## Naughty or Nice - Charted

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# Naughty or Nice Calendar

This shawl is designed to use tiny skeins featured in the Trailhead Yarns Naughty or Nice Yarn Calendar of 2021. It also works great for using up other mini skeins, scraps, gradient packs etc of your favorite Fingering Weight and sock yarns.

## Finished Measurements:

Varies based on charts used  
Approximately 24 x 98 inches

## Yarn:

Trailhead Yarns - Appalachian Trail, Fingering weight

## Shown:

Using Naughty or Nice Yarn Calendar 2021  
Naughty calendar  
24 X 64 yds – 15 grams

## Needles and Notions:

Size US 6 [4 mm] circular or straight needle  
Stitch markers  
Tapestry needle  
Blocking supplies

## Gauge:

22 sts and 29 rows = 4" in stockinette blocked  
note: gauge isn't critical however it will affect your yardage required. If you're a tight knitter go up a size and if you're a loose knitter go down a size.

This pattern is a bit of a recipe. The shawl is knit sideways on a bias with a small cable detail. Thirteen lace charts are included and you can mix and match. Repeat the ones you love and eliminate the ones you don't, make it your own.

**Cast on:** Cast on 141 using long tail cast on

knit 4 rows in garter stitch

Follow a chart with 12 to 14 pattern rows

## Transition between colours:

**row 1:** k, kfb, k, 1/1 RC, k to 7 sts before end of row, 1/1 RC, k2, k2tog, k

**row 2:** k4, p, knit to 5 sts before end of row, p, k4

Switch to next colour

**row 3:** k, kfb, k, 1/1 RC, k to 7 sts before EOR, 1/1 RC, k2, k2tog, k

**row 4:** k4, p, knit to 5 sts before end of row, p, k4

**row 5:** k, kfb, k, 1/1 RC, k to 7 sts before end of row, 1/1 RC, k2, k2tog, k

**row 6:** k4, p to 4 stitches before end of row, k4

## Lace sections:

Select and knit a lace section as charted

## Continuing:

Repeat transition and lace section the desired amount of time

## Final section:

after transition section continue by knitting a lace section with 12 to 14 pattern rows

knit 4 rows in garter stitch

cast off with a stretchy bind off.

## Finishing:

Weave in ends. Block to desired size.

## Abbreviations:

<b>k</b>	knit
<b>kfb</b>	knit front and back
<b>k2tog</b>	knit 2 together
<b>p</b>	purl
<b>RC</b>	right cable
<b>sts</b>	stitches
<b>ssk</b>	slip slip knit
<b>sk2p</b>	slip 1 knit wise, knit 2 together, pass slip stitch over knit 2 together
<b>s2kp2</b>	slip 2 stitches as if to knit 2 together, knit 1, pass 2 slip stitches over knit stitch

	2-st RC (RT) - Sl 1 st to cn and hold to back, k1, k1 from cn

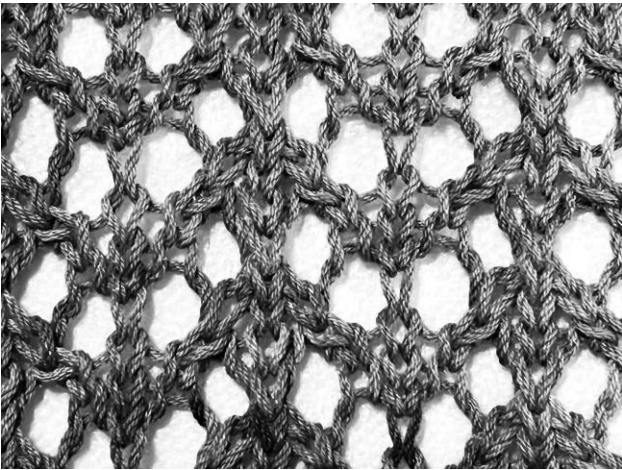
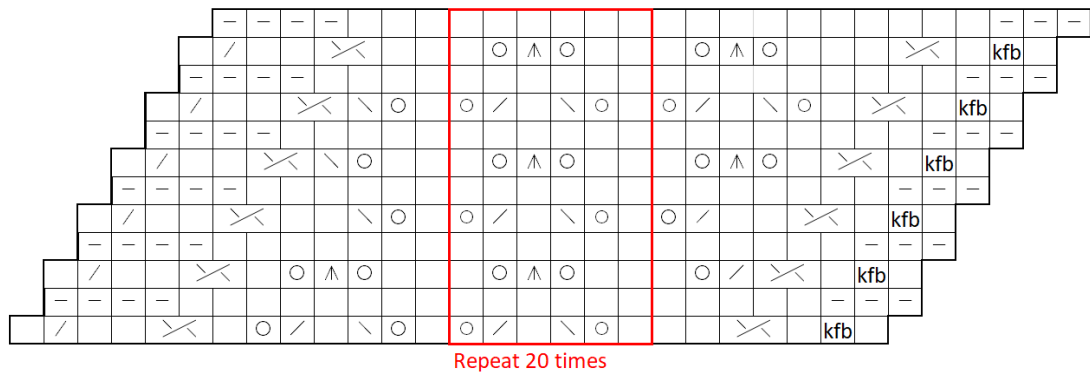
Fishtail lace



