

## Abbreviations:

BO = bind off

CO = cast on

k = knit

k2tog= knit two (2) stitches together

k3tog= knit three (3) stitches together

p = purl

sl1k = slip a stitch knit-wise

st(s) = stitch (es)

RN= right needle

LN= left needle

RS = right side

WS = wrong side

w/o = without

WYIB = with yarn in back

WYIF = with yarn in front



## Special abbreviation:

“k1-w1-r2” = “knit 1, wrap 1, return 2” (k1, wrap next st (= bring yarn to front between the st just worked and the next st on the left needle, sl1 (=next st on left needle)-wyif, bring yarn to back = behind this st), now, w/o turning, return both 2sts to left needle and continue working).

“k2-w1-r3”, “k3-w1-r4”, “k4-w1-r5”, “k5-w1-r6”, “k6-w1-r7”: work the same way as done for “k1-w1-r2”, but with a different stitch count

**Yarn:** Mechita Malabrigo

A - (color 889 Musas ) - 100g (385M/100r)

B - (color 120 Lotus ) - 150g (385M/100r)

**Size:** wide - 28cm. / long - 200 cm. or optional

**Needles:** 2,25mm

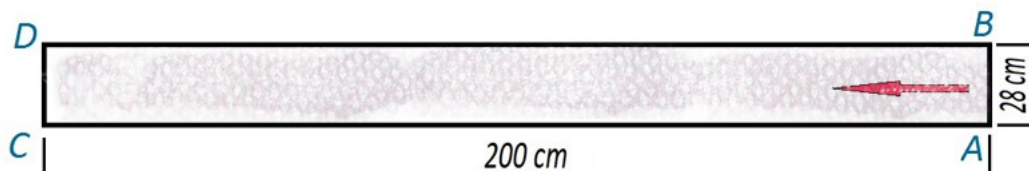
**Gauge:** 24sts and 30 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm

**Note:** Selvedge stitches are already included in this stitch count. Do not add any additional selvedge stitches.

Do not confuse "turn", "w/o turning "and "wrap and turn"! Work step by step and you will have excellent results.

Attention! - For photo-tutorial I've used another, more thick kind of yarn.

The direction of knitting being shown with red arrow in the schematic:

### The first band of drops:

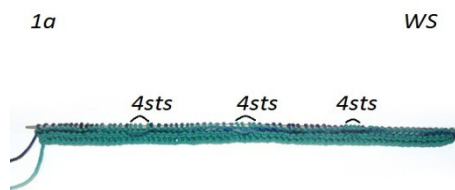
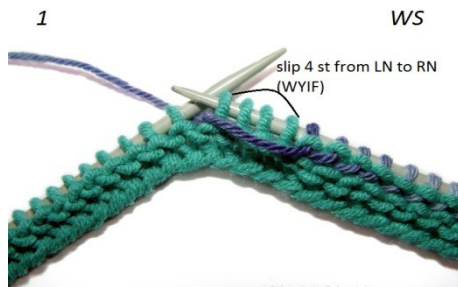
**Yarn A:** CO 72 sts (or multiply 18).

**(RS) Row 1:** Sl1k, k71

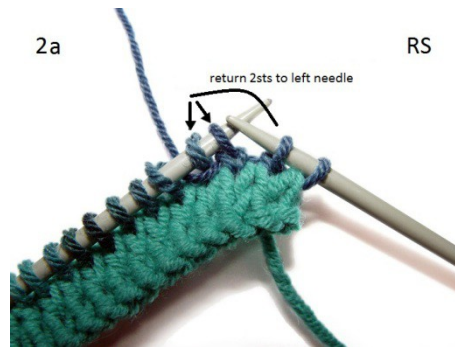
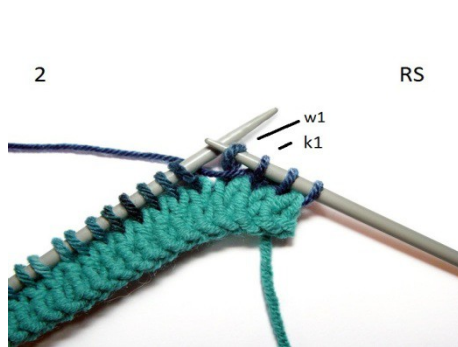
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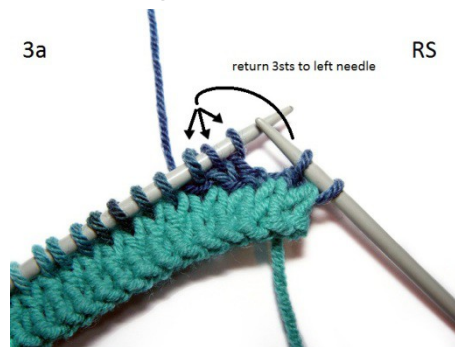
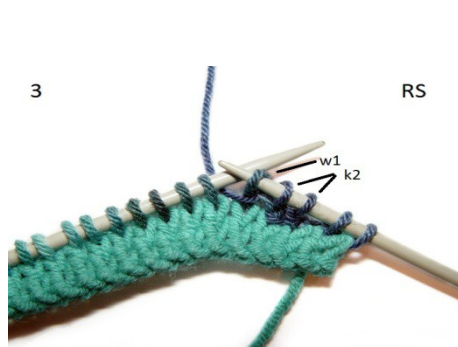
**Yarn B (WS) Row 2:** P2, {p14, slip 4 st from LN to RN (WYIF)} x 3 times, p16

