

Mosaic Hats™

Have you always wanted to create beautiful crocheted colorwork but been afraid of working with more than one yarn at a time? If so, mosaic colorwork is the technique for you!

These complicated-looking patterns are created by working simple two-row stripes. On successive rows, stitches are worked into the rows below to create the intricate patterns. It's as easy as that!

With concise instructions and photos, this book will take you step by step through the creation of basic mosaic fabric. There are useful patterns for seven hats in teens', women's and men's sizes so you can showcase your new skills. No one needs to know how easy—and fun—these gorgeous hats are to make. It'll be our special secret!

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## **General Information**

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## Stitch Guide

### Mosaic Basics

This fascinating colorwork technique requires just one color per row and is created using simple crochet stitches. Chain-2 spaces are used as placeholders where stitches of the other color will be worked. In subsequent rows, double crochet stitches are used to cover those chain-2 spaces and add the appropriate color in the desired spot in the pattern.

Let's learn how to do mosaic colorwork while stitching the 3-in-1 mosaic pattern stitch used in the 3-in-1 Hat chapter.

Begin with the foundation rows. They're worked once at the beginning of a project and are not repeated. The rows will each be the height of a single crochet stitch, so each one will have one chain at the beginning of the subsequent row to bring the yarn and hook up to the height required to work that row.

With gray, chain a multiple of 4.

**Foundation row 1 (RS):** Sc in 2nd ch from hook (*see Photo 1*) and in each ch across, turn.



Foundation row 2 is a wrong-side row.

**Foundation row 2 (WS):** Ch 1, sc in first sc (*see Photo 2*) and in each sc across (*see Photo 3*), change color to magenta in last st, turn.



To change color at the end of the row, work the last stitch to the last yarn over (*2 loops on the hook*), drop gray, leaving a 6-inch tail, draw magenta through the 2

loops (see Photo 4). One loop of magenta is on the hook and now you're ready to begin the next row.

**Foundation row 3 (RS):** Ch 1, sc in each of first 3 sc (see Photo 5), \*ch 2, sk next sc, sc in each of next 3 sc (see Photo 6), rep from \* across, turn.

**Foundation row 4 (WS):** Ch 1, sc in each of first 3 sc (see Photo 7), \*ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in each of next 3 sc, rep from \* across, change color to gray, turn.

To minimize the number of yarn tails that will need to be woven in at the end of a mosaic project, there's no need to cut the yarn at the end of each two-row stripe. Instead, carry the yarn loosely up the wrong side of the fabric until it is used again (see Photo 8). **Hint:** If you twist the yarns in opposite directions each time you change color (grabbing the new yarn from above this time and from below the next time), you'll avoid tangling the yarns as you go!

Now begin the main pattern with row 1 and gray:

**Row 1 (RS):** Ch 1, sc in first sc, \*ch 2, sk next sc, sc in next sc\*\*\*, working in front of ch-2 sps of previous 2 rows, dc in next sk st 3 rows below (*see Photo 9*), sc in next sc (*see Photo 10*), rep from \* across, ending last rep at \*\*\*, turn.

As you continue with the pattern, working rows 2–4, be sure to skip the next stitch or chain space for each chain-2 made and always work your double crochet stitches in front of the chain-2 spaces of the previous two rows.

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in first sc, \*ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp\*\*, sc in each of next 3 sts, rep from \* across, ending last rep at \*\*\*, sc in last sc, change color to magenta, turn.

**Row 3:** Ch 1, sc in first sc, \*dc in next sk st 3 rows below, sc in next sc\*\*\*, ch 2, sk next sc, sc in next sc, rep from \* across, ending last rep at \*\*\*, turn.

**Row 4:** Ch 1, sc in each of first 3 sc, \*ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in each of next 3 sc, rep from \* across, change color to gray, turn.

At the end of row 4, begin again with row 1—not with the foundation rows (*see Photo 11*).

Repeat rows 1–4 for pattern.

After you've completed all repeats of rows 1–4, you'll need to work 2 last rows that omit the chain-2 spaces to avoid having holes in the fabric. With gray on your hook, continue as follows:

**Next row (RS):** Ch 1, sc in each of first 3 sc, \*dc into the next sk st 3 rows below, sc in each of next 3 sc (*see Photo 12*), rep from \* across, turn.

