

Lake Reed



You will need:

Yarn: Sidispinnt Merino DK Twist, 220m / 100g

Needlesize: 1x4mm, 1x 5mm circular or double point needle

Gauge: 20 sts / 30 rows with needlesize 5mm =10x10cm

Tapestry needle

1 stitch marker

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Glossary:**st(s):** stitch(es)**k:** knit**p:** purl**ktbl:** Knit through back loop.**k2tog:** knit 2 together**p2tog:** purl 2 together**k2togk:** knit 2 together, do not slide stitches off of your left needle. knit the first stitch again.**2/2 RC** Slip next 2 stitches to cable needle and place at **back** of work, k2, then k2 from cable needle.**2/2 LC:** Slip next 2 stitches to cable needle and place at **front** of work, k2, then k2 from cable needle.**2/2 kRCtog:** Slip next 2 stitches to cable needle and place at **back** of work. knit the first stitch from the left needle and the cable stitch from the left needle together, then knit the second stitch from the needle and the second stitch from the cable needle together.**2/2 kLCtog:** Slip next 2 stitches to cable needle and place at **front** of work. knit the first stitch from the cable needle and the first stitch from the left needle together, then knit the second stitch from the cable needle and the second stitch from the left needle together.**Border:**Needlesize **4mm**:**Cast on 110 sts** with 1/1 rib tubular cast on .<https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=gToTsGMhG3c>*Make sure you knit the cast on tight!*

Close into round and place your stitchmarker as beginning of round.

Knit the 1/1 rib (p,k) until you have 10cm.

Change your needlesize to **5mm** and knit one round, while **pick up 10 sts**.**Pattern:**Knit **Chart 1** 4 times per round, then 2 times the whole chart and again to round 6**Chart 1 written description:**

Round 1: (p2, ktbl, p2, k2togk x 2, p2, ktbl, p2, k4, 2/2RC, 2/2LC, k4) x4. (120 sts)

Round 2: (p2, ktbl, p2, k4, p2, ktbl, p2, k16) x4.

Round 3: (p2, ktbl, p2, k, k2togk, k, p2, ktbl, p2, k2, 2/2RC, k4, 2/2LC, k2) x4.

Round 4: repeat round 2.

Round 5: (p2, ktbl, p2, k2togk x 2, p2, ktbl, p2, 2/2RC, k8, 2/2LC) x4.

Round 6: repeat round 2.

Round 7: (p2, ktbl, p2, k, k2togk, k, p2, ktbl, p2, k4, 2/2RC, 2/2LC, k4) x4.

Round 8: repeat round 2.

Round 9: (p2, ktbl, p2, k2togk x 2, p2, ktbl, p2, k2, 2/2RC, k4, 2/2LC, k2) x4.

Round 10: repeat round 2.

Round 11: (p2, ktbl, p2, k, k2togk, k, p2, ktbl, p2, 2/2RC, k8, 2/2LC) x4.

Round 12: repeat round 2.

Decrease:Knit **Chart 2** 4 times per round and one time complete.**Chart 2 written description:**

Round 1: (p2tog, ktbl, p2tog, k, k2togk, k, p2tog, ktbl, p2tog, k4, 2/2RC, 2/2LC, k4) x4. (104 sts)

Round 2: (p, ktbl, p, k4, p, ktbl, p, k16) x4.

Round 3: (p, ktbl, p, k2togk x 2, p, ktbl, p, k2, 2/2RC, k4, 2/2LC, k2) x4.

Round 4: repeat round 2.

Knit **Chart 3** 4 times per round and one time complete.

Chart 3 written description:

Round 1: (p, ktbl, p, k, k2togk, k, p, ktbl, p, 2/2 kCRtog, k8, 2/2 kLCtog) x4.

(88 sts)

Round 2: (p, ktbl, p, k4, p, ktbl, p, k12) x4.

Round 3: (p, ktbl, p, k2togk x 2, p, ktbl, p, k2, 2/2RC, 2/2LC, k2) x4.

Round 4: repeat round 2.

Round 5: (P, ktbl, p, k, k2togk, k, p, ktbl, p, 2/2 kCRtog, k4, 2/2 kLCtog)

x4. (72 sts)

Round 6: (p, ktbl, p, k4, p, ktbl, p, k8) x4.

Round 7: (p, ktbl, p, k2togk x 2, p, ktbl, p, 2/2 kCRtog, 2/2 kLCtog) x4. (56 sts)

Round 8: ((p, ktbl, p, k4) x 2) x4.

Round 9: ((p, ktbl, p, k2tog x 2) x 2) x4. (40 sts)

Round 10: ((p, ktbl, p, k2) x 2) x4.

Round 11: ((p, ktbl, p, k2tog) x 2) x4. (32 sts)

Round 12: k2tog x 16. (16 sts)

Cut yarn with a 10cm tail and weave end through the left stitches. Weave all ends in wash and dry it flat.

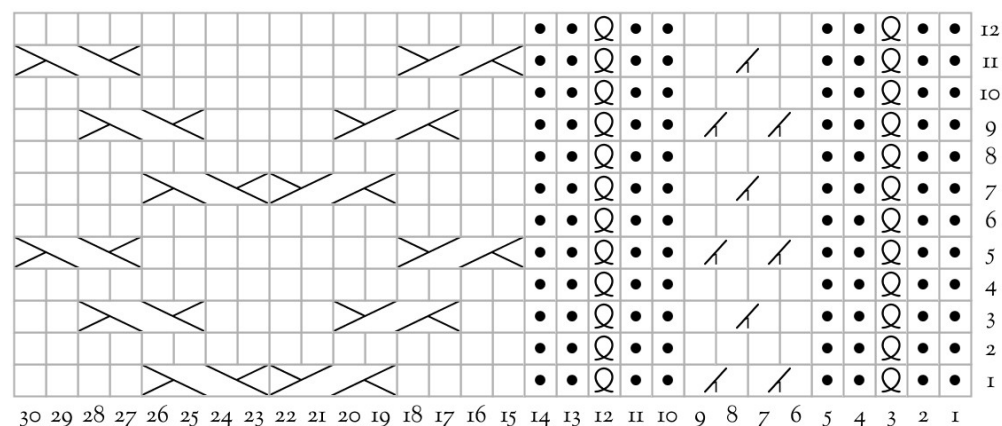

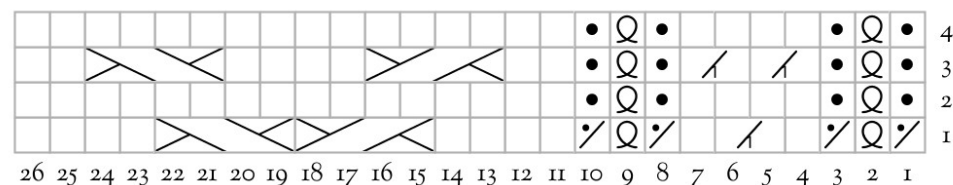