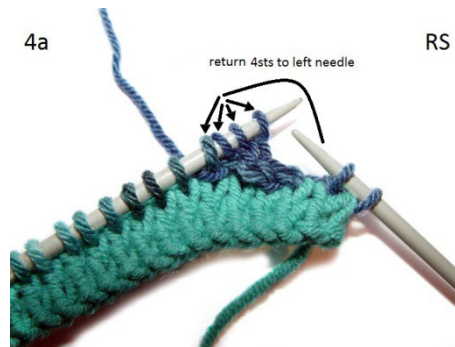
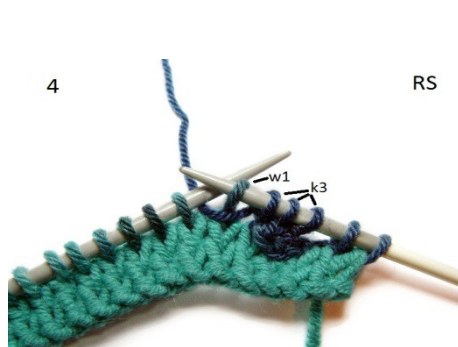
**(RS) Row 3:** Sl1k, k1, \* “k1-w1-r2” (see photos 2, 2a), w/o turning

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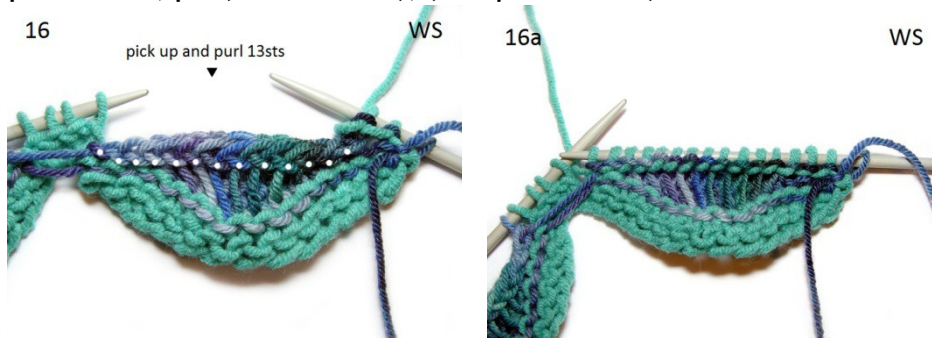
k3tog **\* \***, w/o turning, slip 4 sts from LN to RN (WYIB) **\* \* \***, (see photo 14), w/o turning



Repeat from **\*** to **\* \* \*** - 2 more times, w/o turning, repeat from **\*** to **\* \*** - 1 more time, k2 (see photo 15)

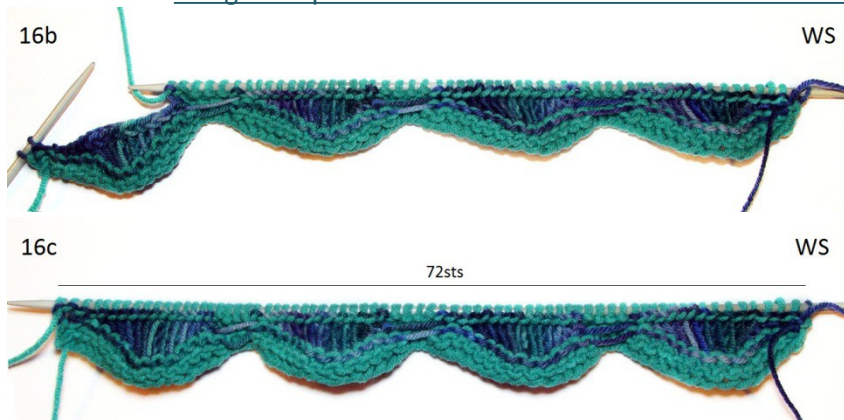


**Yarn A (WS) Row 4:** P3, w/o turning, **\*** pick up and purl 13sts (see photos 16, 16a), p5 **\* \*** - repeat from **\*** to **\* \*** - 2 more times (see photo 16b), pick up and purl 13sts, p2 (72st on RN), (see photo 16c)



