CO = cast on  
k = knit  
p = purl  
p2tog= purl two (2) stitches together  
sl1k = slip a stitch knit-wise  
SSK = slip, slip, knit: [Slip a stitch knitwise] twice.  
st(s) = stitch (es)  
RS = right side  
WS = wrong side  
w/o = without

**A** - Malabrigo - Sock (col. 141Dewberry) - 20g  
(402m/100g)

**B** - Schoppel Wolle Zauberball Cotton (col. 2342) – 100g  
(420m/100g)

**Needles:** 2.5 - 2.75 mm (straight or circular for the 257sts)

**Note:** Please note that each ball Schoppel Wolle Zauberball Cotton tangle has a unique color sequence. You can pick your favorite colors or leave it up to chance. I previously divided my big ball into small colored balls.



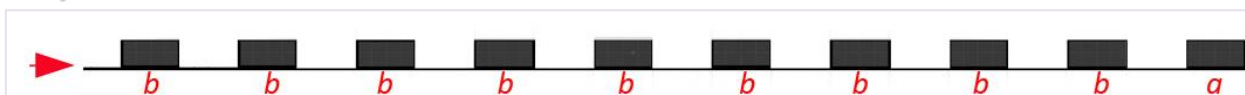

**Instructions:**

**Yarn "A"** CO 200sts (multiple of 20)

**Strip 1 (see black in the diagram):**



(WS) Row 1: Sl1k, p199

(RS) Row 2: Sl1k, p199

**Yarn "B"**

(WS) Row 3: P200

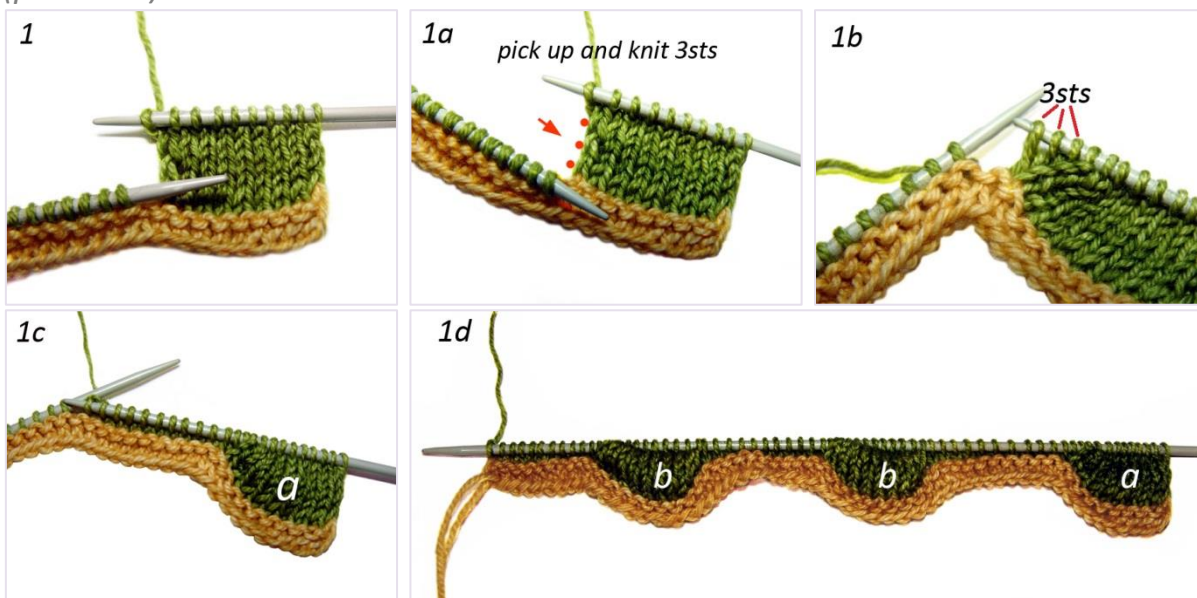
**Part «a»**

(Start RS): (Sl1k, k9, turn work; Sl1k, p9, turn work) x 3 times; Sl1k, k9, (*photo 1*), w/o turn, pick up and knit 3sts through the back loop (*photos 1a, 1b*), w/o turn; k10, w/o turn, (*photo 1c*).

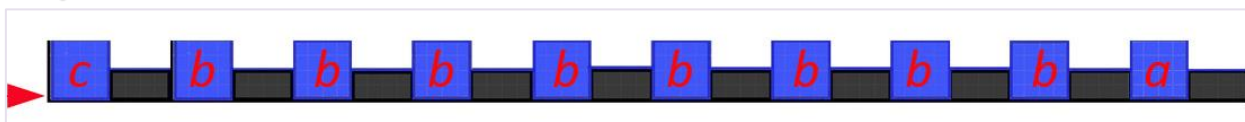
**Part «b»**

(Start RS): K10, turn work; Sl1k, p9, turn work; (Sl1k, k9, turn work; Sl1k, p9, turn work) x 2 times; Sl1k, k9, w/o turn, pick up and knit 3sts through the back loop, w/o turn; k10, w/o turn.

