1): K4, sl 1 wyif, k1 [sl 1 wyif, k2, sl 1 wyif, k3, sl 1 wyif, k2, sl 1 wyif, k1] to last 3 sts, k1, sl 1 wyif, change to CC2, k1.

Row 9 (CC2): Sl 1 wyif, k2, [(k2, sl 1 wyib) twice, k1, sl 1 wyib, k2, sl 1 wyib, k1] to last 6 sts, k2, sl 1 wyib, k1, kfb, k1.

Row 10 (CC2): K4, sl 1 wyif, k2, [(k1, sl 1 wyif, k2, sl 1 wyif) twice, k2] to last 3 sts, k1, sl 1 wyif, change to CC1, k1.

Row 11 (CC1): Sl 1 wyif, k2, [(sl 1 wyib, k2) 4 times] to last 7 sts, sl 1 wyib, k2, sl 1 wyib, k1, kfb, k1.

Row 12 (CC1): K4, sl 1 wyif, k2, sl 1 wyif, [(k2, sl 1 wyif) 4 times] to last 3 sts, k1, sl 1 wyif, change to CC2, k1.

Row 13 (CC2): Sl 1 wyif, k2, [k1, sl 1 wyib, k2, sl 1 wyib, k3, sl 1 wyib, k2, sl 1 wyib] to last 8 sts, k1, sl 1 wyib, k2, sl 1 wyib, k1, kfb, k1.

Row 14 (CC2): K4, sl 1 wyif, k2, sl 1 wyif, k1, [sl 1 wyif, k2, sl 1 wyif, k3, sl 1 wyif, k2, sl 1 wyif, k1] to last 3 sts, k1, sl 1 wyif, change to CC1, k1.

Row 15 (CC1): Sl 1 wyif, k2, [(k2, sl 1 wyib) twice, k1, sl 1 wyib, k2, sl 1 wyib, k1] to last 9 sts, (k2, sl 1 wyib) twice, k1, kfb, k1.

Row 16 (CC1): K4, (sl 1 wyif, k2) twice, [(k1, sl 1 wyif, k2, sl 1 wyif) twice, k2] to last 3 sts, k1, sl 1 wyif, change to CC2, k1.

Row 17 (CC2): Sl 1 wyif, k2, [(sl 1 wyib, k2) 4 times] to last 10 sts, (sl 1 wyib, k2) twice, sl 1 wyib, k1, kfb, k1.

Row 18 (CC2): K4, sl 1 wyif, (k2, sl 1 wyif) twice, [(k2, sl 1 wyif) 4

times] to last 3 sts, k1, sl 1 wyif, change to CC1, k1.

Row 19 (CC1): Sl 1 wyif, k2, [k1, sl 1 wyib, k2, sl 1 wyib, k3, sl 1 wyib, k2, sl 1 wyib] to last 11 sts, k1, sl 1 wyib, k2, sl 1 wyib, k3, sl 1 wyib, kfb, k1.

Row 20 (CC1): K3, sl 1 wyif, k3, sl 1 wyif, k2, sl 1 wyif, k1, [sl 1 wyif, k2, sl 1 wyif, k3, sl 1 wyif, k2, sl 1 wyif, k1] to last 3 sts, k1, sl 1 wyif, change to CC2, k1.

Row 21 (CC2): Sl 1 wyif, k2, [(sl 1 wyib, k2) 4 times] to last 12 sts, (sl 1 wyib, k2) 3 times, sl 1 wyib, kfb, k1.

Row 22 (CC2): K3, sl 1 wyif, (k2, sl 1 wyif) 3 times, [(k2, sl 1 wyif) 4 times] to last 3 sts, k1, sl 1 wyif, change to CC1, k1.

Row 23 (CC1): Sl 1 wyif, k2, [(k2, sl 1 wyib) twice, k1, sl 1 wyib, k2, sl 1 wyib, k1] to last 13 sts, (k2, sl 1 wyib) twice, k1, sl 1 wyib, k2, sl 1 wyib, kfb, k1.

Row 24 (CC1): K3, sl 1 wyif, k2, sl 1 wyif, k1, (sl 1 wyif, k2) twice, [(k1, sl 1 wyif, k2, sl 1 wyif) twice, k2] to last 3 sts, k1, sl 1 wyif, change to CC2, k1.

