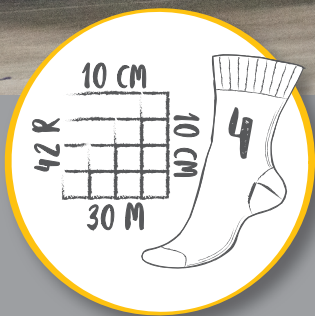

Dennis has been interested in ancient cultures ever since he was a young adult: Greek and Roman mythology, the cultures of the Maya, Aztecs and Inca, and many others. He is inspired by the art of these cultures. One famous Mayan symbol is the two-headed eagle. It represents a god with two faces: one looks toward goodness, the other toward evil; or toward heaven and earth, past and future, or forwards and backwards at the same time. These socks are named after a subterranean river in the Chaak Tun caves. This was a sacred place for the Maya. Chaak is the god of rain, and for the Maya, the cave was Chaak's rain of stones. The motif on the back of the socks is a graphic depiction of waves in the river.

SIZE

36/37, [38/39](#), [40/41](#), [42/43](#), [44/45](#), [46/47](#)

MATERIALS

REGIA Uni 4-fädig / 4-ply, 50 g ball

approx. 50 g = 210 m

col. 00017 (hell-kamel-meliert)

1 ball

REGIA Uni 4-fädig / 4-ply, 100 g ball

approx. 50 g = 420 m

col. 00316 (maroon)

1 ball

The amount of yarn needed can vary from person to person.

Double pointed Needles 2,5 mm

Double pointed Needles 3,0 mm

1 tapestry needle for weaving in ends

GAUGE

Stockinette stitch, size 2,5 mm needles:

30 st and 42 rounds = 10 x 10 cm

Fair isle pattern, size 3,0 mm needles:

30 st and 42 rounds = 10 x 10 cm

If your gauge differs from the given gauge, use needles of a larger or smaller size accordingly.

BASICS

Cuf pattern:

k2, p2 to end of round.

Stockinette stitch:

In Rd: knitt all stitches.

In Rows: RS: knit, WS: purl.

Fair Isle pattern:

Number of stitches: **Chart A** = 60 st, **Chart B** = 64 st, **Chart C** = 68 st, **Chart D** = 72 st.

In rounds: After completing the chart, work in stockinette st as given. All rounds are shown in the chart.

You will be working in Fair Isle technique using several balls of different-colored yarn. Carry the color not currently in use loosely along the back side of the work, taking care not to cross the floats.

Work the 6-stitch pattern repeat to the end of each round.

Repeat Rounds 1 - 6 throughout.

INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions for the individual sizes are listed in different colors, from smallest to largest, separated by slashes.

If only one option is given, this applies to all sizes.

NOTE:

work according to the 'Basics Socks' tutorial.

Cuff: using 2.5 mm (US size 2) double-pointed needles and Maroon, cast on 60/[60](#)/[64](#)/[64](#)/[68](#)/[72](#) st and divide them evenly over 4 needles (= 15/[15](#)/[16](#)/[16](#)/[17](#)/[18](#) st per needle) plus one additional st on the 4th needle.

Round 1: work in the cuff pattern, leaving the last st on the 4th needle unworked. Slip this st onto the 1st needle, then knit the st together with the following st = 1st st of Round 2.

Rounds 2–20: work in Maroon.

Total cuff length: = approx. 5 cm.

Leg shaft: using the 3.0 mm (US size 3) double-pointed needles and Maroon, work 1 Rd in stockinette st.

Move the start of the row to the side of the leg section: 1st and 2nd needle = lower side/sole, 3rd and 4th needle = upper side.

Continue working in the Fair Isle pattern:

For [size 36/37](#) and [size 38/39](#): **Chart A 60 st**, round 1–48 once.

For [size 40/41](#) and [size 42/43](#): **Chart B 64 st**, round 1– 50 once.

For [size 44/45](#): **Chart C 68 st**, round 1–52 once.

For [size 46/47](#): **Chart D 72 st**, round 1–52 once.

Work 1 round in stockinette stitch in Maroon.

Length of leg shaft excluding cuff = 50/[50](#)/[52](#)/[52](#)/[54](#)/[72](#) t (= 12/[12](#)/[12,5](#)/[12,5](#)/[13](#)/[13](#) cm).

Boomerang heel:

Using 2.5 mm (US size 2) double-pointed needles and Maroon, work the boomerang heel in stockinette st over the 30/**30/34/34/36/36** st on Needles 1 and 2.

Stitch division: sizes 36/37 and **38/39**: 10/10/10 st.

Size 40/41 and **42/43**: 11/12/11 st.

Size 44/45 and **46/47**: 12/12/12 st.

Foot:

Continue working in rounds in stockinette st over all st.

Rounds 1 and 2: work in Maroon.

