Cesta is an asymmetrical shawl worked in a basketweave pattern. The shawl starts in one corner and works its way out by increasing stitches, creating a lovely texture. The entire pattern is crocheted with simple double crochets, front post double crochets, and back post double crochets, which makes it perfect for a beginner who is looking to master these stitches.

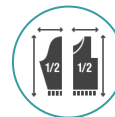

-DETAILS-

SIZE: 64" W x 30" H (163 cm x 76 cm), blocked; Size is adjustable.

Expression Fiber Arts Allure Fingering

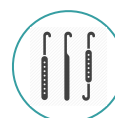
Shown in Fairy Tale Hues: A) Gray, B) Purple, C) Blue Green, D) Dark Green, E) Medium Green, and F) Light Green

MATERIALS

US size E (3.5 mm) or size needed to obtain gauge



HOOK

Tapestry needle for weaving in ends, stitch markers



TOOLS

18 sts and 9 rows = 4" (10 cm) in Double Crochet Stitch, unblocked

14 sts and 7 rows = 4" (10 cm) in Double Crochet Stitch, blocked



GAUGE

Adventurous Beginner: For crocheters who are ready to learn some new skills or stitch combinations. Stitches include double crochet, front post double crochet, and back post double crochet.



SKILL LEVEL

-ABBREVIATIONS-

Ch	chain
Dc	double crochet
Rep	repeat
St(s)	stitch(es)

SPECIAL STITCHES:

FPDC (front post double crochet): Yarn over, (working on the side facing you) insert hook around the post of the next st, yarn over, pull yarn around the post and up to working level, yarn over, pull through two loops on hook, yarn over, pull through two loops on hook.

BPDC (back post double crochet): Yarn over, (working on the side facing away from you) insert hook around the post of the next st, yarn over, pull yarn around the post and up to working level, yarn over, pull through two loops on hook, yarn over, pull through two loops on hook.

-PATTERN-

NOTES

- Approximate total yardage used: 1200 yds/1097 m total (200 yds/183 m of each color).
- The starting chain for each row **does not** count as a stitch.
- Continuing to repeat Rows 10 - 13 will increase the width and height of the shawl.
- Gently carry the yarn up the sides for the color change rows.

PATTERN

With Color A, ch 3.

Row 1: Make 2 dc in 3rd ch from hook, turn. (2 dc)

Row 2: Ch 2, 1 dc, 3 dc in next, turn. (4 dc)

Row 3: Ch 2, 3 dc in first st, 3 bpdc, turn. (3 bpdc, 3 dc)

Row 4: Ch 2, 1 bpdc in the first st, 3 bpdc, 1 fpdc, 3 dc in last, turn. (4 bpdc, 1 fpdc, 3 dc)

Row 5: Ch 2, 3 dc in the first st, 3 bpdc, 4 fpdc, turn. (3 bpdc, 4 fpdc, 3 dc)

Row 6: Ch 2, 1 fpdc in the first st, 3 fpdc, 4 bpdc, 1 fpdc, 3 dc in last, turn. (4 bpdc, 5 fpdc, 3 dc)

Row 7: Ch 2, 3 dc in the first st, 3 bpdc, 4 fpdc, 4 bpdc, turn. (7 bpdc, 4 fpdc, 3 dc)

Row 8: Ch 2, 4 bpdc, 4 fpdc, 4 bpdc, 1 fpdc, 3 dc in last, turn. (8 bpdc, 5 fpdc, 3 dc)

Row 9: Ch 2, 3 dc in the first st, 3 bpdc, 4 fpdc, 4 bpdc, 4 fpdc, turn. (7 bpdc, 8 fpdc, 3 dc)

Row 10: Ch 2, *4 fpdc, 4 bpdc,* rep from * to * until 2 sts remain, 1 fpdc, 3 dc in last, turn. (8 bpdc, 9 fpdc, 3 dc)

Row 11: Ch 2, 3 dc in the first st, 3 bpdc, *4 fpdc, 4 bpdc,* rep from * to * to end, turn. (11 bpdc, 8 fpdc, 3 dc)

Row 12: Ch 2, 4 bpdc, *4 fpdc, 4 bpdc,* rep from * to * until 2 sts remain, 1 fpdc, 3 dc in last, turn. (12 bpdc, 9 fpdc, 3 dc)

Row 13: Ch 2, 3 dc in the first st, 3 bpdc, 4 fpdc, *4 bpdc, 4 fpdc,* rep from * to * to end, turn. (11 bpdc, 12 fpdc, 3 dc)

Rows 14 - 41: Rep Rows 10 - 13. (39 bpdc, 40 fpdc, 3 dc)

Rows 42 - 43: Rep Rows 10 - 11. (43 bpdc, 40 fpdc, 3 dc)