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**(RS) Row 5:** Sl1k, k71

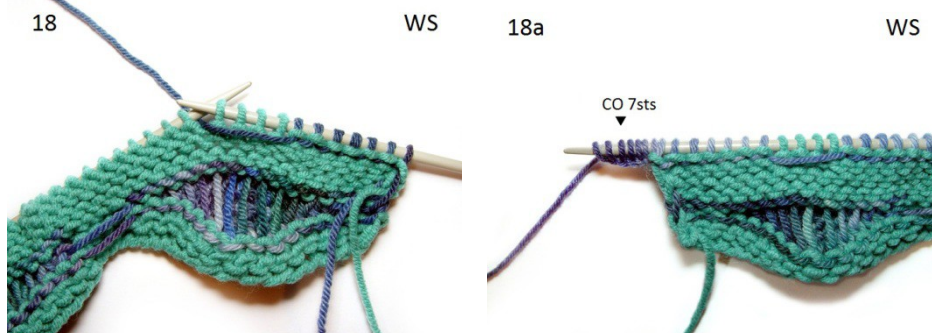
**(WS) Row 6:** Sl1k, p71

**(RS) Row 7:** Sl1k, k71 (see photo 17)

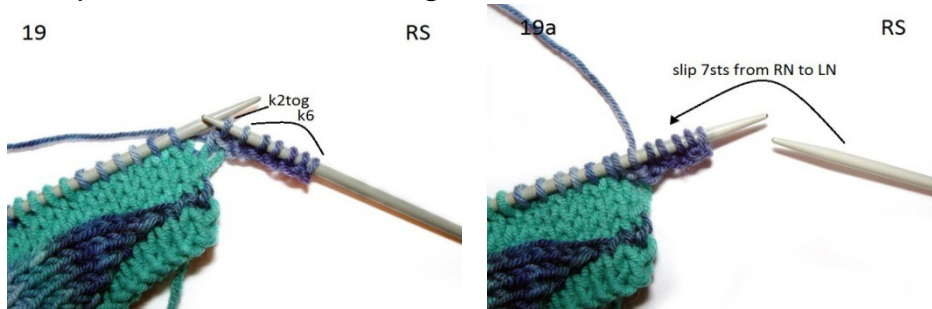


**Yarn B (WS) Row 8:** P7, w/o turning, {slip 4sts from LN to RN (WYIF), (see photo 18), p14} x 3 times, slip 4sts from LN to RN (WYIF), p7, w/o turning, CO 7sts (using the loop cast-on method), (see photo 18a), turn work

The second band of drops:



**(RS) Row 9:** K6, k2tog, (see photo 19), w/o turning, slip 7sts from RN to LN (WYIB), (see photo 19a), w/o turning





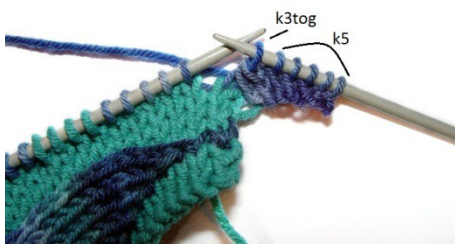

Continue: repeat similarly Row 3 from \* to \*\*\* x 3 times (see photo 26), w/o turning,



“k1-w1-r2”, w/o turning, “k2-w1-r3”, w/o turning, “k3-w1-r4”, w/o turning, “k4-w1-r5”, w/o turning, “k5-w1-r6”, w/o turning, k5, k2tog, (see photo 27), turn work