Row 25 (CC2): Sl 1 wyif, k2, [k1, sl 1 wyib, k2, sl 1 wyib, k3, sl 1 wyib, k2, sl 1 wyib] to last 2 sts, kfb, k1.

Row 26 (CC2): K3, [sl 1 wyif, k2, sl 1 wyif, k3, sl 1 wyif, k2, sl 1 wyif, k1] to last 3 sts, k1, sl 1 wyif, change to CC1, k1.

Row 27 (CC1): Sl 1 wyif, k2, [(sl 1 wyib, k2) 4 times] to last 3 sts, sl 1 wyib, kfb, k1.

Row 28 (CC1): K3, sl 1 wyif, [(k2, sl 1 wyif) 4 times] to last 3 sts, k1, sl 1 wyif, change to CC2, k1.

Row 29 (CC2): Sl 1 wyif, k2, [(k2, sl 1 wyib) twice, k1, sl 1 wyib, k2, sl 1 wyib, k1] to last 4 sts, k2, kfb, k1.

Row 30 (CC2): K5, [(k1, sl 1 wyif, k2, sl 1 wyif) twice, k2] to last 3 sts, k1, sl 1 wyif, change to CC1, k1.

Row 31 (CC1): Sl 1 wyif, k2, [k1, sl 1 wyib, k2, sl 1 wyib, k3, sl 1 wyib, k2, sl 1 wyib] to last 5 sts, k1, sl 1 wyib, k1, kfb, k1.

Row 32 (CC1): K4, sl 1 wyif, k1, [sl 1 wyif, k2, sl 1 wyif, k3, sl 1 wyif, k2, sl 1 wyif, k1] to last 3 sts, k1, sl 1 wyif, change to CC2, k1.

Row 33 (CC2): Sl 1 wyif, k2, [(sl 1 wyib, k2) 4 times] to last 6 sts, sl 1 wyib, k2, sl 1 wyib, kfb, k1.

Row 34 (CC2): K3, sl 1 wyif, k2, sl 1 wyif, [(k2, sl 1 wyif) 4 times] to last 3 sts, k1, sl 1 wyif, change to CC1, k1.

Row 35 (CC1): Sl 1 wyif, k2, [(k2, sl 1 wyib) twice, k1, sl 1 wyib, k2, sl 1 wyib, k1] to last 7 sts, k2, sl 1 wyib, k2, kfb, k1.

Row 36 (CC1): K5, sl 1 wyif, k2, [(k1, sl 1 wyif, k2, sl 1 wyif) twice, k2] to last 3 sts, k1, sl 1 wyif, change to CC2, k1.

Row 37 (CC2): Sl 1 wyif, k2, [(sl 1 wyib, k2) 4 times] to last 8 sts, (sl 1 wyib, k2) twice, kfb, k1.

Row 38 (CC2): K5, sl 1 wyif, k2, sl 1 wyif, [(k2, sl 1 wyif) 4 times] to last 3 sts, k1, sl 1 wyif, change to CC1, k1.

Row 39 (CC1): Sl 1 wyif, k2, [k1, sl 1 wyib, k2, sl 1 wyib, k3, sl 1 wyib, k2, sl 1 wyib] to last 9 sts, k1, sl 1 wyib, k2, sl 1 wyib, k2, kfb, k1.

Row 40 (CC1): K5, sl 1 wyif, k2, sl 1 wyif, k1, [sl 1 wyif, k2, sl 1 wyif, k3, sl 1 wyif, k2, sl 1 wyif, k1] to last 3 sts, k1, sl 1 wyif, change to CC2, k1.





Row 41 (CC2): Sl 1 wyif, k2, [(k2, sl 1 wyib) twice, k1, sl 1 wyib, k2, sl 1 wyib, k1] to last 10 sts, [(k2, sl 1 wyib) twice, k1, sl 1 wyib, kfb, k1.

Row 42 (CC2): K3, sl 1 wyif, k1, (sl 1 wyif, k2) twice, [(k1, sl 1 wyif, k2, sl 1 wyif) twice, k2] to last 3 sts, k1, sl 1 wyif, change to CC1, k1.

Row 43 (CC1): Sl 1 wyif, k2, [(sl 1 wyib, k2) 4 times] to last 11 sts, (sl 1 wyib, k2) 3 times, kfb, k1.

Row 44 (CC1): K3, (k2, sl 1 wyif) 3 times, [(k2, sl 1 wyif) 4 times] to last 3 sts, k1, sl 1 wyif, change to CC2, k1.