Rows 44 - 45: With Color B (do not cut Color A), rep Rows 12 - 13. (43 bpdc, 44 fpdc, 3 dc)

Rows 46 - 47: With Color A (do not cut Color B), rep Rows 10 - 11. (47 bpdc, 44 fpdc, 3 dc)

Rows 48 - 49: With Color B (do not cut Color A), rep Rows 12 - 13. (47 bpdc, 48 fpdc, 3 dc)

Rows 50 - 51: With Color A (do not cut Color B), rep Rows 10 - 11. (51 bpdc, 48 fpdc, 3 dc)

Rows 52 - 53: With Color B (cut Color A), rep Rows 12 - 13. (51 bpdc, 52 fpdc, 3 dc)

Rows 54 - 61: Rep Rows 10 - 13. (59 bpdc, 60 fpdc, 3 dc)

Rows 62 - 63: Rep Rows 10 - 11. (63 bpdc, 60 fpdc, 3 dc)

Rows 64 - 65: With Color C (do not cut Color B), rep Rows 12 - 13. (63 bpdc, 64 fpdc, 3 dc)

Rows 66 - 67: With Color B (do not cut Color C), rep Rows 10 - 11. (67 bpdc, 64 fpdc, 3 dc)

Rows 68 - 69: With Color C (do not cut Color B), rep Rows 12 - 13. (67 bpdc, 68 fpdc, 3 dc)

Rows 70 - 71: With Color B (do not cut Color C), rep Rows 10 - 11. (71 bpdc, 68 fpdc, 3 dc)

Rows 72 - 73: With Color C (cut Color B), rep Rows 12 - 13. (71 bpdc, 72 fpdc, 3 dc)

Rows 74 - 77: Rep Rows 10 - 13. (75 bpdc, 76 fpdc, 3 dc)

Rows 78 - 79: Rep Rows 10 - 11. (79 bpdc, 76 fpdc, 3 dc)

Rows 80 - 81: With Color D (do not cut Color C), rep Rows 12 - 13. (79 bpdc, 80 fpdc, 3 dc)

Rows 82 - 83: With Color C (do not cut Color D), rep Rows 10 - 11. (83 bpdc, 80 fpdc, 3 dc)

Rows 84 - 85: With Color D (do not cut Color C), rep Rows 12 - 13. (83 bpdc, 84 fpdc, 3 dc)

Rows 86 - 87: With Color C (do not cut Color D), rep Rows 10 - 11. (87 bpdc, 84 fpdc, 3 dc)

Rows 88 - 89: With Color D (cut Color C), rep Rows 12 - 13. (87 bpdc, 88 fpdc, 3 dc)

Rows 90 - 91: Rep Rows 10 - 11. (91 bpdc, 88 fpdc, 3 dc)

Rows 92 - 93: With Color E (do not cut Color D), rep Rows 12 - 13. (91 bpdc, 92 fpdc, 3 dc)

Rows 94 - 95: With Color D (do not cut Color E), rep Rows 10 - 11. (95 bpdc, 92 fpdc, 3 dc)

Rows 96 - 97: With Color E (do not cut Color D), rep Rows 12 - 13. (95 bpdc, 96 fpdc, 3 dc)

Rows 98 - 99: With Color D (do not cut Color E), rep Rows 10 - 11. (99 bpdc, 96 fpdc, 3 dc)

Rows 100 - 101: With Color E (cut Color D), rep Rows 12 - 13. (99 bpdc, 100 fpdc, 3 dc)

Rows 102 - 103: Rep Rows 10 - 11. (103 bpdc, 100 fpdc, 3 dc)

Rows 104 - 105: With Color F (do not cut Color E), rep Rows 12 - 13. (103 bpdc, 104 fpdc, 3 dc)

Rows 106 - 107: With Color E (do not cut Color F), rep Rows 10 - 11. (107 bpdc, 104 fpdc, 3 dc)

Rows 108 - 109: With Color F (cut Color E), rep Rows 12 - 13. (107 bpdc, 108 fpdc, 3 dc)