**Last row:** Ch 1, sc in each st across (*see Photo 13*). Fasten off.

**Circumference:** 18 [20½, 23] inches

**Length:** 10 [11, 11½] inches tall

### Materials



- Premier Yarns Deborah Norville Everyday Soft Worsted medium (worsted) weight acrylic yarn (4 oz/203 yds/113g per ball):  
1 [1, 2] ball(s) #1023 mist  
1 ball #1021 magenta
- Size H/8/5mm crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge

- Tapestry needle

## Gauge

**Ribbing:** 4 sc = 1 inch; 13 rows = 4 inches

**Body:** 13 sts = 4 inches; 18 rows = 4 inches

## Pattern Notes

Weave in ends as work progresses.

Work all double crochet stitches in front of chain-2 spaces of previous 2 rows throughout.

## Pattern Stitch

### 3-in-1 Pattern

**Row 1 (RS):** Ch 1, sc in first sc, \*ch 2, sk next sc, sc in next sc\*\*, **working in front of ch-2 sps of previous 2 rows** (see Pattern Notes), dc in next sk sc 3 rows below, sc in next sc, rep from \* across, ending last rep at \*\*, turn. (30 [34, 38] sc, 14 [16, 18] dc, 15 [17, 19] ch-2 sps)

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in first sc, \*ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp\*\*, sc in each of next 3 sts, rep from \* across, ending last rep at \*\*, sc in last sc, change color to magenta, turn. (44 [54, 64] sc, 15 [17, 19] ch-2 sps)

**Row 3:** Ch 1, sc in first sc, \*dc in next sk sc 3 rows below, sc in next sc\*\*, ch 2, sk next sc, sc in next sc, rep from \* across, ending last rep at \*\*, turn. (30 [34, 38] sc, 14 [16, 18] dc, 15 [17, 19] ch-2 sps)

**Row 4:** Ch 1, sc in each of first 3 sc, \*ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in each of next 3 sc, rep from \* across, change color to mist, turn. (44 [54, 64] sc, 15 [17, 19] ch-2 sps)

Rep rows 1–4 for pattern.



## Hat

### Ribbing

**Row 1 (RS):** With mist, ch 8 [9, 9], sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, turn. (7 [8, 8] sc)

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in **back lp** (*see Stitch Guide*) of each sc across, turn.

Rep row 2 until Ribbing measures 17 [19½, 22] inches, slightly stretched. Do not fasten off.

## Body

**Foundation row 1 (RS):** With RS facing and working in ends of rows, ch 1, work 59 [67, 75] sc evenly sp across, turn. (59 [67, 75] sc)

**Foundation row 2:** Ch 1, sc in each sc across, **change color** (*see Stitch Guide*) in last sc to magenta, turn.

**Foundation row 3:** Ch 1, sc in each of first 3 sc, \*ch 2, sk next sc, sc in each of next 3 sc, rep from \* across, turn. (44 [54, 64] sc, 15 [17, 19] ch-2 sps)

**Foundation row 4:** Ch 1, sc in each of first 3 sc, \*ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in each of next 3 sc, rep from \* across, change color to mist, turn.

**Next rows:** Work in **3-in-1 Pattern** (*see Pattern Stitch*) until piece measures approximately 7 [8, 8] inches from bottom edge of Ribbing, ending at row 4.

**Next row (RS):** Ch 1, sc in each of first 3 sc, \*dc in next sk sc 3 rows below, sc in each of next 3 sc, rep from \* across, turn.

## Crown

**Next row:** Ch 1, **sc dec** (*see Stitch Guide*) in first 2 sc, \*sc in each of next 18 [15, 13] sts, sc dec in next 2 sts, rep from \* 1 [2, 3] time(s), sc in each rem st, turn. (56 [63, 70] sc)

**Next row:** Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

Rep last row until piece measures approximately 8 [9, 9½] inches from bottom edge of Ribbing or 2 inches less than desired height.

**Next row (dec):** Ch 1, sc dec in first 2 sc, sc in each of next 5 sc, \*sc dec in next 2 sc, sc in each of next 5 sc, rep from \* across, turn. (48 [54, 60] sc)

**Next row (dec):** Ch 1, sc dec in first 2 sc, sc in each of next 4 sc, \*sc dec in next 2 sc, sc in each of next 4 sc, rep from \* across, turn. (40 [45, 50] sc)

**Next row (dec):** Ch 1, sc dec in first 2 sc, sc in each of next 3 sc, \*sc dec in next 2 sc, sc in each of next 3 sc, rep from \* across, turn. (32 [36, 40] sc)

**Next row (dec):** Ch 1, sc dec in first 2 sc, sc in each of next 2 sc, \*sc dec in next 2 sc, sc in each of next 2 sc, rep from \* across, turn. (24 [27, 30] sc)

**Next row (dec):** Ch 1, sc dec in first 2 sc, sc in next sc, \*sc dec in next 2 sc, sc in next sc, rep from \* across, turn. (16 [18, 20] sc)

**Last row (dec):** Ch 1, sc dec in first 2 sc, sc in next sc, \*sc dec in next 2 sc, sc in next sc, rep from \* across, turn. Leaving an 8-inch tail, fasten off. (8 [9, 10] sc)

## Finishing

Weave tail through last row and pull tightly to secure. Sew back seam.