Repeat Part «b» - 8 more times; turn work. For this photo-tutorial - 1 more times, (*photo 1d*).

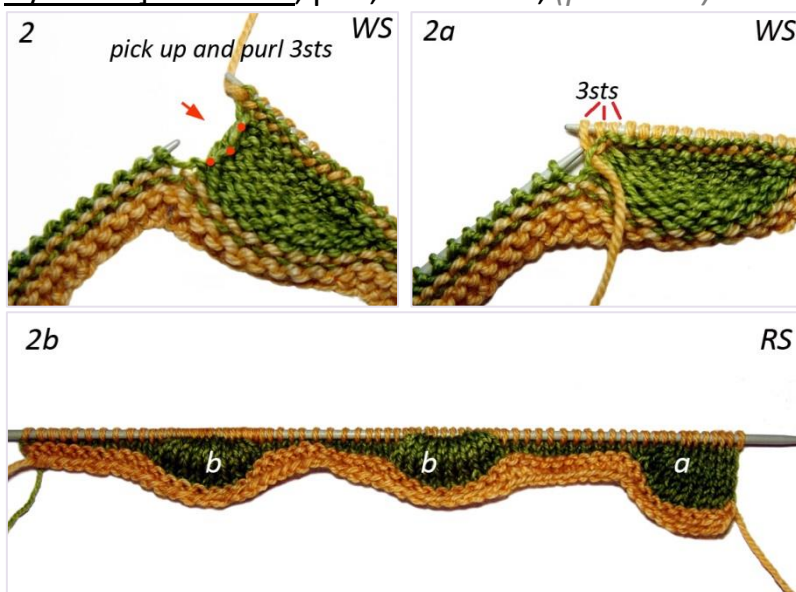


**Strip 2 (see blue in the diagram):**



### Yarn "A"

(WS) Row 1: [P23, pick up and purl 3sts through the front loop (see photos 2, 2a), w/o turn] x 9 times; p23, turn work, (photo 2b).



(RS) Row 2: Sl1k, p256, turn work.

### Yarn "B"

(WS) Row 3: P257, turn work.

#### Part «a»

(Start RS): Sl1k, k21, SSK, turn work; Sl1k, p8, p2tog, turn work; [Sl1k, k8, SSK, turn work; Sl1k, p8, p2tog, turn work] x 2 times, (photo 2c); [Sl1k, k9, turn work; Sl1k, p9, turn work] x 3 times, (photo 2d); Sl1k, k9, w/o turn, pick up and knit 3sts through the back loop (photo 2e), w/o turn.



#### Part «b»

(Start RS): K22, SSK, turn work; Sl1k, p8, p2tog, turn work; [Sl1k, k8, SSK, turn work; Sl1k, p8, p2tog, turn work] x 2 times; [Sl1k, k9, turn work; Sl1k, p9, turn work] x 3 times; Sl1k, k9, w/o turn, pick up and knit 3sts through the back loop, w/o turn.

Repeat Part «b» - 7 more times; turn work.

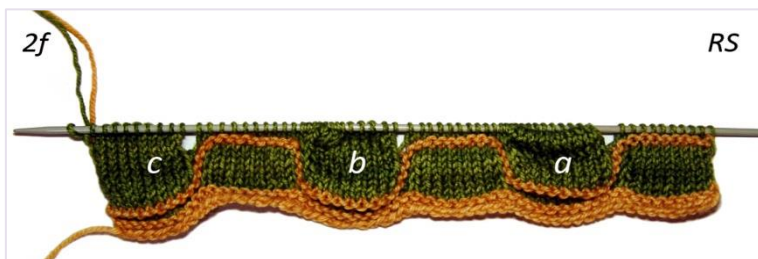
#### Part «c»

(Start RS): K23, turn work; Sl1k, p8, p2tog, turn work; [Sl1k, k9, turn work; Sl1k, p8, p2tog, turn work] x 2 times; [Sl1k, k9, turn work; Sl1k, p9, turn work] x 3 times; Sl1k, k9, (photo 2f), turn work.

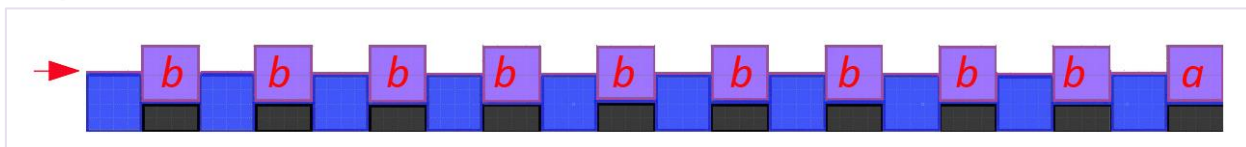


## Snood Smalt mosaic

### Strip 3 (see purple in the diagram):



### Yarn "A"

(WS) Row 1: P10, [pick up and purl 3sts through the front loop (*photo 3*), p23] x 9 times; pick up and purl through the front loop 3sts, p10, turn work.