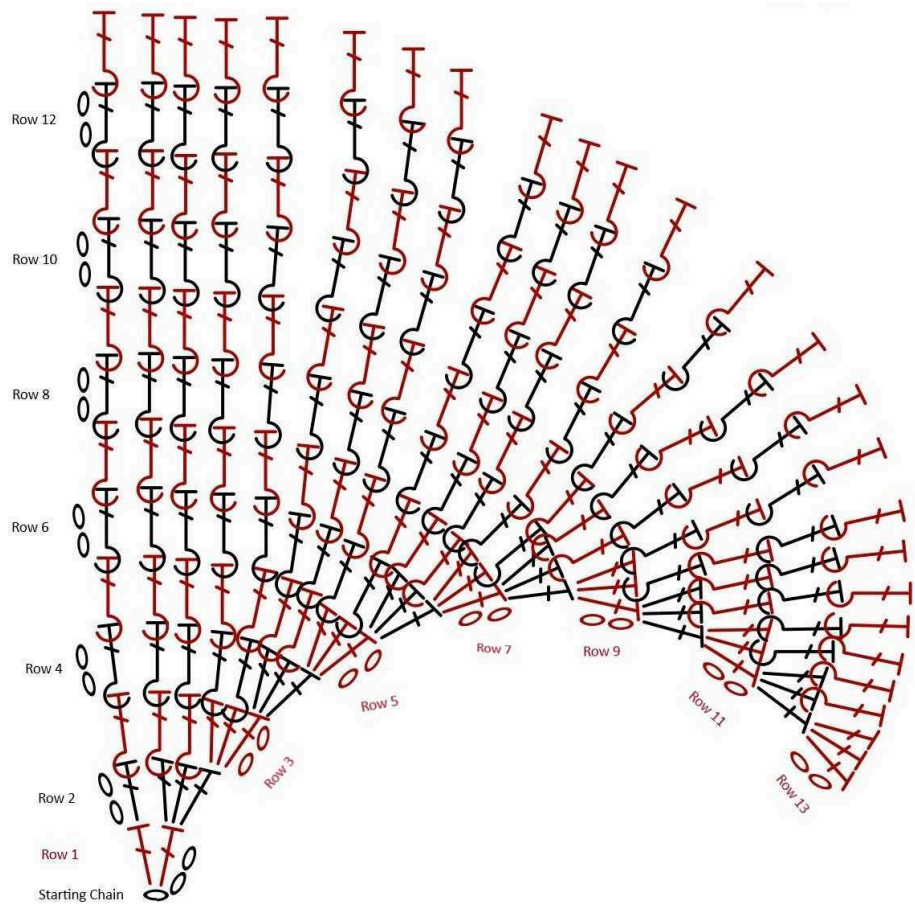
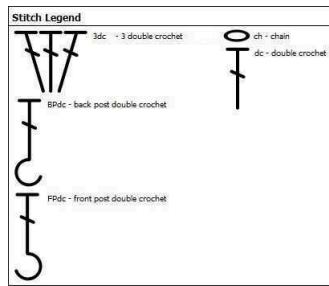
Rows 110 - 113: Rep Rows 10 - 13. (111 bpdc, 112 fpdc, 3 dc)

Rows 114 - 115: Rep Rows 10 - 11. Cut Color F. (115 bpdc, 112 fpdc, 3 dc)

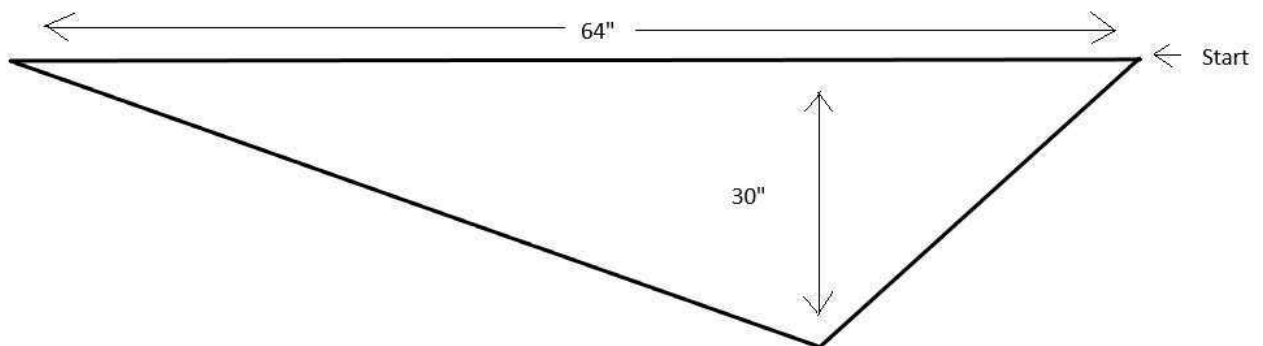
FINISHING

Weave in ends with a tapestry needle. Pin to size and desired shape, and then spray block. Allow to air dry.

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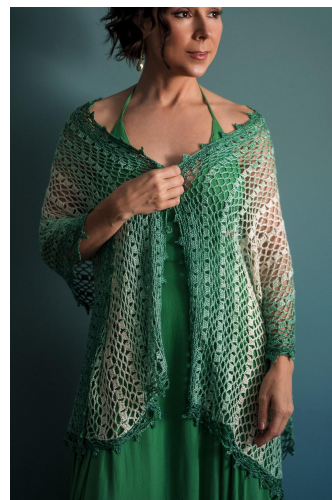