Row 45 (CC2): Sl 1 wyif, k2, [k1, sl 1 wyib, k2, sl 1 wyib, k3, sl 1 wyib, k2, sl 1 wyib] to last 12 sts, k1, sl 1 wyib, k2, sl 1 wyib, k3, sl 1 wib, k1, kfb, k1.

Row 46 (CC2): K4, sl 1 wyif, k3, sl 1 wyif, k2, sl 1 wyif, k1, [sl 1 wyif, k2, sl 1 wyif, k3, sl 1 wyif, k2, sl 1 wyif, k1] to last 3 sts, k1, sl 1 wyif, change to CC1, k1.

Row 47 (CC1): Sl 1 wyif, k2, [(k2, sl 1 wyib) twice, k1, sl 1 wyib, k2, sl 1 wyib, k1] to last 13 sts, (k2, sl 1 wyib) twice, k1, sl 1 wyib, k2, sl 1 wyib, kfb, k1.

Row 48 (CC1): K3, sl 1 wyif, k2, sl 1 wyif, k1, sl 1 wyif, k2, sl 1 wyif, k2, [(k1, sl 1 wyif, k2, sl 1 wyif) twice, k2] to last 3 sts, k1, sl 1 wyif, change to CC2, k1.

Row 49 (CC2): Sl 1 wyif, k2, [(sl 1 wyib, k2) 4 times] to last 2 sts, kfb, k1.

Row 50 (CC2): K3, [(k2, sl 1 wyif) 4 times] to last 3 sts, k1, sl 1 wyif, change to CC1, k1.

Row 51 (CC1): Sl 1 wyif, k2, [k1, sl 1 wyib, k2, sl 1 wyib, k3, sl 1 wyib, k2, sl 1 wyib] to last 3 sts, k1, kfb, k1.

Row 52 (CC1): K4, [sl 1 wyif, k2, sl 1 wyif, k3, sl 1 wyif, k2, sl 1 wyif, k1] to last 3 sts, k1, sl 1 wyif, change to CC2, k1.

Row 53 (CC2): Sl 1 wyif, k2, [(sl 1 wyib, k2) 4 times] to last 4 sts, sl 1 wyib, k1, kfb, k1.

Row 54 (CC2): K4, sl 1 wyif, [(k2, sl 1 wyif) 4 times] to last 3 sts, k1, sl 1 wyif, change to CC1, k1.

Row 55 (CC1): Sl 1 wyif, k2, [(k2, sl 1 wyib) twice, k1, sl 1 wyib, k2, sl 1 wyib, k1] to last 5 sts, k2, sl 1 wyib, kfb, k1.

Row 56 (CC1): K3, sl 1 wyif, k2, [(k1, sl 1 wyif, k2, sl 1 wyif) twice, k2] to last 3 sts, k1, sl 1 wyif, change to CC2, k1.

Row 57 (CC2): Sl 1 wyif, k2, [k1, sl 1 wyib, k2, sl 1 wyib, k3, sl 1 wyib, k2, sl 1 wyib] to last 6 sts, k1, sl 1 wyib, k2, kfb, k1.

Row 58 (CC2): K5, sl 1 wyif, k1, [sl 1 wyif, k2, sl 1 wyif, k3, sl 1 wyif, k2, sl 1 wyif, k1] to last 3 sts, k1, sl 1 wyif, change to CC1, k1.

Row 59 (CC1): Sl 1 wyif, k2, [(sl 1 wyib, k2) 4 times], to last 7 sts, sl 1 wyib, k2, sl 1 wyib, k1, kfb, k1.

Row 60 (CC1): K4, sl 1 wyif, k2, sl 1 wyif, [(k2, sl 1 wyif) 4 times] to last 3 sts, k1, sl 1 wyif, change to CC2, k1.

Row 61 (CC2): Sl 1 wyif, k2, [(k2, sl 1 wyib) twice, k1, sl 1 wyib, k2, sl 1 wyib, k1] to last 8 sts, (k2, sl 1 wyib) twice, kfb, k1.

Row 62 (CC2): K3, (sl 1 wyif, k2) twice, [(k1, sl 1 wyif, k2, sl 1 wyif) twice, k2] to last 3 sts, k1, sl 1 wyif, change to CC1, k1.