Staggered Eyelet

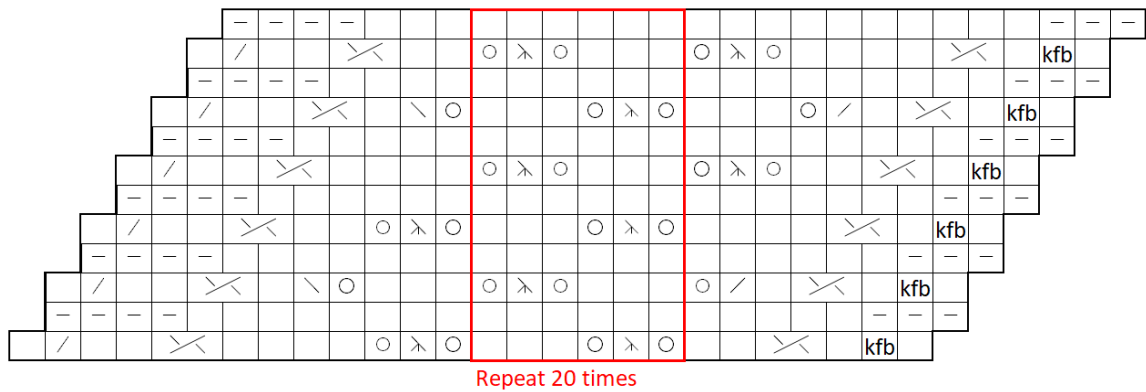


Little Arrowhead (Repeat one and a half time)

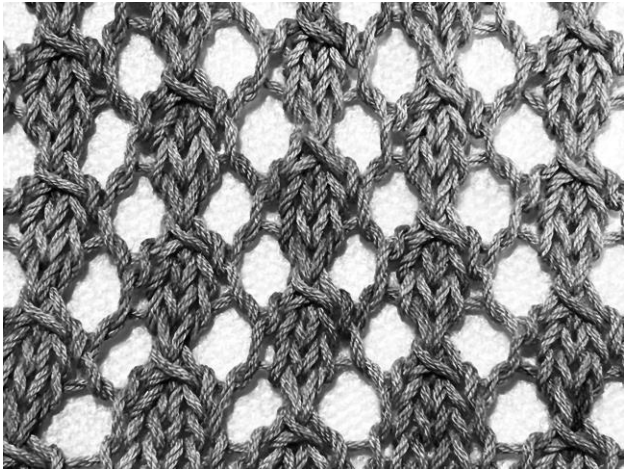




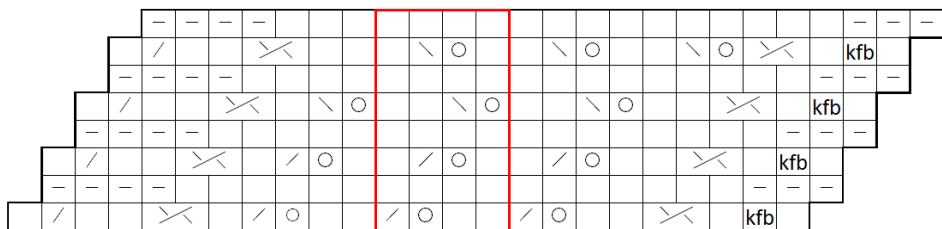
**Trellis lace** (Repeat one and a half time)



Repeat 20 times



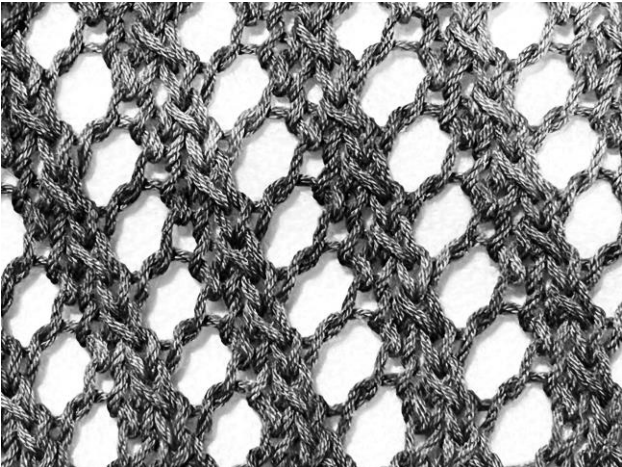
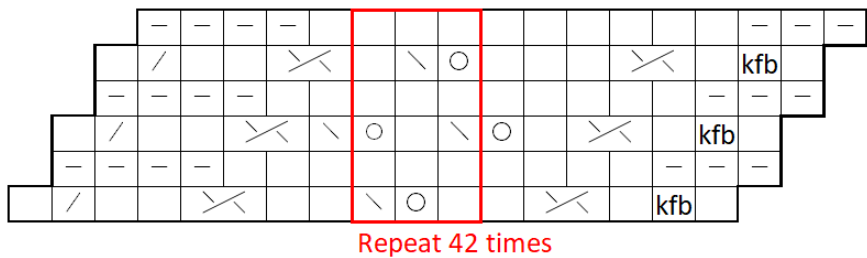
**Zigzag** (Repeat twice)