## Designer's Tip

*It's easy to customize these hats for a trendy slouchy look. Just work more rows of single crochet before starting the crown decreases!*

## Confetti Stripes Hat

**Circumference:** 18 [20½, 23] inches

**Length:** 10 [11, 11½] inches tall

### Materials



- Premier Yarns Deborah Norville Everyday Soft Worsted medium (worsted) weight acrylic yarn (4 oz/203 yds/113g per ball):  
1 [1, 2] ball(s) #1030 glass  
1 ball #1017 azure
- Size H/8/5mm crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge

- Tapestry needle

## Gauge

**Ribbing:** 4 sc = 1 inch; 13 rows = 4 inches

**Body:** 13 sts = 4 inches; 18 rows = 4 inches

## Pattern Notes

Weave in ends as work progresses.

Work all double crochet stitches in front of chain-2 spaces of previous 2 rows throughout.

## Pattern Stitch

### Confetti Stripes Pattern

**Row 1 (RS):** Ch 1, sc in first sc, \*working in front of ch-2 sps of previous 2 rows (see Pattern Notes), dc in next sk sc 3 rows below\*\*, ch 2, sk next sc, sc in each of next 2 sc, rep from \* across, ending last rep at \*\*, sc in last sc, turn. (30 [34, 38] sc, 15 [17, 19] dc, 14 [16, 18] ch-2 sps)

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in each of first 3 sts, \*sc in next sc, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in each of next 2 sts, rep from \* across, change color to azure, turn. (45 [51, 57] sc, 14 [16, 18] ch-2 sps)

**Row 3:** Ch 1, sc in first sc, \*ch 2, sk next sc, dc in next sk sc 3 rows below, sc in each of next 2 sc, rep from \* across to last 2 sc, ch 2, sk next sc, sc in last sc, turn. (30 [34, 38] sc, 14 [16, 18] dc, 15 [17, 19] ch-2 sps)

**Row 4:** Ch 1, sc in first sc, \*ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in each of next 3 sts, rep from \* across to last ch-2 sp, ch 2, sk last ch-2 sp, sc in last sc, change color to glass, turn. (44 [50, 56] sc, 15 [17, 19] ch-2 sps)

**Row 5:** Ch 1, sc in first sc, dc in next sk sc 3 rows below, \*sc in each of next 2 sc, ch 2, sk next sc, dc in next sk sc 3 rows below, rep from \* across to last sc, sc in last sc, turn. (30 [34, 38] sc, 15 [17, 19] dc, 14 [16, 18] ch-2 sps)

**Row 6:** Ch 1, sc in each of first 2 sts, \*ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in each of next 3 sts, rep from \* across to last sc, sc in last sc, change color to azure, turn. (45 [51, 57] sc, 14 [16, 18] ch-2 sps)

**Row 7:** Ch 1, sc in first sc, \*ch 2, sk next sc, sc in each of next 2 sc, dc in next sk sc 3 rows below, rep from \* across to last 2 sc, ch 2, sk next sc, sc in last sc, turn. (30 [34, 38] sc, 14 [16, 18] dc, 15 [17, 19] ch-2 sps)

**Row 8:** Rep row 4.

Rep rows 1–8 for pattern.

## Hat

### Ribbing

**Row 1 (RS):** With glass, ch 8 [9, 9], sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, turn. (7 [8, 8] sc)

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in **back lp** (see *Stitch Guide*) of each sc across, turn.

Rep row 2 until Ribbing measures 17 [19½, 22] inches, slightly stretched. Do not fasten off.