Row 63 (CC1): Sl 1 wyif, k2, [k1, sl 1 wyib, k2, sl 1 wyib, k3, sl 1

wyib, k2, sl 1 wyib] to last 9 sts, k1, (sl 1 wyib, k2) twice, kfb, k1.

Row 64 (CC1): K3, (k2, sl 1 wyif) twice, k1, [sl 1 wyif, k2, sl 1 wyif, k3, sl 1 wyif, k2, sl 1 wyif, k1] to last 3 sts, k1, sl 1 wyif, change to CC1, k1.

Row 65 (CC2): Sl 1 wyif, k2, [(sl 1 wyib, k2) 4 times] to last 10 sts, (sl 1 wyib, k2) twice, sl 1 wyib, k1, kfb, k1.

Row 66 (CC2): K4, sl 1 wyif, (k2, sl 1 wyif) twice, [(k2, sl 1 wyif) 4 times] to last 3 sts, k1, sl 1 wyif, change to CC1, k1.

Row 67 (CC1): Sl 1 wyif, k2, [(k2, sl 1 wyib) twice, k1, sl 1 wyib, k2, sl 1 wyib, k1] to last 11 sts, (k2, sl 1 wyib) twice, k1, sl 1 wyib, k1, kfb, k1.

Row 68 (CC1): K4, sl 1 wyif, k1, (sl 1 wyif, k2) twice, [(k1, sl 1 wyif, k2, sl 1 wyif) twice, k2] to last 3 sts, k1, sl 1 wyif, change to CC2, k1.

Row 69 (CC2): Sl 1 wyif, knit to last 2 sts, kfb, k1.

Row 70 (CC2): Knit to last 2 sts, sl 1 wyif, change to MC, k1.

INSTRUCTIONS

With MC and US 6 (4 mm) circular needle, using the longtail cast on, CO 6 sts. Do not join.

Row 1 (WS): Knit to last 2 sts, sl1 wyif, k1.

Row 2 (RS): Sl 1 wyif, knit to last 2 sts, kfb, k1. (1 st inc'd)

Row 3 (WS): Knit to last 2 sts, sl 1 wyif, k1.

Rep last 2 rows 116 times – 123 sts

Next Row (RS): Rep row 2.

Next Row (WS): Knit to last 2 sts, sl 1 wyif, change to CC2, k1 – 124 sts

Break Main color, change to US 7 (4.5 mm) cir needle and work rows 1 to 70 from chart or written instructions – 159 sts

Change to US 6 (4 mm) cir needle.

Next Row (RS): Rep row 2.

Next Row (WS): Rep row 3.

Rep last 2 rows 8 more times – 168 sts

Next Row (RS): Rep row 2.

Next Row (WS): Knit to last 2 sts, sl 1 wyif, change to CC2, k1 – 169 sts

Break MC, change to US 7 (4.5 mm) cir needle and work rows 19 to 36 from chart or written instructions – 178 sts

Then rows 69 and 70 from chart or written instructions – 179 sts

Change to US 6 (4 mm) cir needle and continue in MC to end.

Next Row (RS): Rep row 2.

Next Row (WS): Rep row 3.