(WS) Row 10: BO 5sts (1st remaining on RN), (see photo 28), w/o turning,

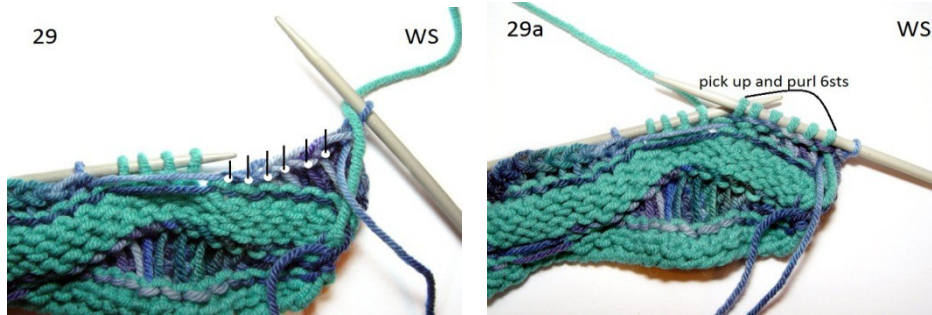




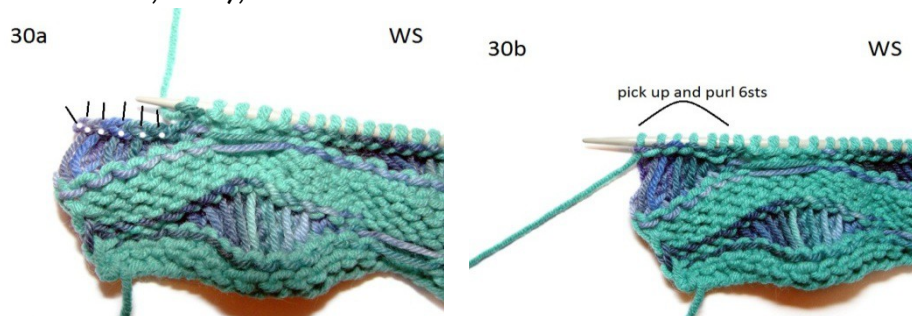
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Continue **Yarn A** - pick up and purl 6sts (see photos 29, 29a), w/o turning,



{p5, pick up and purl 13sts (see photo 30)} x 3 times, p5, pick up and purl 6sts (see photos 30a, 30b), turn work.



**(RS) Row 11:** Sl1k, k71

**(WS) Row 12:** Sl1k, p71

**(RS) Row 13:** Sl1k, k71, (see photo 31)

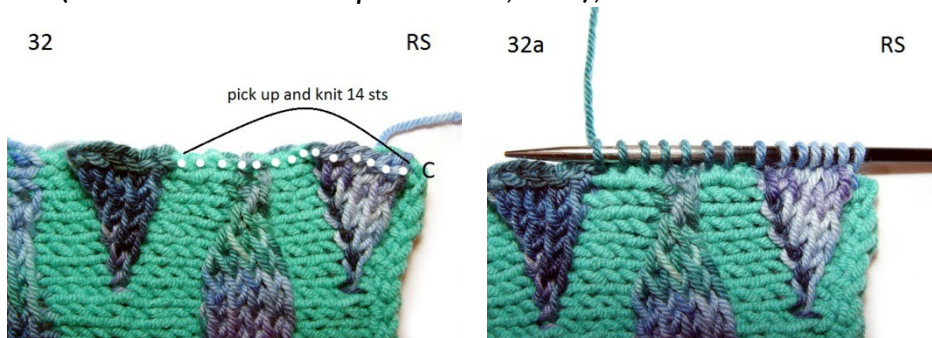


Repeat **Rows 2 - 13** x 47 more times or scarf to the desired length.

When you reach desired length, BO all stitches instead of row 12. Break yarn A.

### The border:

**Yarn B)** From the selv sts pick up and knit sts as follows: from the mark "C" - 14 sts (see Schematic and photos 32, 32a), turn work.



**WS) Row 1:** Sl1k, p13, turn work.

**RS) Row 2:** “k1-w1-r2”, w/o turning, “k2-w1-r3”, w/o turning, “k3-w1-r4”, w/o turning, “k4-w1-r5”, w/o turning, “k5-w1-r6”, w/o turning, “k6-w1-r7”, w/o turning;

k6, k2tog, w/o turning, slip 7sts from RN to LN (WYIB), w/o turning;

k5, k3tog, w/o turning, slip 6sts from RN to LN (WYIB), w/o turning;

k4, k3tog, w/o turning, slip 5sts from RN to LN (WYIB), w/o turning;

k3, k3tog, w/o turning, slip 4sts from RN to LN (WYIB), w/o turning;

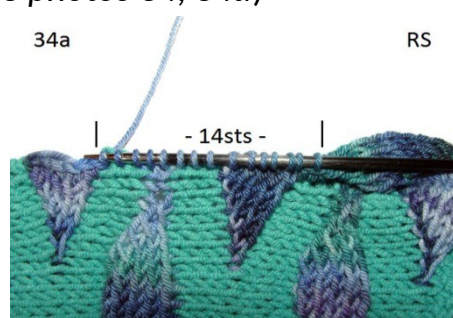
k2, k3tog, w/o turning, slip 3sts from RN to LN (WYIB), w/o turning;

k1, k3tog, w/o turning, slip 2sts from RN to LN (WYIB), w/o turning;

k3tog (1st remaining on RN), (see photo 33), w/o turning



Next: pick up and knit 13sts, (see photos 34, 34a)



Turn work. **Repeat Rows 1 - 2** (the border) to the mark “A” (see Schematic) Similarly knit border from mark "B" to mark "D".