## Body

**Foundation row 1 (RS):** With RS facing and working in ends of rows, ch 1, work 59 [67, 75] sc evenly sp across, turn. (59 [67, 75] sc)

**Foundation row 2:** Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn, **change color** (*see Stitch Guide*) in last sc to azure. (44 [54, 64] sc, 15 [17, 19] ch-2 sps)

**Foundation row 3:** Ch 1, sc in first sc, \*ch 2, sk next sc\*\*, sc in each of next 3 sc, rep from \* across, ending last rep at \*\*, sc in last sc, turn. (44 [54, 64] sc, 15 [17, 19] ch-2 sps)

**Foundation row 4:** Ch 1, sc in first sc, \*ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp\*\*, sc in each of next 3 sc, rep from \* across, ending last rep at \*\*, sc in last sc, change color to glass, turn.

**Next rows:** Work in **Confetti Stripes Pattern** (*see Pattern Stitch*) until piece measures approximately 7 [8, 8] inches from bottom edge of Ribbing, ending at row 4.

**Next row (RS):** Ch 1, sc in first sc, dc in next sk sc 3 rows below, \*sc in each of next 3 sc, dc in next sk sc 3 rows below, rep from \* across to last sc, sc in last sc, turn.

## Crown

### Size Teen Only

**Next row:** Ch 1, **sc dec** (*see Stitch Guide*) in first 2 sts, \*sc in each of next 18 sts, sc dec in next 2 sts, rep from \* once, sc in each rem st, turn. (56 sc)

**Next row:** Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

Rep last row until piece measures approximately 8 inches from bottom edge of Ribbing or 2 inches less than desired height.

### Sizes Woman & Man Only

**Next row:** Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn. ([67, 75] sc)

Rep last row until piece measures approximately [9, 9½] inches from bottom edge of Ribbing or 2 inches less than desired height.

**Next row:** Ch 1, **sc dec** (*see Stitch Guide*) in first 2 sc, \*sc in each of next [15, 13] sts, sc dec in next 2 sc, rep from \* [2, 3] times, sc in each rem st, turn. ([63, 70] sc)

## All Sizes

**Next row (dec):** Ch 1, sc dec in first 2 sc, sc in each of next 5 sc, \*sc dec in next 2 sc, sc in each of next 5 sc, rep from \* across, turn. (48 [54, 60] sc)

**Next row (dec):** Ch 1, sc dec in first 2 sc, sc in each of next 4 sc, \*sc dec in next 2 sc, sc in each of next 4 sc, rep from \* across, turn. (40 [45, 50] sc)

**Next row (dec):** Ch 1, sc dec in first 2 sc, sc in each of next 3 sc, \*sc dec in next 2 sc, sc in each of next 3 sc, rep from \* across, turn. (32 [36, 40] sc)

**Next row (dec):** Ch 1, sc dec in first 2 sc, sc in each of next 2 sc, \*sc dec in next 2 sc, sc in each of next 2 sc, rep from \* across, turn. (24 [27, 30] sc)

**Next row (dec):** Ch 1, sc dec in first 2 sc, sc in next sc, \*sc dec in next 2 sc, sc in next sc, rep from \* across, turn. (16 [18, 20] sc)

**Last row (dec):** Ch 1, sc dec in first 2 sc, sc in next sc, \*sc dec in next 2 sc, sc in next sc, rep from \* across, turn. Leaving an 8-inch tail, fasten off. (8 [9, 10] sc)

### **Finishing**

Weave tail through last row and pull tightly to secure. Sew back seam.

- Premier Yarns Deborah Norville Everyday Heathers medium (worsted) weight acrylic yarn (3½ oz/180 yds/100g per ball):  
1 [1, 2] ball(s) #0009 charcoal heather  
1 ball #0008 grey heather
- Size H/8/5mm crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge

- Tapestry needle

## Gauge

**Ribbing:** 4 sc = 1 inch; 13 rows = 4 inches

**Body:** 13 sts = 4 inches, 18 rows = 4 inches

## Pattern Notes

Weave in ends as work progresses.

Work all double crochet stitches in front of chain-2 spaces of previous 2 rows throughout.