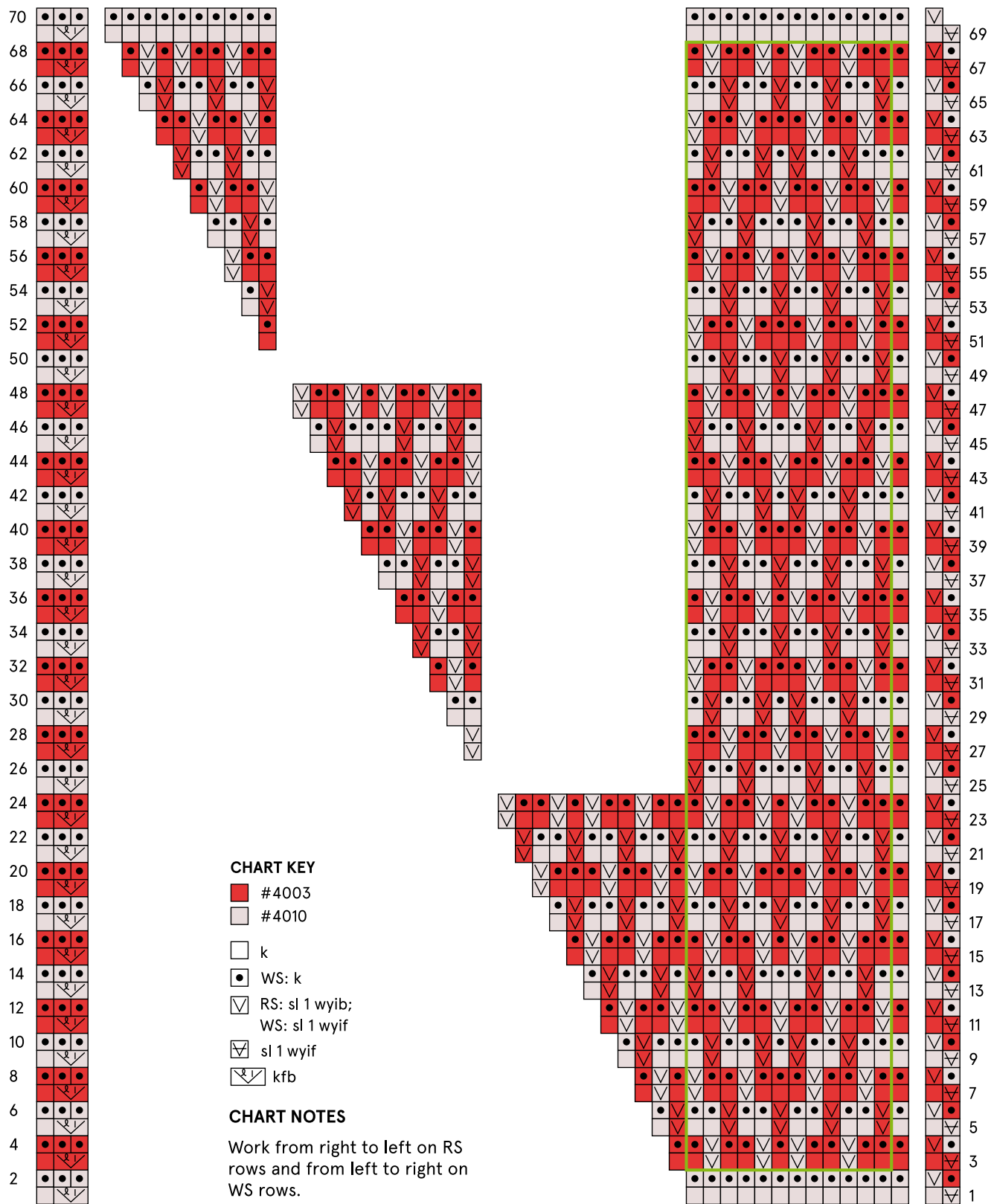
Rep last 2 rows 8 more times – 188 sts

Bind Off Row: Sl 1 wyif, k1, (slip 2 sts back to LH needle, k1, k2tog tbl) to end, slip first stitch over second stitch on RH needle and pull yarn through last loop.

