## Yarn:

**A (main color)** - Malabrigo Mechita (052 color Paris Night) - 100g (385m/100g)  
**B (for leaf color)** - Skeino Arabella Shawl (color Winter) – 120g (328m/100g)

You can use one or several yarn colors for leaves knitting. This is a perfect project to use up odds and ends of yarn.

**Size:** wide - 45cm. / long - 120 cm. or any other – if you want to knit scarf.


**Needles:** 3mm

**Gauge:** 25sts and 34 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm


**Note:** I used “wrap and turn” (knit the indicated number of sts, wrap working yarn around next stitch, turn and knit back in the opposite direction), but any other short-row turn works just as well. Selvedge stitches are already included in this stitch count. Do not add any additional selvedge stitches.

Do not confuse "turn", "w/o turning "and "wrap and turn"! In wrong side YO of the previous row purl crossed stitch to avoid holes in the knitted cloth.


CO 100 sts and knit one row (RS).


**The first band of leaves (see Schematic 2):**

(WS) Row 1: Sl1k, p99.

(RS) Row 2: BO 15sts (1 st remaining on RN), (see photo 1), w&t



(WS) Row 3: K1, w/o turn, CO 14sts using the loop cast-on method (see photo 2), turn work.



(RS) Row 4: Sl1k, k13, w&t

(WS) Row 5: K10, w&t

(RS) Row 6: K7, w&t

(WS) Row 7: K5, w&t

(RS) Row 8: K4, w&t

(RS) Row 52: Sl1k, p2, yo, p92, p2tog, p3, turn work

**Yarn "B"**

(WS) Row 53: Sl1k, p99, turn work

(RS) Row 54: Sl1k, p2, yo, p92, p2tog, p3, turn work

**Yarn "A"**

(WS) Row 55: Sl1k, p99, turn work

(RS) Row 56: Sl1k, p2, yo, p92, p2tog, p3, turn work

(WS) Row 57: Sl1k, p99, turn work

(RS) Row 58: Sl1k, p2, yo, p92, p2tog, p3, turn work

Repeat rows 1-132 7 more times or more – if you want to knit scarf.

**Border:**

**Step 1**


Begin at upper right corner of the snood (see mark "1" on Schematic 3).

(RS) **Yarn A:** pick up and knit 18sts (8+10), turn work.

(WS) Next row: knit all sts, turn work.

(RS): BO 17sts (1 st remaining on RN), w/o turn


**Step 2**

**Continued work:** (RS) pick up and knit 35sts (9+16+10), (from mark "2" to mark "3" on Schematic 4), turn work.

(WS) Next row: knit all sts, turn work.

(RS): BO 35sts (1 st remaining on RN), w/o turn

Repeat Step 2 for the entire length of the snood.


### Step 3

(RS) Pick up and knit 17sts (9+8), (from mark "4" to mark "5" on Schematic 5), turn work.

(WS) Next row: knit all sts, turn work.

(RS): BO 18sts (all)

### Schematic 5



Repeat the edging for the other side. Seam the snood.
