### EXPERIENCE LEVEL

- Intermediate

### MATERIALS

- Baby Alpaca (100% Baby Alpaca; 50g/110yds): 10 hanks
- Size 8 (5mm) 24" circular needle, or size needed to obtain gauge
- Tapestry needle

### SIZE

- One

### FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

- Length: approx 70"
- Width: approx 20"

### GAUGE

- In stockinette, 18 sts and 26 rows = 4", blocked

### ABBREVIATIONS

approx:	approximately
CO:	cast on
k:	knit
k2tog:	knit 2 stitches together
LH:	left hand
LLI (left lifted increase):	insert left needle into top of stitch one row below first stitch on right needle; knit this loop
meas:	measures
ndl(s):	needle(s)
p:	purl
pm:	place marker
p2tog:	purl 2 stitches together
rem:	remaining
RH:	right hand
RLI (right lifted increase):	insert right needle into top of stitch one row below next stitch on left needle; knit this loop

rm:	remove marker
RS:	right side
sl:	slip
ssk (slip, slip, knit):	slip 2 stitches separately knitwise, insert left needle in front of 2 slipped stitches, knit 2 slipped stitches together
ssp (slip, slip, purl):	slip 2 stitches separately knitwise, insert left needle behind 2 slipped
st(s):	stitch(es)
WS:	wrong side

SPECIAL METHODS

PICK UP AND KNIT (RS FACING)

Insert RH ndl under both legs of next selvedge st from RS to WS, wrap yarn counter-clockwise around ndl and pull up a loop. One st picked up and knit.

PICK UP AND PURL (WS FACING)

Insert RH ndl under both legs of next selvedge st from RS to WS, wrap yarn counter-clockwise around ndl and pull up a loop. One st picked up and purled.

WRAP

Loosely CO 60 sts. Do not join.

NEXT ROW (WS): p.

TIER 1

BASE TRIANGLES (BT) (LEFT-LEANING) (MAKE 3)

ROW 1 (RS): sl 1 (selvedge st), turn.

ROW 2 (WS): p1, turn.

ROW 3 (RS): sl 1, k1, turn.

ROW 4 AND ALL WS ROWS: sl 1, p to end.

ROW 5: sl 1, k2, turn.

ROW 7: sl 1, k3, turn.

ROW 9: sl 1, k4, turn.

ROW 11: sl 1, k5, turn.

ROW 13: sl 1, k6, turn.

ROW 15: sl 1, k7, turn.

ROW 17: sl 1, k8, turn.

ROW 19: sl 1, k9, turn.

ROW 21: sl 1, k10, turn.

ROW 23: sl 1, k11, turn.

ROW 25: sl 1, k12, turn.

ROW 27: sl 1, k13, turn.

ROW 29: sl 1, k14, turn.

ROW 31: sl 1, k15, turn.

ROW 33: sl 1, k16, turn.

ROW 35: sl 1, k17, turn.

ROW 37: sl 1, k18, turn.

ROW 39: sl 1, k19, pm.

One left-leaning base triangle is complete. Row one of next triangle will begin with the first stitch on LH ndl. [20 sts]

Rep rows 1-39 two more times, for a total of three 20-st base triangles.

In second and third triangles, Row 4 and all WS rows should be worked as follows: sl 1, p to marker, turn. Do not place marker at end of row 39 for third triangle.

TIER 2

LEFT-SIDE TRIANGLE (LST) (RIGHT-LEANING) (MAKE 1)

ROW 1 (WS): p1, turn.

ROW 2 (RS): RLI, k1, turn.

ROW 3 (WS): sl 1 (selvedge st), p2tog, turn.

ROW 4 AND ALL RS ROWS: sl 1, LLI, k to end, turn.

ROW 5: sl 1, p1, p2tog, turn.

ROW 7: sl 1, p2, p2tog, turn.

ROW 9: sl 1, p3, p2tog, turn.

ROW 11: sl 1, p4, p2tog, turn.

ROW 13: sl 1, p5, p2tog, turn.

ROW 15: sl 1, p6, p2tog, turn.

ROW 17: sl 1, p7, p2tog, turn.

ROW 19: sl 1, p8, p2tog, turn.

ROW 21: sl 1, p9, p2tog, turn.

ROW 23: sl 1, p10, p2tog, turn.

ROW 25: sl 1, p11, p2tog, turn.

ROW 27: sl 1, p12, p2tog, turn.

ROW 29: sl 1, p13, p2tog, turn.

ROW 31: sl 1, p14, p2tog, turn.