(RS) Row 2: Sl1k, p256, (*photo 3a*), turn work.



### Yarn "B"

(WS) Row 3: P257, turn work.

### Part «a»

(Start RS): [Sl1k, k8, SSK, turn work; Sl1k, p9, turn work] x 3 times; [Sl1k, k9, turn work; Sl1k, p9, turn work] x 3 times; Sl1k, k9, w/o turn, pick up and knit 3sts through the back loop, k10, w/o turn, (*photo 3b*).

### Part «b»

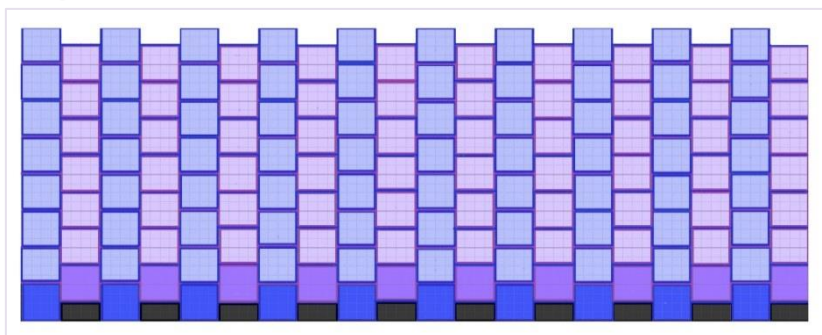
(Start RS): K12, SSK, turn work; Sl1k, p8, p2tog, turn work; [Sl1k, k8, SSK, turn work; Sl1k, p8, p2tog, turn work] x 2 times; [Sl1k, k9, turn work; Sl1k, p9, turn work] x 3 times; Sl1k, k9, w/o turn, pick up and knit 3sts through the back loop, k10, w/o turn.

Repeat **Part «b»** - 8 more times, (*photo 3c*); turn work.



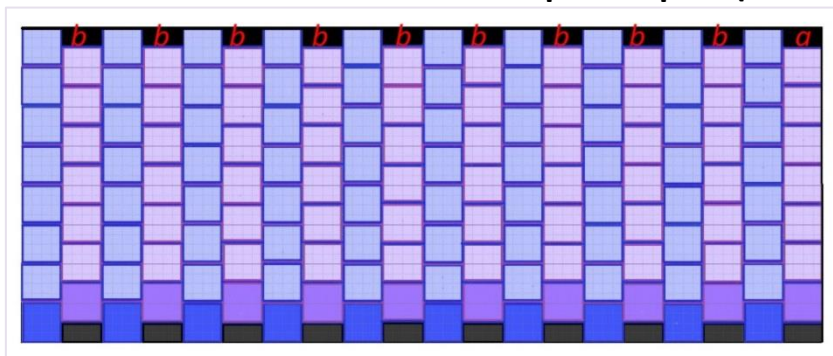
**Stripes 4, 6, 8, 10, 12, 14, 16** (Light blue in the diagram) - similar to the Strip 2

**Stripes 5, 7, 9, 11, 13, 15** (Light lilac in the diagram) - similar to the Strip 3



**Strip 17** (see black in the diagram):

Please note that in front of this strip is Strip 16 (similar to the Strip 2).



### Yarn "A"

(WS) Row 1: P10, [pick up and purl 3sts through the front loop, p23] x 9 times, pick up and purl 3sts through the front loop, p10; turn work.

(RS) Row 2: Sl1k, p256, turn work.

### Yarn "B"

(WS) Row 3: P257, turn work.

### Part «a»

(Start RS): [Sl1k, k8, SSK, turn work; Sl1k, p9, turn work] x 3 times; Sl1k, k19, *(photo 4)*, w/o turn.

### Part «b»

(Start RS): K12, SSK, turn work; Sl1k, p8, p2tog, turn work; [Sl1k, k8, SSK, turn work; Sl1k, p8, p2tog, turn work] x 2 times; Sl1k, k19, w/o turn.

Repeat Part «b» 8 more times, *(photo 4a)*; turn work.



### Yarn “A”

Purl two rows. Bind off 200sts. Seam the snood.

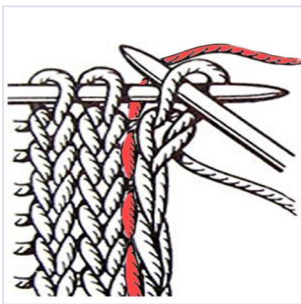
### Or optional:

### Yarn “A”

**Border I-Cord:** Purl one row + CO 3 sts (using the loop cast-on method), turn work.

Next: K2, k2tog tbl, [slip 3sts from RN to LN (wyib), k2, k2tog tbl] x until the end of the rows.

Bind off 3 sts. Seam the snood.



To useful tip: beautifully lift yarn while changing color, bring it alternately on RS and WS after/before selvedge stitches in every row.

For this photo-tutorial I used Malabrigo Sock Yarns (A – 803; B – 037, 851, 863, 141).
