

Tiilda Hat

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SIZE: One Size - to fit head circumference of 22"-23" (56 cm-58.5 cm).

YARN & YARDAGE: Bulky (Chunky) Weight. Approximately 147 yds (135 m) – including a 3 3/8" (85 mm) size pompom.

Pictured in Deramores Vintage Chunky, 50% Merino Wool, 50% Acrylic, 153 yds (140 m) / 100 gr.
Colour: Chalk.

NEEDLES: US 6 (4 mm) circulars with 16" (40 cm) cable.

US 8 (5 mm) circulars with 16" (40 cm) cable.

US 8 (5 mm) double pointed needles for the crown decrease shaping.

GAUGE: 15 sts x 22 rows to 4" (10 cm) in stockinette on larger size needles.

NOTIONS: cable needle, tapestry needle, stitch marker (*optional, to mark the beginning of rounds*), 3 3/8" (85 mm) (or size desired) pompom maker.

Note: Choosing different size pompom maker will affect the total yardage of the project.

ABBREVIATIONS & STITCH GUIDE

CO – Cast on

BO – Bind off

sts - stitches

K – knit

P – purl

M1L – Make one left: Insert left hand needle from front to back under the strand of yarn which runs between the stitch just worked and the next stitch on left hand needle. Lift the strand up and knit through back loop

C2B – slip next stitch onto cable needle and hold at the back of work, K1, then K1 from the cable needle

C4B – slip next 2 sts onto cable needle and hold at the back of work, K2, then K2 from the cable needle

C6B – slip next 3 sts onto cable needle and hold at the back of work, K3, then K3 from the cable needle

C6F – slip next 3 sts onto cable needle and hold at the front of work, K3, then K3 from the cable needle

K2tog – knit 2 sts together

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P2tog – purl 2 sts together

Rep – repeat

Rnd / Rnds – Round / Rounds

PATTERN BEGINS

Using US 6 (4 mm) needles and the long tail cast-on, CO 82 sts.

Join to begin working in the round making sure not to twist the stitches.

RIBBING

Rnd 1: *K1. P1. Rep from * to end.

Rep Rnd 1 for 10 more times.

SET UP ROUND

Change to US 8 (5 mm) needles.

*K10. M1L. Rep from * 7 more times. K2. (90 sts)

MAIN BODY

(Refer to CHART 1 on page 4 for the cable panel pattern repeat)

Rnd 1: *K9. P2. K2. P2. Rep from * 5 more times.

Rnd 2: *C6B. K3. P2. C2B. P2. Rep from * 5 more times.

Rnd 3: Rep Rnd 1.

Rnd 4: *K9. P2. C2B. P2. Rep from * 5 more times.

Rnd 5: Rep Rnd 1.

Rnd 6: *K3. C6F. P2. C2B. P2. Rep from * 5 more times.

Rnd 7: Rep Rnd 1.

Rnd 8: Rep Rnd 4.

Repeat Rnds 1 – 8 for 2 more times.

Repeat Rnds 1 – 6.

DECREASE STARTS

Change to double pointed needles if necessary for crown shaping.

Rnd 1: *[K2tog. K1] x 3. P2tog. K2. P2tog. Rep from * 5 more times. (60 sts)

Rnd 2: *K6. P1. K2tog. P1. Rep from * 5 more times. (54 sts)

Rnd 3: *K6. P1. K1. P1. Rep from * 5 more times. (54 sts)

Rnd 4: *C4B. K2. P2tog. P1. Rep from * 5 more times. (48 sts)

Rnd 5: *[K2tog. K1] x 2. P2tog. Rep from * 5 more times. (30 sts)

Rnd 6: *[K2tog] x 2. P1. Rep from * 5 more times. (18sts)



Rnd 7: K2tog to the end of Rnd.

Cut off yarn leaving 10"- 13" (25 cm-33 cm) tail.

BO the tip by drawing the tapestry needle through the remaining stitches and fastening them, weaving in the end on the inside of the hat.

Use the remaining yarn to make the pompom.

Weave in the ends and enjoy!