ROW 33: sl 1, p15, p2tog, turn.

ROW 35: sl 1, p16, p2tog, turn.

ROW 37: sl 1, p17, p2tog, turn.

ROW 39: sl 1, p18, p2tog, turn.

Right-leaning left-side triangle is complete. [20 sts]

**RECTANGLES (RR) (RIGHT-LEANING) (MAKE 2)**

ROW 1 (WS): rm, pick up and purl 20 sts along selvedge edge of triangle or rectangle in previous tier, turn. [20 sts]

ROW 2 (RS): sl 1, k19, turn.

ROW 3 (WS): sl 1 (selvedge st), p18, p2tog, turn.

ROWS 4-41: Rep rows 2 and 3 nineteen more times.

One right-leaning rectangle is complete. [20 sts]

Rep rows 1-41 one more time, for a total of two 20-st right-leaning rectangles.

Do not Turn at end of Row 3 on last repeat.

**RIGHT-SIDE TRIANGLE (RST) (RIGHT-LEANING) (MAKE 1)**

ROW 1 (WS): pick up and purl 20 sts along selvedge edge of triangle or rectangle in previous tier, turn. [20 sts]

ROW 2 (RS): sl 1, k 19, pm, turn.

ROW 3 (WS): sl 1 (selvedge st), p to last 2 sts, ssp, turn.

ROW 4 AND REM RS ROWS: sl 1, k to m, turn.

Rep last 2 rows until 2 sts rem, ending with a RS row.

NEXT ROW (WS): ssp, turn. [1 st rem]

Right-leaning right-side triangle is complete. [1 st]

**TIER 3****FIRST RECTANGLE (FLR) (LEFT-LEANING) (MAKE 1)**

ROW 1 (RS): sl 1 (st rem from right-edge ending triangle), rm, then pick up and knit 19 sts along selvedge edge of triangle in previous tier, turn. [20 sts]

ROW 2 (WS): sl 1, p to end.

ROW 3 (RS): sl 1 (selvedge st), k18, ssk, turn.

ROWS 4-41: Rep rows 2 and 3 nineteen more times.

First left-leaning rectangle is complete. Do not turn at the end of row 3 on last repeat. [20 sts]

**NEXT RECTANGLES (LR) (LEFT-LEANING) (MAKE 2)**

ROW 1 (RS): pm, pick up and knit 20 sts along selvedge edge of rectangle in previous tier, turn. [20 sts]

ROW 2 (WS): sl 1, p to marker, turn.

ROW 3 (RS): sl 1 (selvedge st), k18, ssk, turn.

ROWS 4-41: rep rows 2 and 3 nineteen more times.

Do not turn at the end of row 3 on last repeat.

Rep one more time, for a total of three 20-st left-leaning rectangles.



## MORE TIERS

Rep Tiers 2 and 3 until piece meas approx 70" or desired length, ending with a Tier 2.

## FINAL TIER

### TOP TRIANGLE (TT) (LEFT-LEANING) (MAKE 3)

**ROW 1 (RS):** sl 1 (st rem from previous triangle), then pick up and knit 19 sts along selvedge edge of triangle in previous tier, turn. [20 sts]

**ROW 2 AND ALL WS ROWS:** sl 1, p to end.

**ROW 3:** ssk, k17, ssk.

**ROW 5:** ssk, k16, ssk.

**ROW 7:** ssk, k15, ssk.

**ROW 9:** ssk, k14, ssk.

**ROW 11:** ssk, k13, ssk.

**ROW 13:** ssk, k12, ssk.

**ROW 15:** ssk, k11, ssk.

**ROW 17:** ssk, k10, ssk.

**ROW 19:** ssk, k9, ssk.

**ROW 21:** ssk, k8, ssk.

**ROW 23:** ssk, k7, ssk.

**ROW 25:** ssk, k6, ssk.

**ROW 27:** ssk, k5, ssk.

**ROW 29:** ssk, k4, ssk.

**ROW 31:** ssk, k3, ssk.

**ROW 33:** ssk, k2, ssk.

**ROW 35:** ssk, k1, ssk.

**ROW 37:** k2tog, ssk.

**ROW 38 (WS):** pass leftmost st on LH ndl over rightmost st. [1 st rem]

One left-leaning top triangle is complete. [1 st]

Rep rows 1-38 two more times, for a total of three top triangles.

Fasten off last st.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends. Block to finished measurements.

**CARE INSTRUCTIONS:** Hand wash or dry clean. Wash in tepid water using a mild soap. Do not twist. Shape and dry flat on a towel. Store folded, do not hang.