## Pattern Stitch

### Diagonal Stairsteps Pattern

**Row 1 (RS):** Ch 1, sc in first sc, \*ch 2, sk next sc\*\*, sc in each of next 2 sc, **working in front of ch-2 sps of previous 2 rows** (see *Pattern Notes*), dc in next sk sc 3 rows below, sc in next sc, rep from \* across, ending last rep at \*\*, sc in last sc, turn. (30 [34, 38] sc, 14 [16, 18] dc, 15 [17, 19] ch-2 sps)

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in first sc, \*ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp\*\*, sc in each of next 3 sts, rep from \* across, ending last rep at \*\*, sc in last sc, change color to grey, turn. (44 [54, 64] sc, 15 [17, 19] ch-2 sps)

**Row 3:** Ch 1, sc in first sc, \*dc in next sk sc 3 rows below\*\*, ch 2, sk next sc, sc in each of next 2 sc, rep from \* across, ending last rep at \*\*, sc in last sc, turn. (30 [34, 38] sc, 15 [17, 19] dc, 14 [16, 18] ch-2 sps)

**Row 4:** Ch 1, sc in each of first 4 sc, \*ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp\*\*, sc in each of next 3 sc, rep from \* across, ending last rep at \*\*, sc in each of last 2 sc, change color to charcoal, turn. (45 [51, 57] sc, 14 [16, 18] ch-2 sps)

**Row 5:** Ch 1, sc in each of first 2 sts, \*dc in next sk sc 3 rows below, ch 2, sk next sc, sc in each of next 2 sts, rep from \* across to last sc, sc in last sc, turn. (31 [35, 39] sc, 14 [16, 18] dc, 14 [16, 18] ch-2 sps)

**Row 6:** Ch 1, sc in each of first 3 sts, \*ch 2, sk next sc, sc in each of next 3 sts, rep from \* across, change color to grey, turn. (45 [51, 57] sc, 14 [16, 18] ch-2 sps)

**Row 7:** Ch 1, sc in each of first 3 sc, \*dc in next sk sc 3 rows below, ch 2, sk next sc, sc in each of next 2 sc, rep from \* across, turn. (31 [35, 39] sc, 14 [16, 18] dc, 14 [16, 18] ch-2 sps)

**Row 8:** Ch 1, sc in each of first 2 sc, \*ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in each of next 3 sc, rep from \* across to last sc, sc in last sc, change color to charcoal, turn. (45 [51, 57] sc, 14 [16, 18] ch-2 sps)

Rep rows 1–8 for pattern.

## Hat

### Ribbing

**Row 1 (RS):** With charcoal, ch 8 [9, 9], sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, turn. (7 [8, 8] sc)

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in **back lp** (see *Stitch Guide*) of each sc across, turn.

Rep row 2 until Ribbing measures 17 [19½, 22] inches, slightly stretched. Do not fasten off.

## Body

**Foundation row 1 (RS):** With RS facing and working in ends of rows, ch 1, work 59 [67, 75] sc evenly sp across, turn. (59 [67, 75] sc)

**Foundation row 2:** Ch 1, sc in each sc across, **change color** (see *Stitch Guide*) in last sc to grey, turn.

**Foundation row 3 (RS):** Ch 1, sc in first sc, sc in each of next 3 sc, \*ch 2, sk next sc, sc in each of next 3 sc, rep from \* across to last 3 sc, ch 2, sk next sc, sc in each of last 2 sc, turn. (45 [51, 57] sc, 14 [16, 18] ch-2 sps)

**Foundation row 4:** Ch 1, sc in each of first 2 sc, \*ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in each of next 3 sc, rep from \* across to last sc, sc in last sc, change color to charcoal, turn.

**Next rows:** Work in **Diagonal Stairsteps Pattern** (see *Pattern Stitch*) until piece measures approximately 7 [8, 8] inches from bottom edge of Ribbing, ending at row 4.

**Next row (RS):** Ch 1, sc in each of first 2 sc, \*dc in next sk sc 3 rows below, sc in each of next 3 sc, rep from \* across to last sc, sc in last sc, turn. (45 [51, 57] sc, 14 [16, 18] dc)

## Crown

### Size Teen Only

**Next row:** Ch 1, **sc dec** (see *Stitch Guide*) in first 2 sts, \*sc in each of next 18 sts, sc dec in next 2 sts, rep from \* once, sc in each rem st, turn. (56 sc)

**Next row:** Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

Rep last row until piece measures approximately 8 inches from bottom edge of Ribbing or 2 inches less than desired height.

### Sizes Woman & Man Only

**Next row:** Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn. ([67, 75] sc)

Rep last row until piece measures approximately [9, 9½] inches from bottom edge of Ribbing or 2 inches less than desired height.