FINISHING

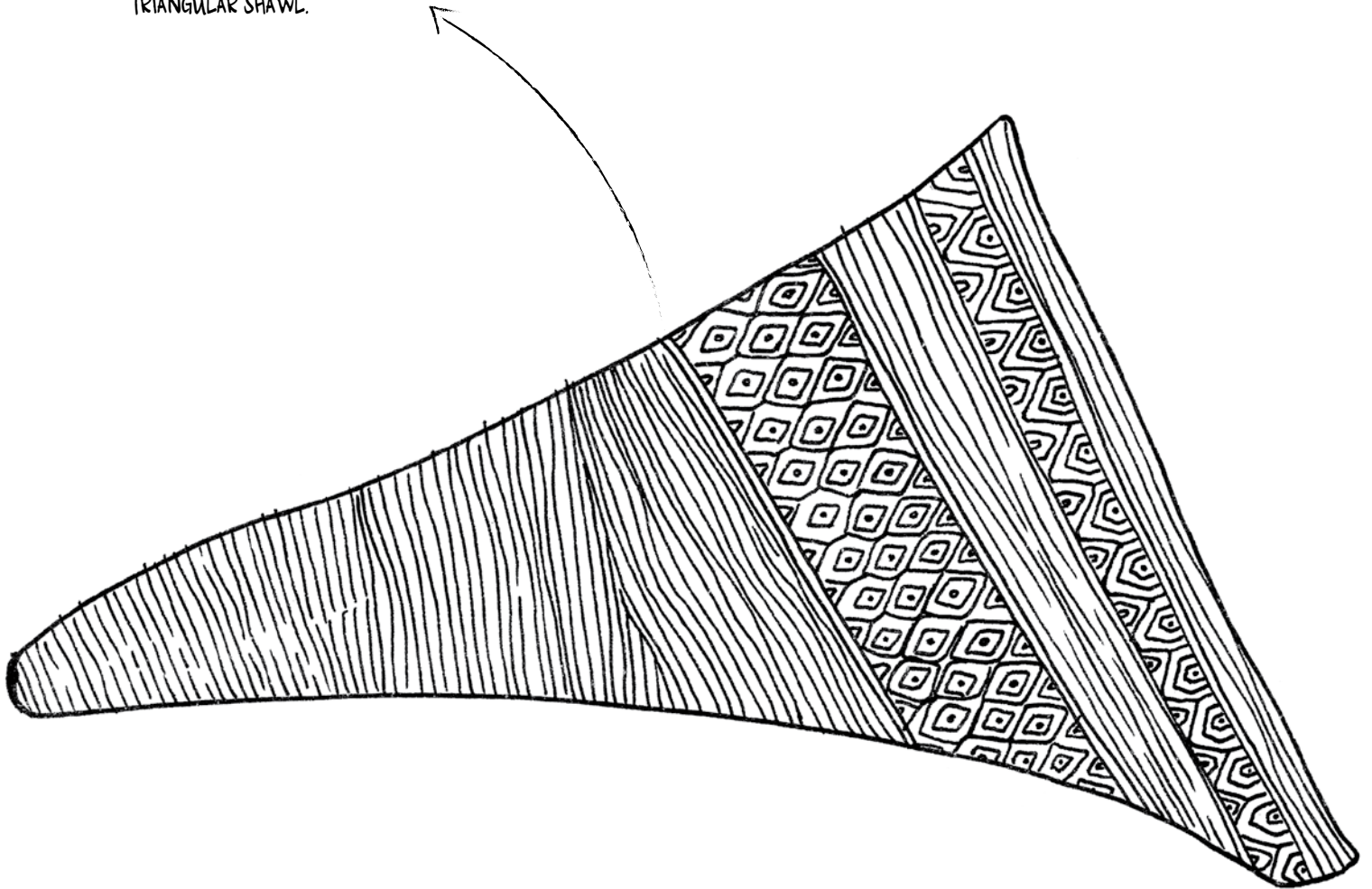
Weave in all ends and wet block.

ABBREVIATIONS & TERMS

beg: beginning
BO: bind off
CO: cast on
cn: cable needle
dec: decrease
dpn: double pointed needles
K: knit
k tbl: knit through the back loop(s)
k2tog: Knit 2 stitches together
k3tog: Knit 3 stitches together
LH: left hand
M1: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).
M1L: Work as for M1.
M1p: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).
M1R: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).
p: purl
PM: place marker
psso: pass slip stitch over knit stitch
p1d: purl 1 st by going under the stitch below and working through both sts.
p2tog: purl 2 stitches together
rep: repeat
RH: right hand
rnd(s): round(s)
RS: right side
sl: slip
sl2tog-k1-psso: Slip 2 together (as if to k2tog), knit 1, pass the 2 slipped stitches over.
SM: slip marker
ssk: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 2 stitches and knit 2 together.
sssk: Slip 3 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 3 stitches and knit 3 together.
st(s): stitch(es)
TBL: through back loop(s)
tog: together
WS: wrong side
wyib: with yarn in back
wyif: with yarn in front
yo: yarn over
end on WS: end having just completed a Wrong Side row.

end on RS: end having just completed a Right Side row.
STOCKINETTE ST (St st): Knit 1 row, purl 1 row alternately when working on straight needles. The knit side is the right side of work. Knit EVERY round when working in the round on a circular needle.
Reverse St st (Rev St st): Purl 1 row, knit 1 row alternately when working on straight needles. The purl side is the right side of the work. Purl EVERY round when working in the round on a circular needle.
GARTER ST: Knit EVERY row when working on straight needles. Knit 1 round, purl 1 round when working on a circular needle.
K1, p1 Rib: Knit 1 st, purl 1 st.
3 Needle Blind Off: With RS together, hold in one hand two needles with the same number of sts on each. with third needle, knit tog 1 st from each needle, *knit tog one st from each needle, pass first st over second to bind off, repeat from *to last st.