Beginning with Rd 3, continue working in Hell-kamel-meliert until the foot measures 18.5/**20/21/22/22.5/24** cm long.

Toe shaping: work in stockinette st in Maroon.

In Rd 1, work the decreases once as described; then repeat these decreases in every 4th Rd once, in every 3rd Rd twice, in every other Rd 3x/**3x/3x/3x/4x/4x** and in every Rd 6x/**6x/7x/7x/7x/8x** = 8 st.

Cut the yarn and draw the end through the remaining st twice and pull snugly to close.

Weave in all ends with a tapestry needle.

Total foot length = approx. 23.5/**25/26.5/27.5/28.5/30** cm.

Work the 2nd sock in the same way.

ABBREVIATIONS


k	= knit
p	= purl
RS	= right side
st(s)	= stitch(es)
WS	= wrong side

KEY

	= k1 in Maroon
	= k1 in Hell-kamel-meliert

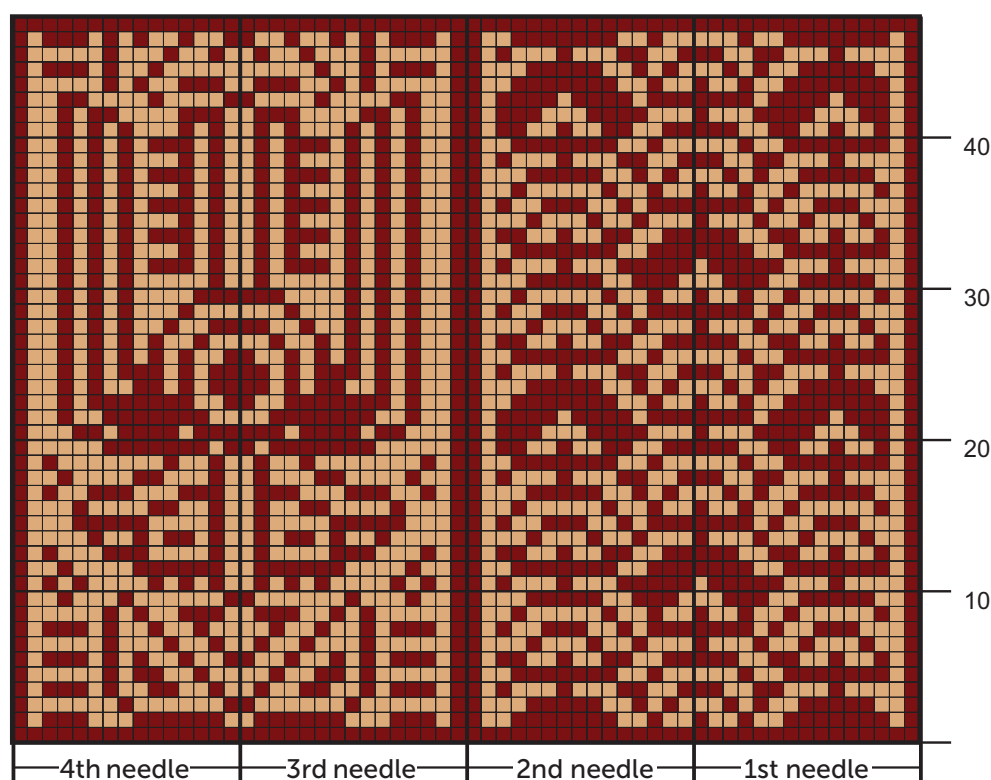
CHART A / 60 ST

CHART B / 64 ST

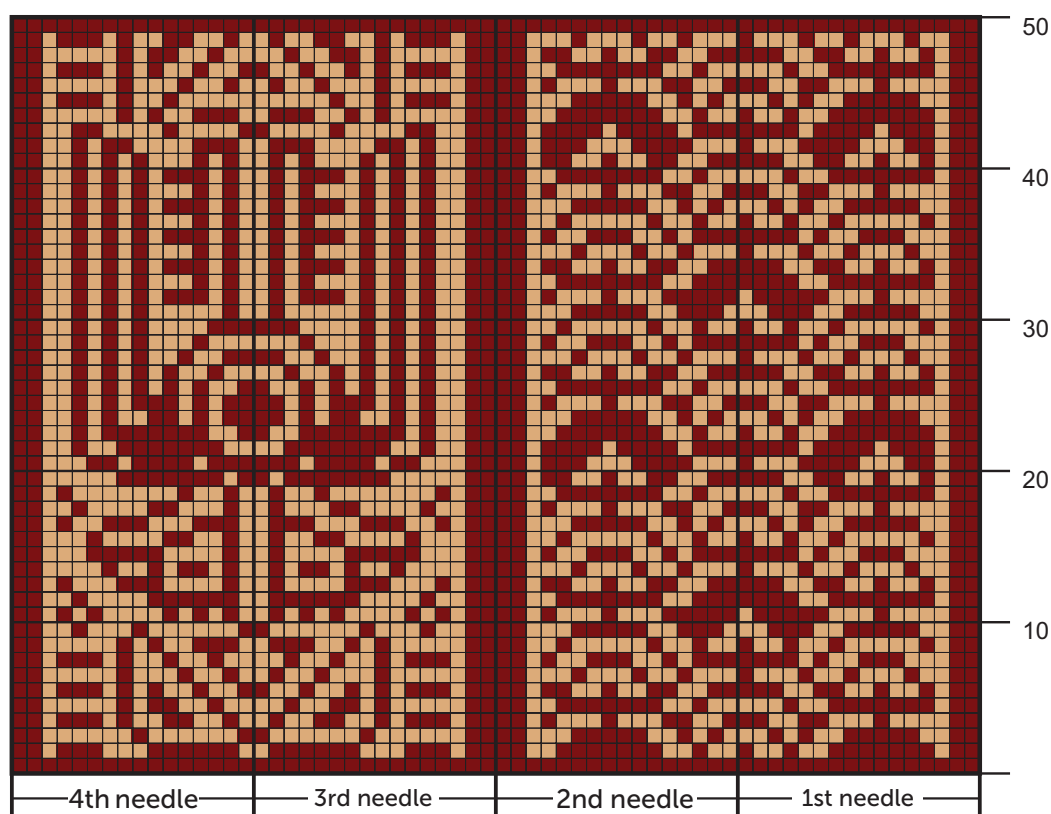


CHART C / 68 ST

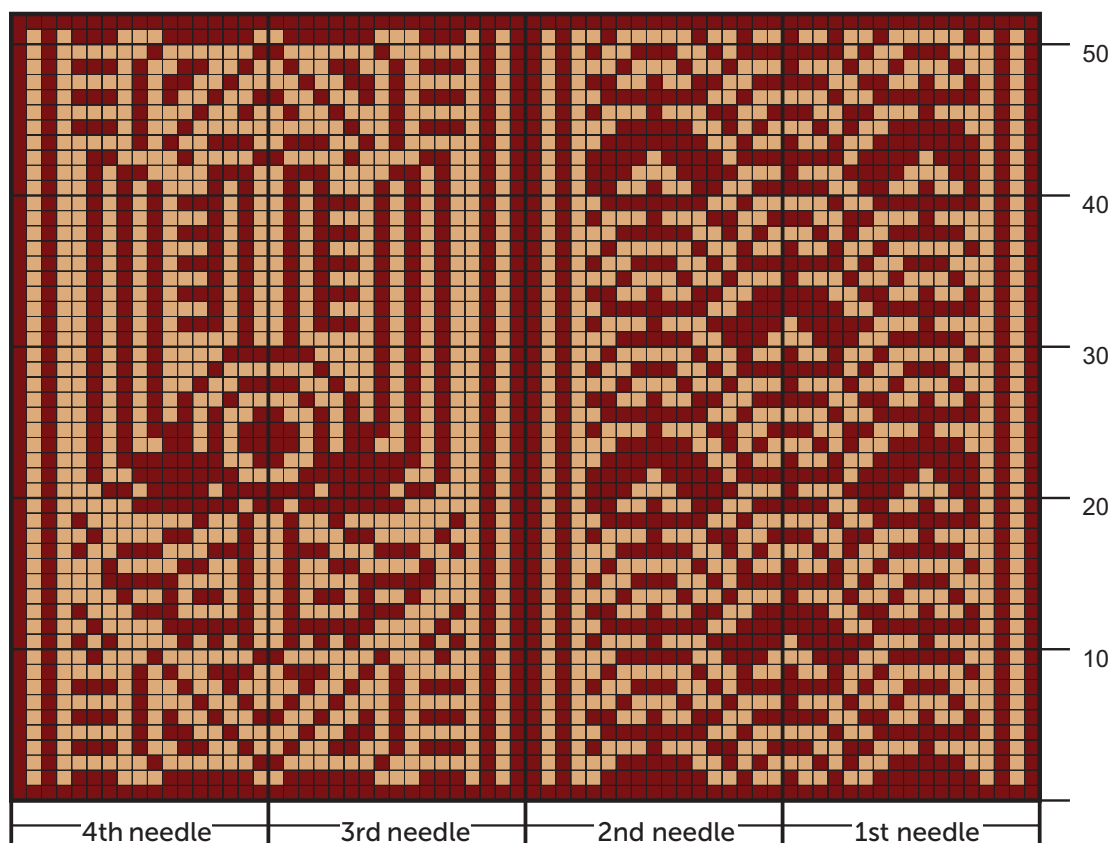