**Next row:** Ch 1, **sc dec** (see *Stitch Guide*) in first 2 sc, \*sc in each of next [15, 13] sts, sc dec in next 2 sc, rep from \* [2, 3] times, sc in each rem st, turn. ([63, 70] sc)

## All Sizes

**Next row (dec):** Ch 1, sc dec in first 2 sc, sc in each of next 5 sc, \*sc dec in next 2 sc, sc in each of next 5 sc, rep from \* across, turn. (48 [54, 60] sc)

**Next row (dec):** Ch 1, sc dec in first 2 sc, sc in each of next 4 sc, \*sc dec in next 2 sc, sc in each of next 4 sc, rep from \* across, turn. (40 [45, 50] sc)

**Next row (dec):** Ch 1, sc dec in first 2 sc, sc in each of next 3 sc, \*sc dec in next 2 sc, sc in each of next 3 sc, rep from \* across, turn. (32 [36, 40] sc)

**Next row (dec):** Ch 1, sc dec in first 2 sc, sc in each of next 2 sc, \*sc dec in next 2 sc, sc in each of next 2 sc, rep from \* across, turn. (24 [27, 30] sc)

**Next row (dec):** Ch 1, sc dec in first 2 sc, sc in next sc, \*sc dec in next 2 sc, sc in next sc, rep from \* across, turn. (16 [18, 20] sc)

**Row 9:** Ch 1, sc in each of first 2 sc, \*dc in next sk sc 3 rows below, sc in next sc, rep from \* across to last sc, sc in last sc, turn. (31 [35, 39] sc, 28 [32, 36] dc)

**Row 10:** Ch 1, sc in each st across, change color to navy, turn. (59 [67, 75] sc)

## Hat

### Ribbing

**Row 1 (RS):** With navy, ch 8 [9, 9], sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, turn. (7 [8, 8] sc)

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in **back lp** (*see Stitch Guide*) of each sc across, turn.

Rep row 2 until Ribbing measures 17 [19½, 22] inches, slightly stretched. Do not fasten off.

## Body

**Foundation row 1 (RS):** With RS facing and working in ends of rows, ch 1, work 59 [67, 75] sc evenly sp across, turn. (59 [67, 75] sc)

**Foundation row 2:** Ch 1, sc in each sc across, **change color** (*see Stitch Guide*) in last sc to bittersweet, turn.

**Rows 1–10:** Work rows 1–10 of **Zigzag Pattern** (*see Pattern Stitches*).

**Rows 11–20:** Rep rows 1–10, reversing all color changes. At end of row 20, do not change color.

## Crown

### Size Teen Only

**Next row:** Ch 1, **sc dec** (*see Stitch Guide*) in first 2 sts, \*sc in each of next 18 sts, sc dec in next 2 sts, rep from \* once, sc in each rem st, turn. (56 sc)

**Next row:** Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

Rep last row until piece measures approximately 8 inches from bottom edge of Ribbing or 2 inches less than desired height.

### Sizes Woman & Man Only

**Next row:** Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn. ([67, 75] sc)

Rep last row until piece measures approximately [9, 9½] inches from bottom edge of Ribbing or 2 inches less than desired height.

**Next row:** Ch 1, **sc dec**(see *Stitch Guide*) in first [2, 2] sc, \*sc in each of next [15, 13] sts, sc dec in next 2 sc, rep from \* [2, 3] times, sc in each rem st, turn. ([63, 70] sc)

### All Sizes

**Next row (dec):** Ch 1, sc dec in first 2 sc, sc in each of next 5 sc, \*sc dec in next 2 sc, sc in each of next 5 sc, rep from \* across, turn. (48 [54, 60] sc)

**Next row (dec):** Ch 1, sc dec in first 2 sc, sc in each of next 4 sc, \*sc dec in next 2 sc, sc in each of next 4 sc, rep from \* across, turn. (40 [45, 50] sc)

**Next row (dec):** Ch 1, sc dec in first 2 sc, sc in each of next 3 sc, \*sc dec in next 2 sc, sc in each of next 3 sc, rep from \* across, turn. (32 [36, 40] sc)

**Next row (dec):** Ch 1, sc dec in first 2 sc, sc in each of next 2 sc, \*sc dec in next 2 sc, sc in each of next 2 sc, rep from \* across, turn. (24 [27, 30] sc)

**Next row (dec):** Ch 1, sc dec in first 2 sc, sc in next sc, \*sc dec in next 2 sc, sc in next sc, rep from \* across, turn. (16 [18, 20] sc)

**Last row (dec):** Ch 1, sc dec in first 2 sc, sc in next sc, \*sc dec in next 2 sc, sc in next sc, rep from \* across, turn. Leaving an 8-inch tail, fasten off. (8 [9, 10] sc)

### Finishing

Weave tail through last row and pull tightly to secure. Sew back seam.








Example of 2-sc dec
