

NO INTERNET

A NICE COWL TO KNIT WHEN THERE IS NO INTERNET



WHAT DO YOU NEED?

Worsted yarn (ex: Malabrigo rios)

- 100gr / 192 M (210 yds) Paris night (background color)

- 50gr / 96 M (105 yds) Lettuce (foreground color)

US 6 / 4 mm needles with 60cm (24") circular
for knitting in the round

4 Stitch Markers: 1 for beginning of round and
3 for motif markers

GAUGE

Haha, who does that ?

If you really want to test, here is my gauge
in stranded, stockinette stitch, blocked

24 sts and 25 rows = 10cm (4")

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Cowl Circumference: 56cm (22")

Depth: 27cm (14.5")

HOW TO KNIT THE COWL?

Cast on 136 stitches with background color.

Join for working in the round, being careful not to twist the cast-on edge.

Place marker for beginning of round and place a marker every 34 stitches (for the motif repetition later).

Work 7 rounds in 2x2 Ribbing with background color : k2 p2.

Knit the stranded design with your two yarns following the grid on next page for 73 rows, repeating the motif of each row 3 times, after each marker.

Be careful : don't forget to catch long floats when you have more than 5 stitches of the same color in a row.

When you're done with the 73 rows, cut foreground colour and leave a 15cm (6") tail for sewing.

Work again 7 rounds in 2x2 Ribbing with background color : k2 p2.

Bind off with a stretchy bind off technique, like «Sheena's Stretchy sock bind off » .

Sew in ends.


Wash and block: lay flat to dry.
